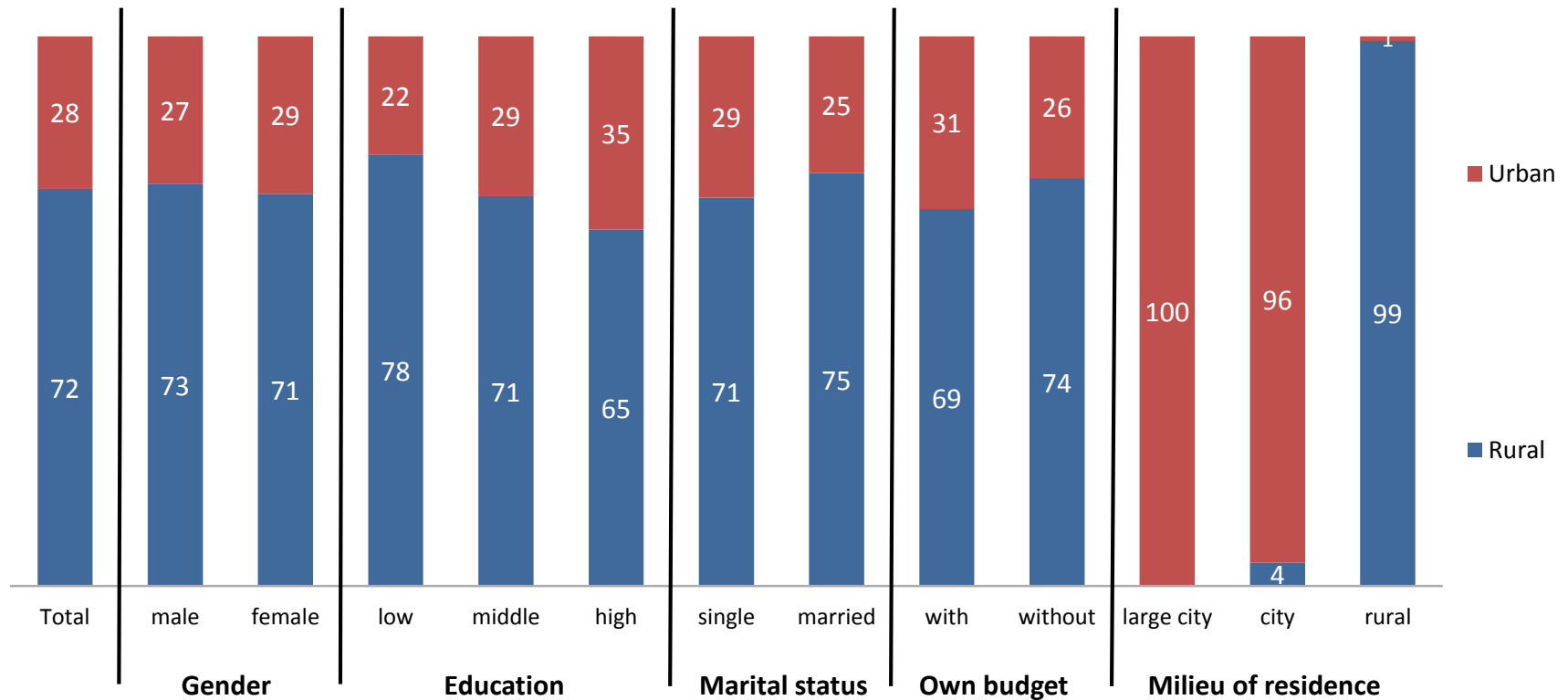

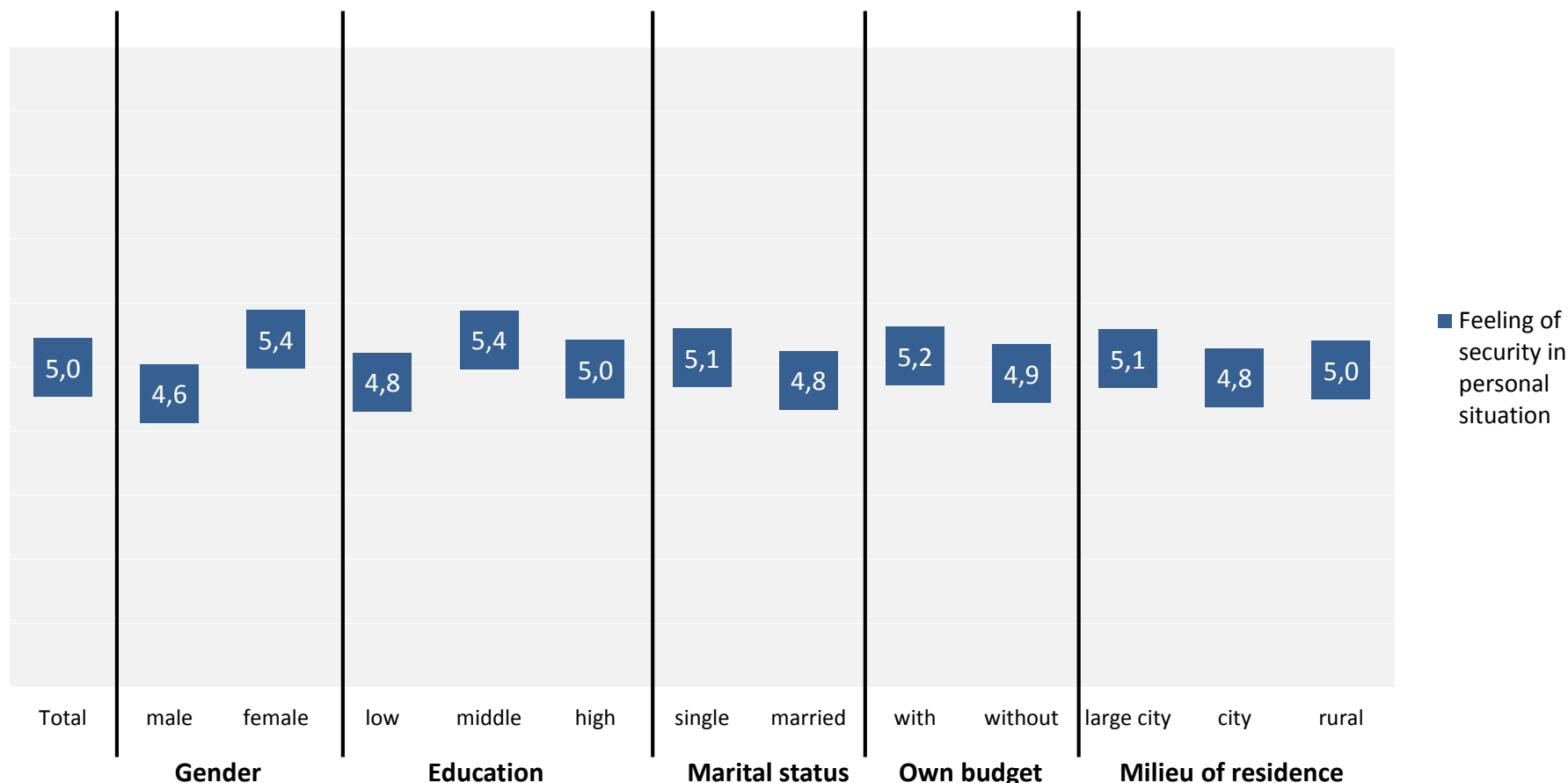

