














Q14: Marital status: Are you...?





Q20: How would you assess the economic situation of your family today?



























































Q65: Do you personally have some money available, either from working, from your family or from other sources?





Q67: What are the different sources of your budget? Multiple answers possible



Syrian refugee: Reason for receiving transfers/budget support



















































Q115: Should the state play a larger or a smaller role in daily life or is it good as it is at the moment?









Syrian refugee: Religion as private matter









Q129: Are you part of a fixed group of friends – a "clique" – that is meeting frequently and where everybody knows one another very well?









Q142: How would you describe the relations between the younger and older generations...?









































Syrian Refugees: Family members that left too (I)













Syrian Refugees: Prepared or sudden decision?












