

DW Akademie: Apply for the Master's Program International Media Studies Until 31st March!



The Master's Program “International Media Studies” is especially designed for international graduates with previous media experience. As a joint project of the University of Bonn, the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University of Applied Sciences and Deutsche Welle (DW), the program offers a perfect learning environment for up to 30 students per year. Since its launch in 2009, over 245 students from about 60 countries have successfully completed the Master's program at DW Akademie,

Germany's leading organization for international media development.

Applications for the 14th intake of the Master's program “International Media Studies”, starting in September 2023, will be accepted until the 31st March 2023.

The interdisciplinary study program is conducted in English, combining topics such as media and development, journalism, communication science and media management. The full-time, four-semester Master's degree in Bonn offers an unparalleled mix of research, lectures and practical experience and prepares students for careers in the communications and media industries. Students conclude the course with a Master's thesis and receive the academic degree “Master of Arts” (M.A.).

Applicants must have completed a Bachelor's degree or equivalent and have at least one year's media experience after obtaining their first degree. They must also provide proof of advanced English language skills. Highly qualified candidates from developing and emerging countries can apply for a scholarship and will complete the degree in their home countries.