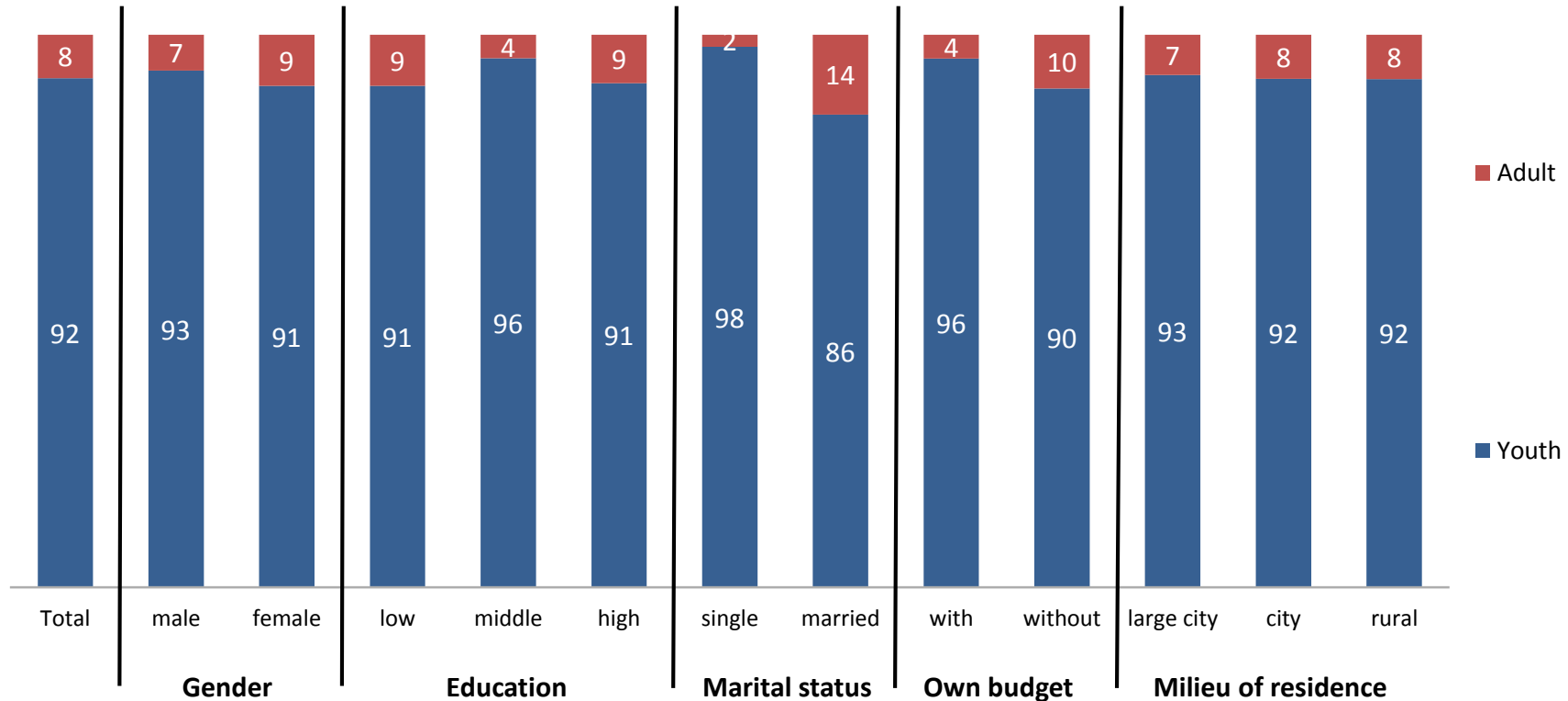

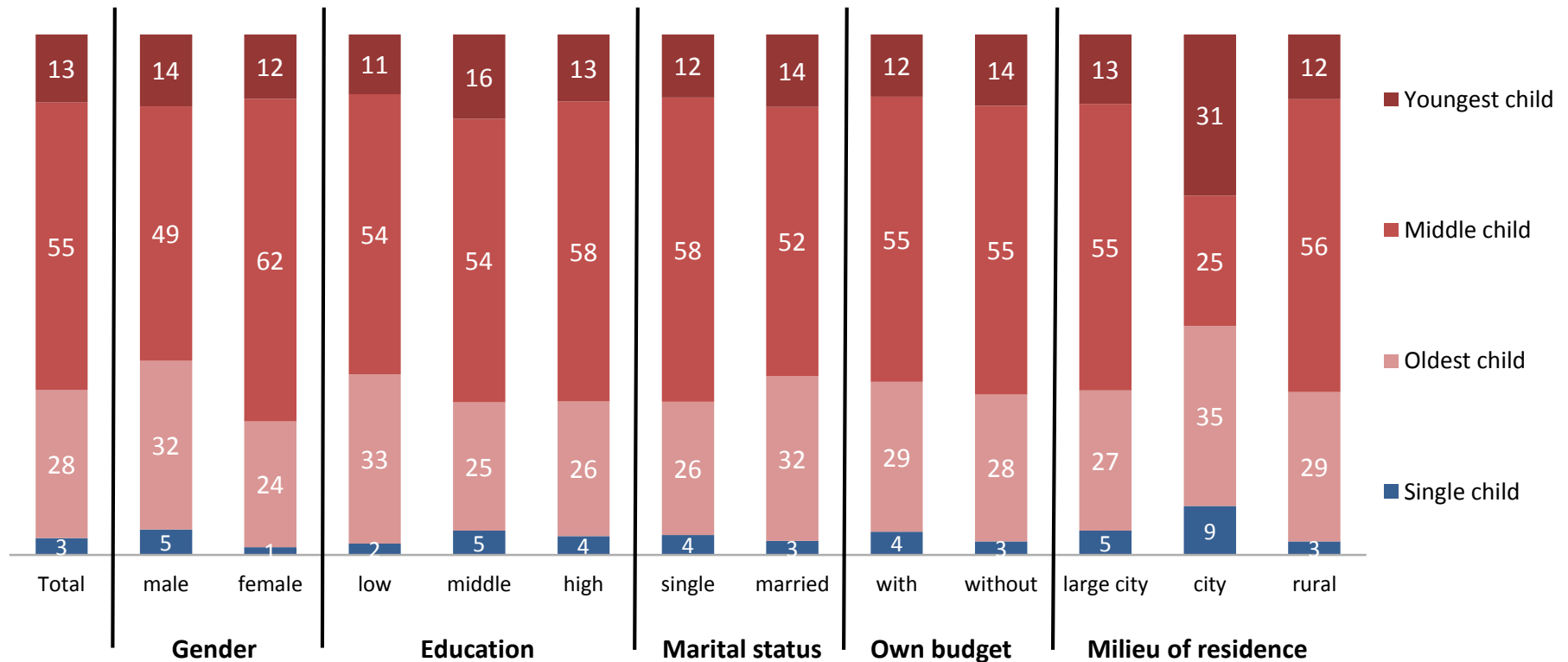

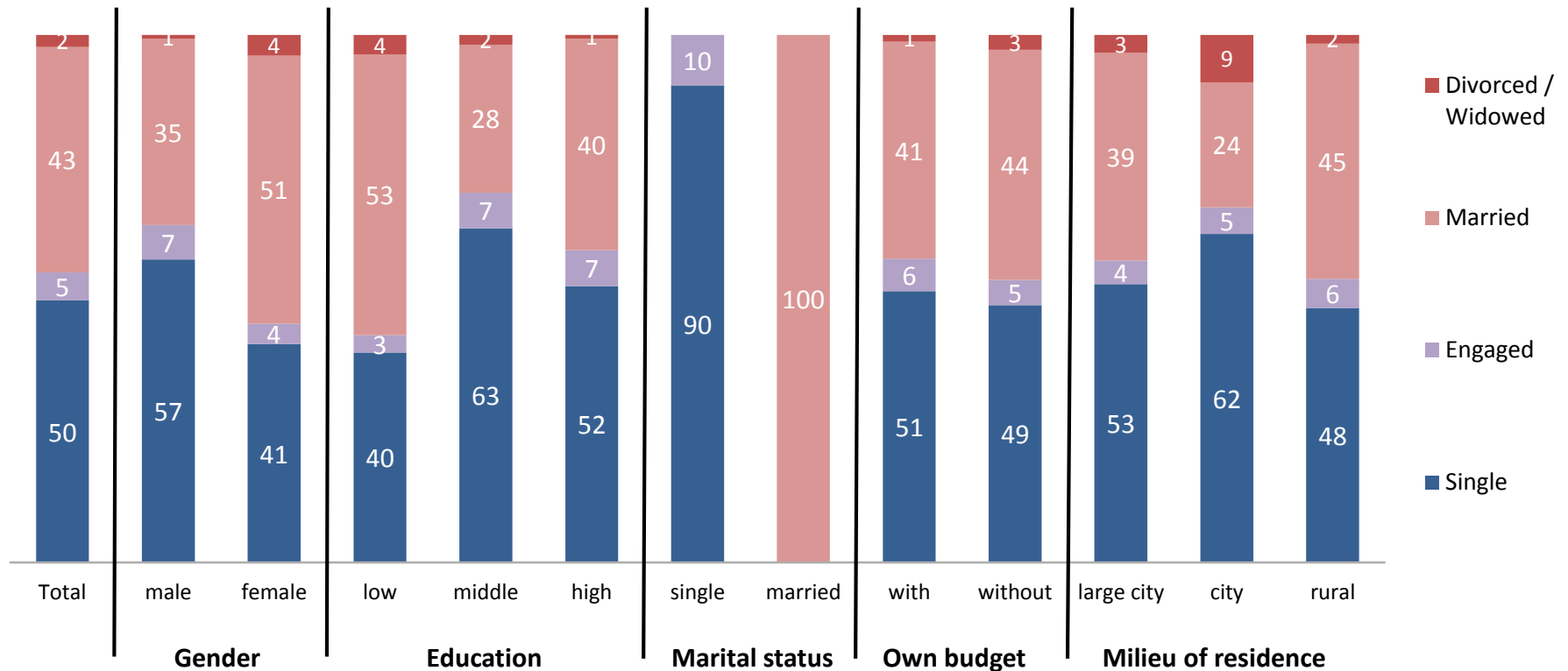
