


















Tunisia: Household size


Q19: Who manages everyday affairs for your household? Multiple answers possible

Q20: How would you assess the economic situation of your family today?











Tunisia: Duration of school education










Q28: Is your father still alive?









































Tunisia: Agricultural land owned




Q58: Does your household own agricultural land?






Q60: Does your household currently produce food for its own consumption?









Q65: Do you personally have some money available, either from working, from your family or from other sources?





Q67: What are the different sources of your budget? Multiple answers possible











Tunisia: Frequency of work – most important job











































Q115: Should the state play a larger or a smaller role in daily life or is it good as it is at the moment?













Tunisia: Part of a clique




Q129: Are you part of a fixed group of friends – a "clique" – that is meeting frequently and where everybody knows one another very well?







Q142: How would you describe the relations between the younger and older generations...?







Q146: How many mobile phones / smartphones do you currently possess?






























Tunisia: Importance of emigration

Q176: Which of the following statements best reflects your opinion?




Q178: If yes, who have you been in contact with?