Yemen: Birth sequence

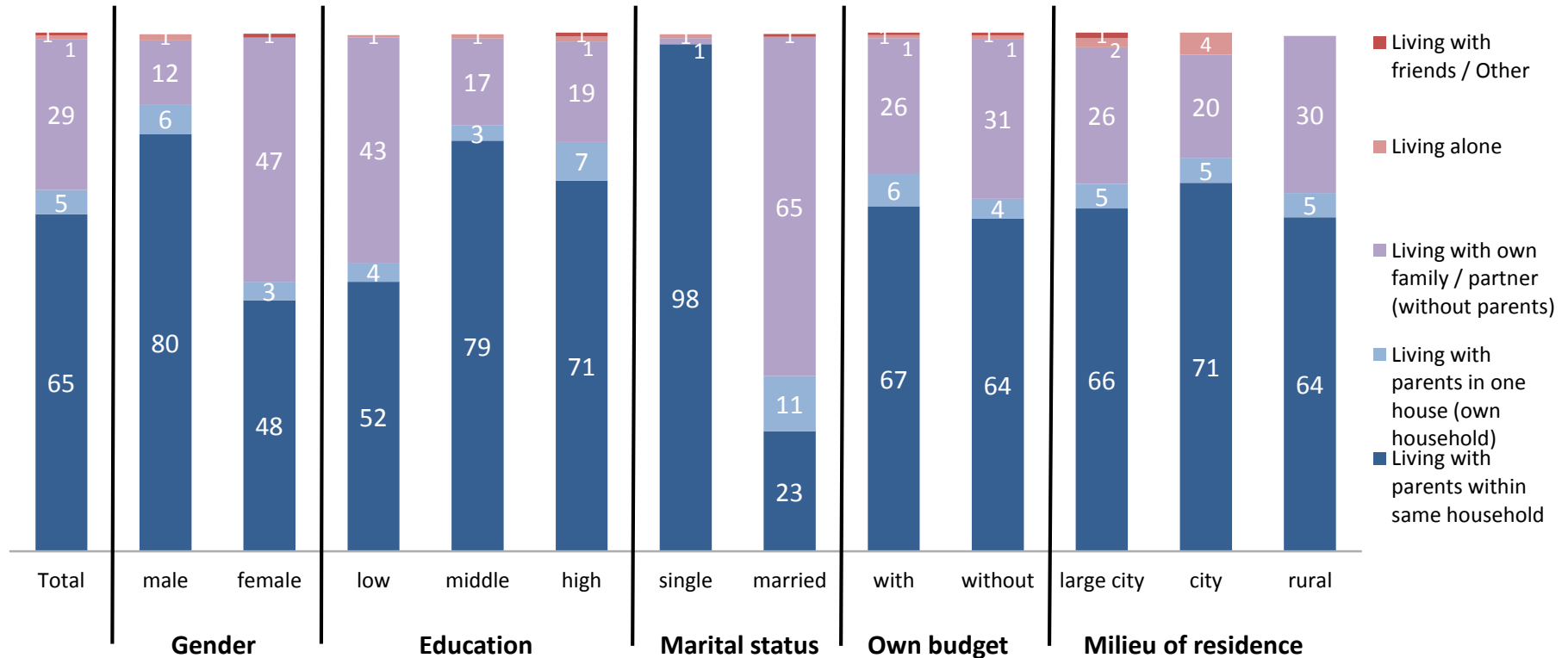

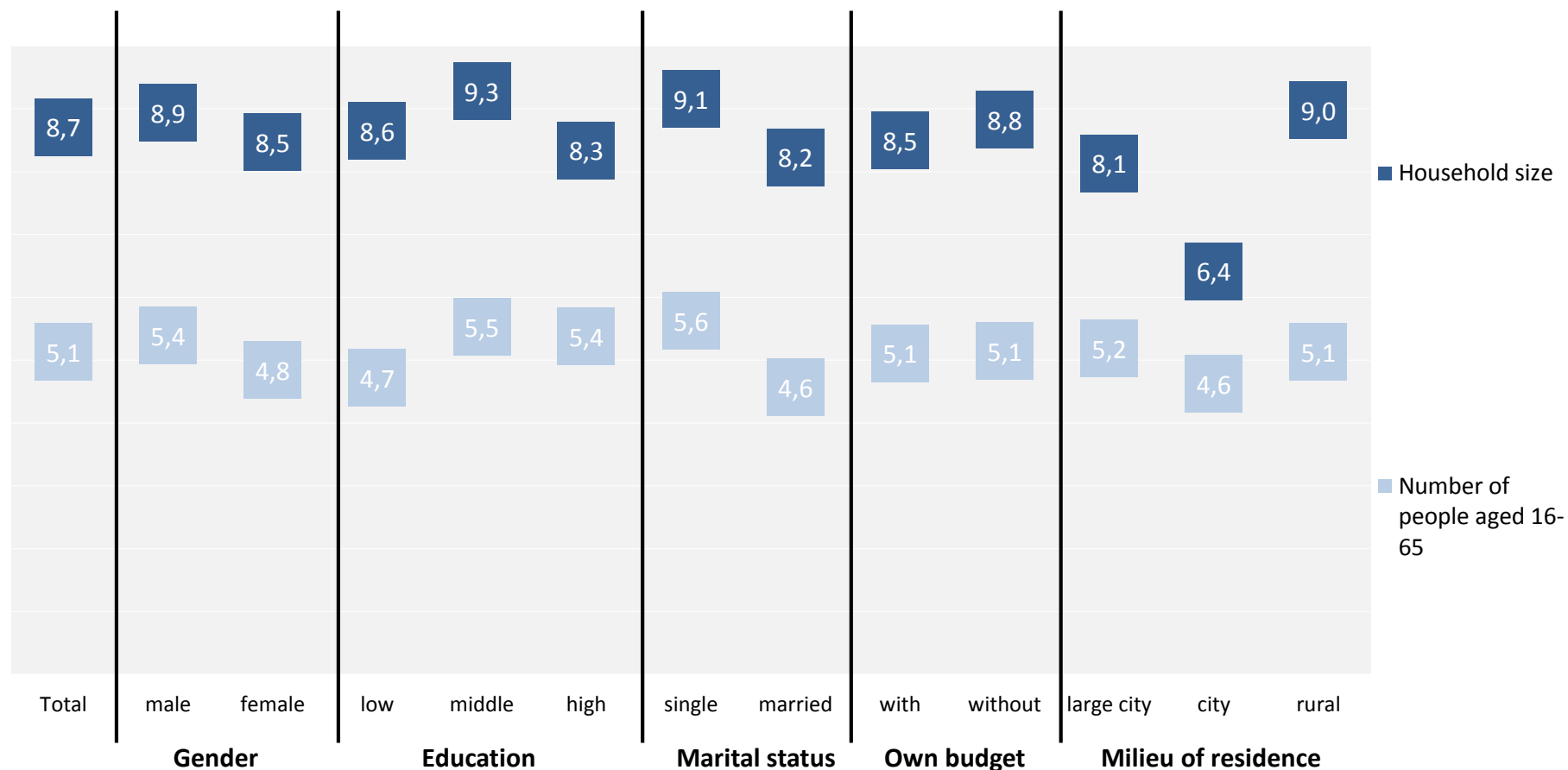

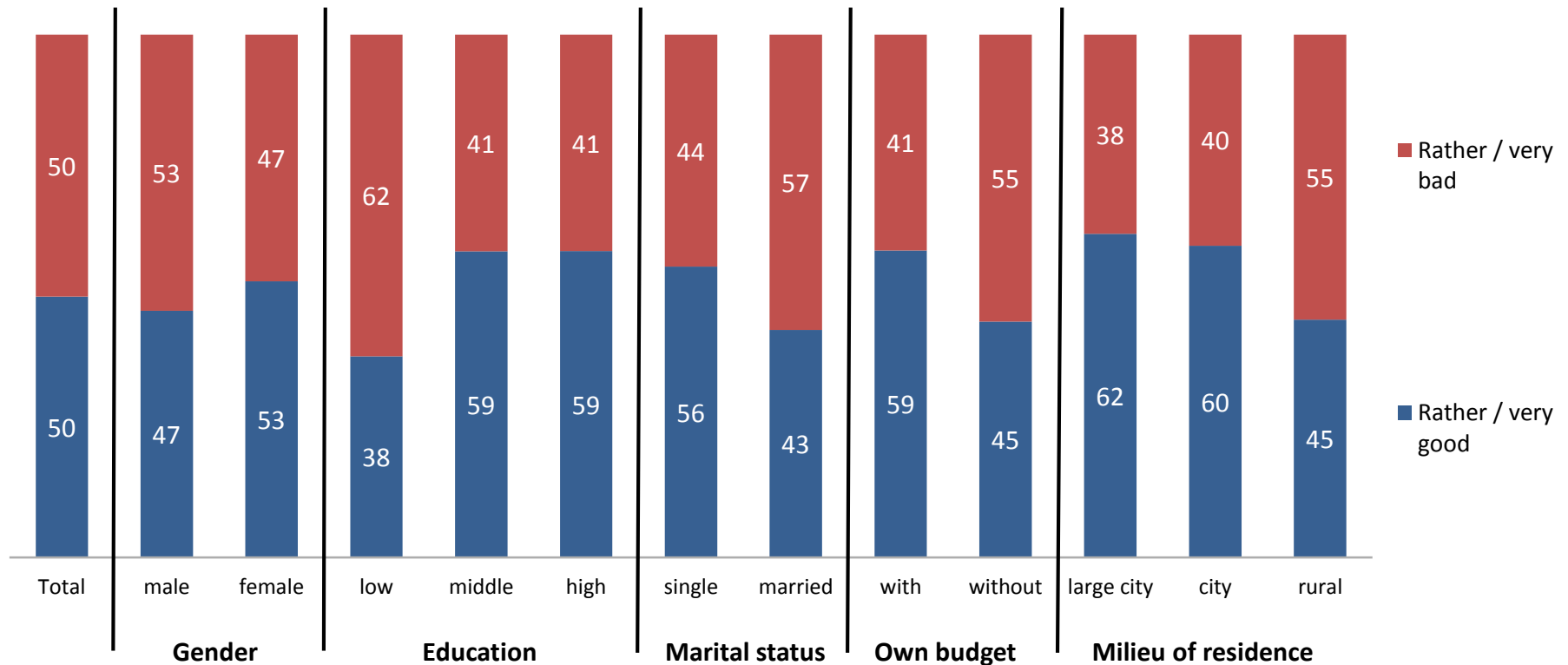

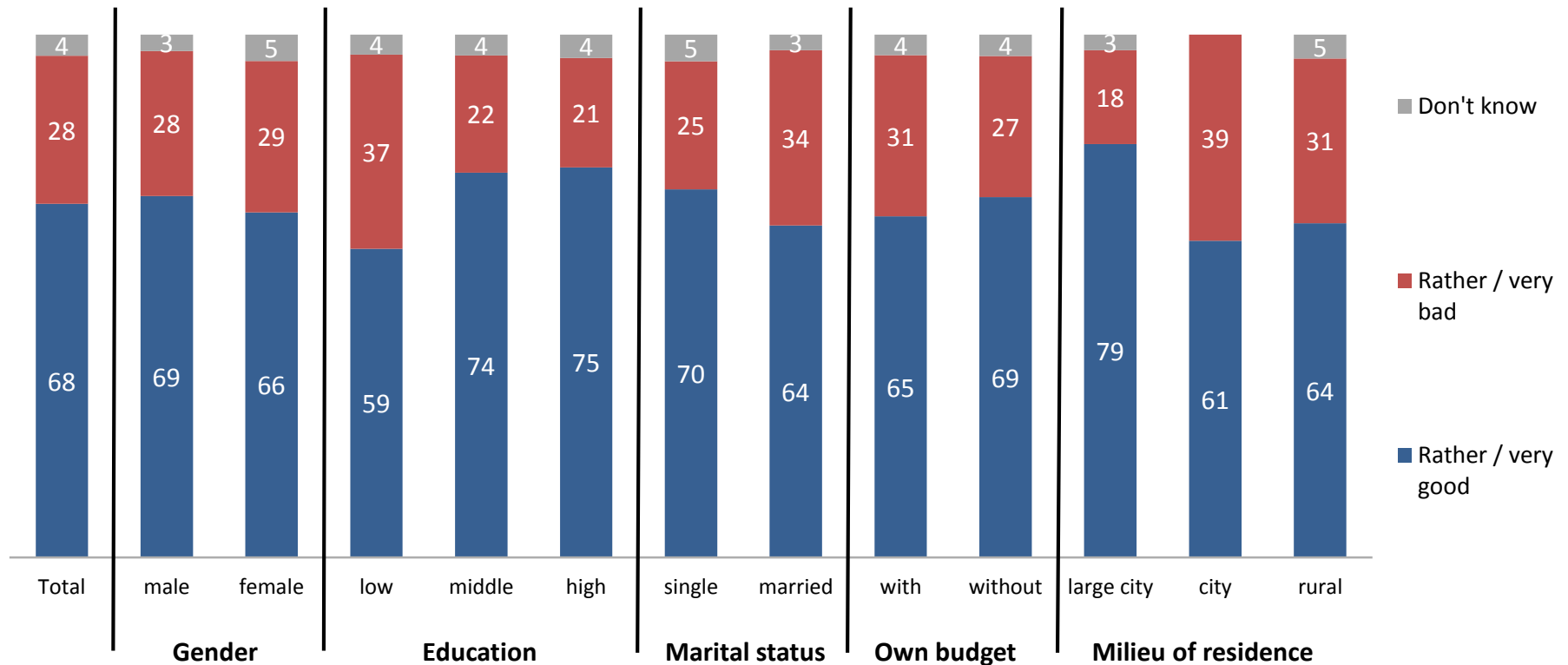
Yemen: Assessment of economic situation today

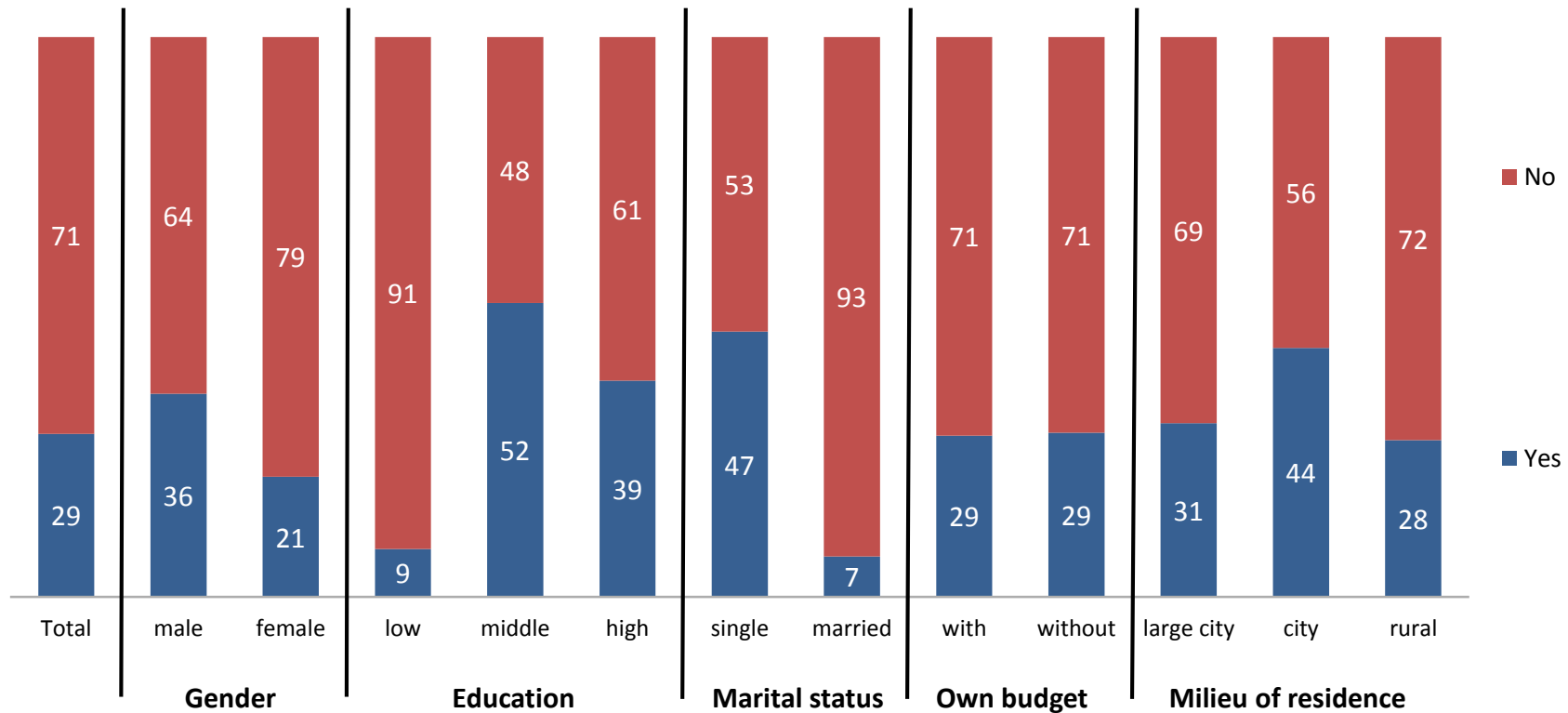
Yemen: Assessment of economic situation in 2010

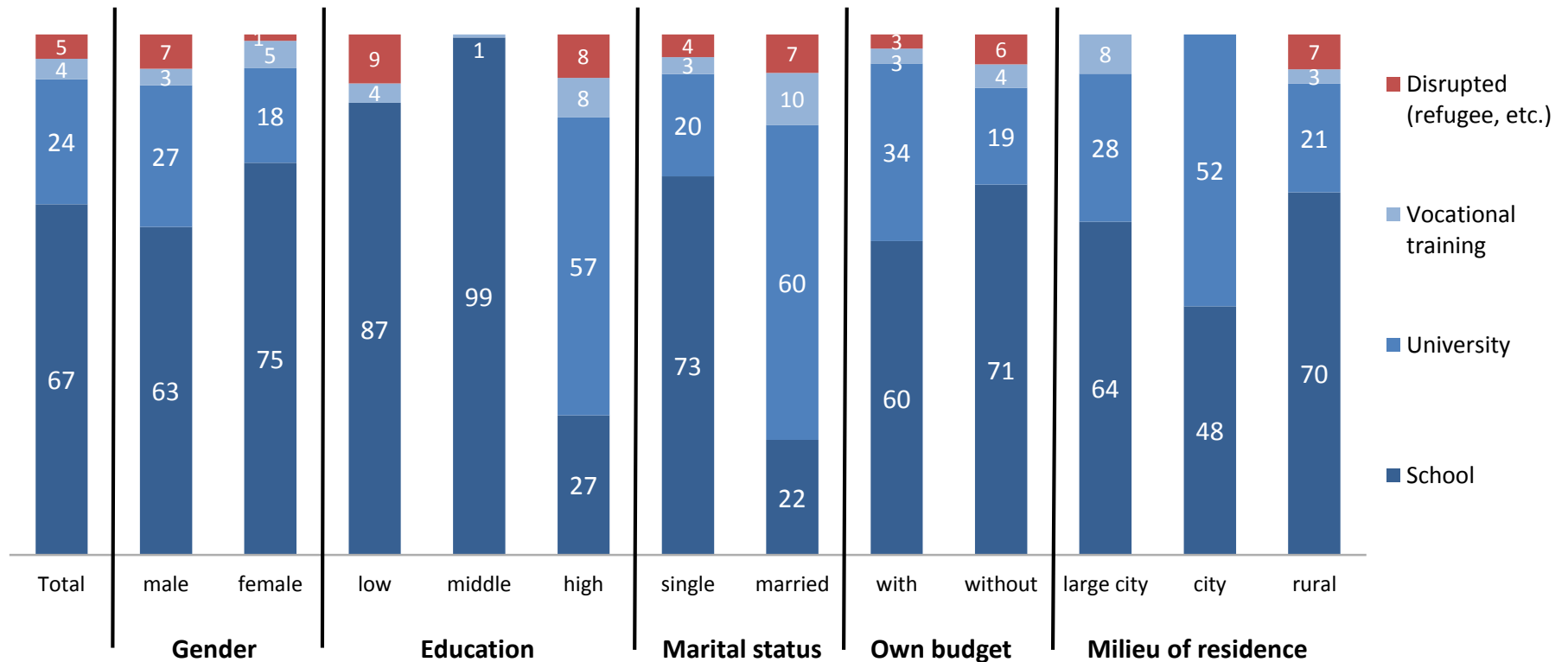

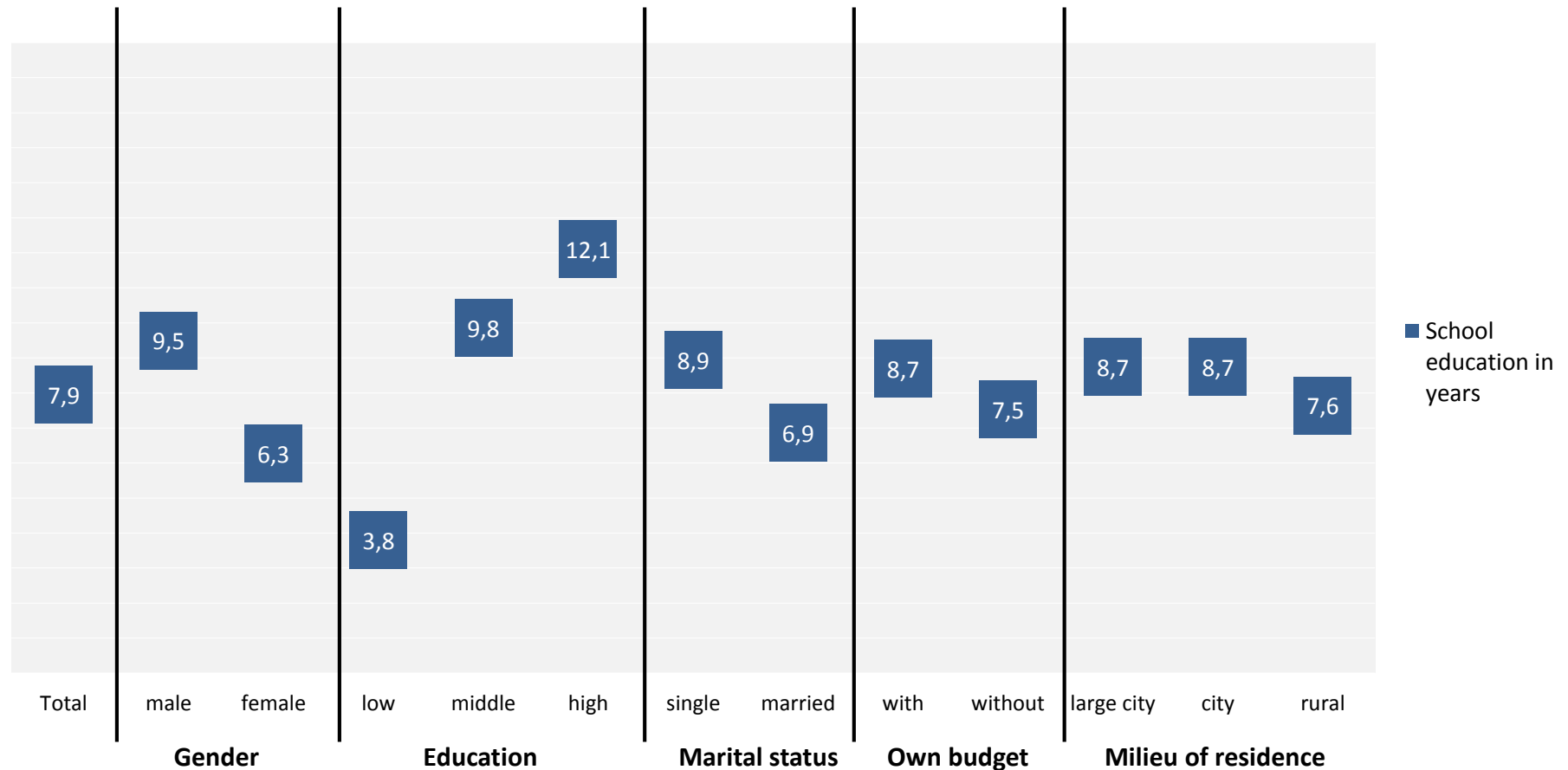

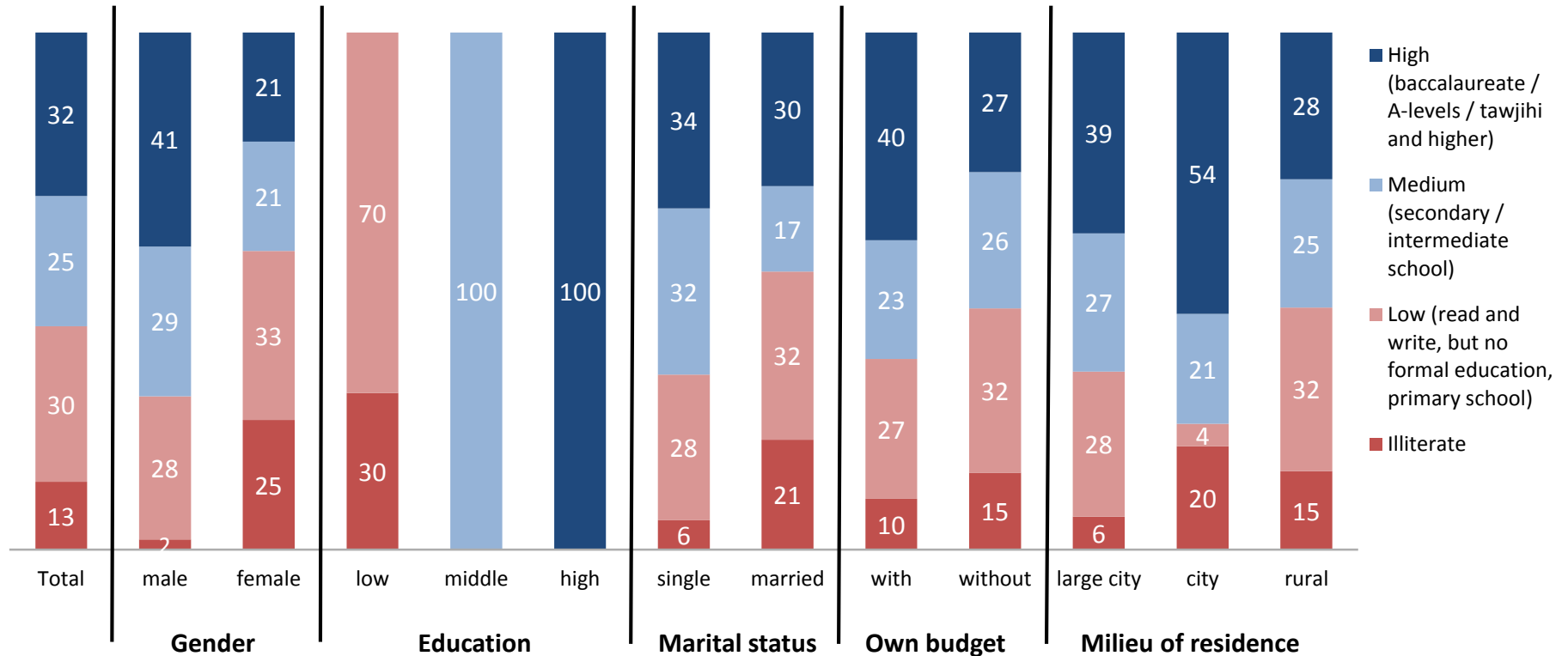
Yemen: Duration of school education

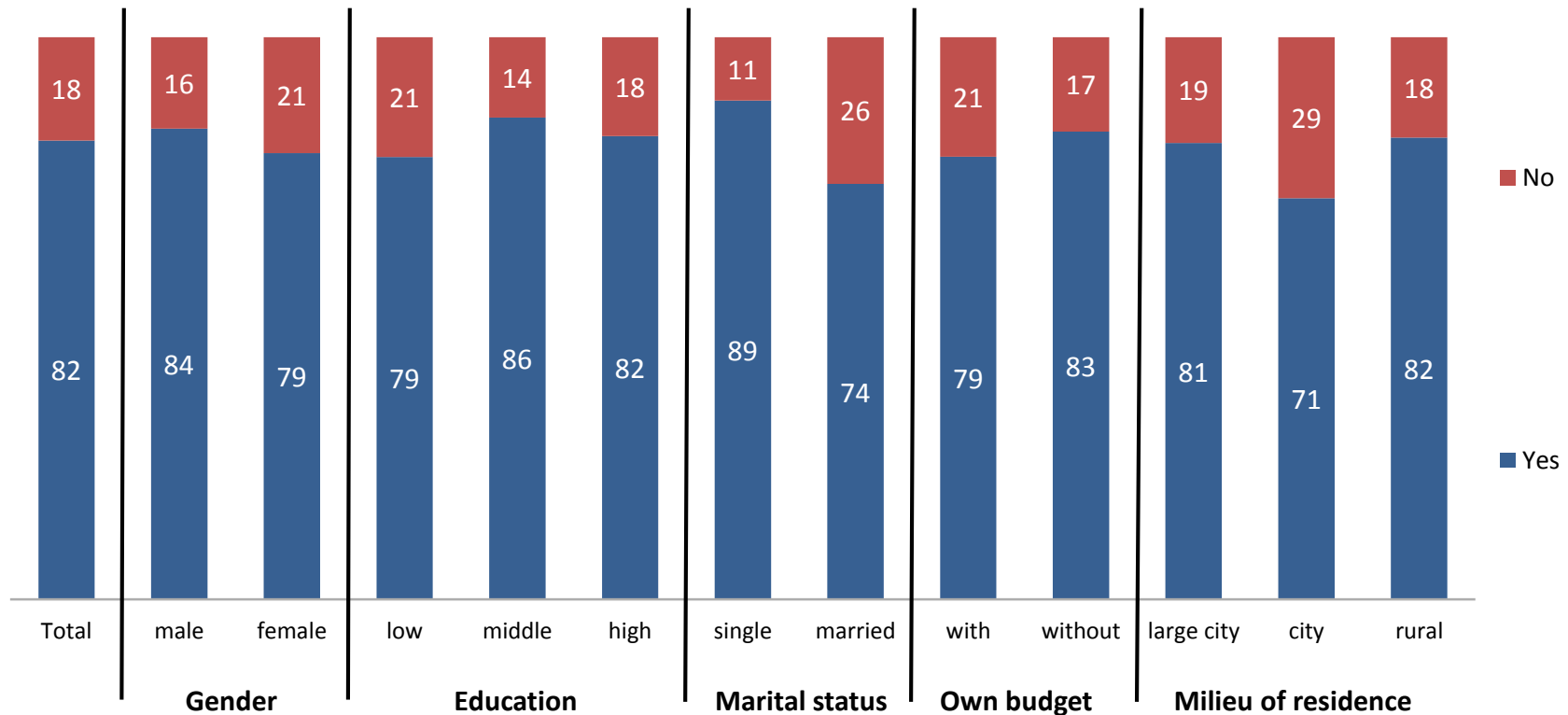

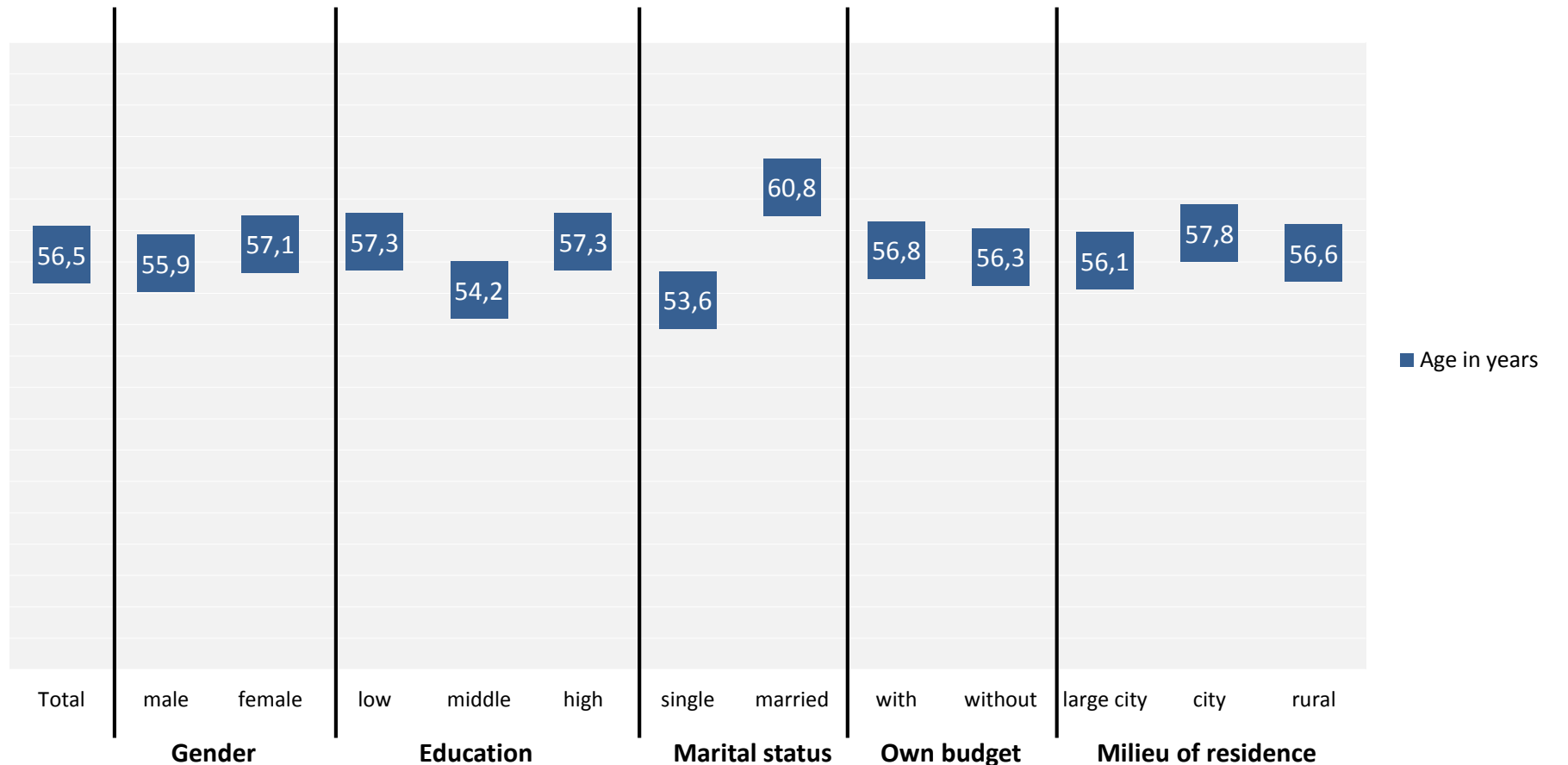

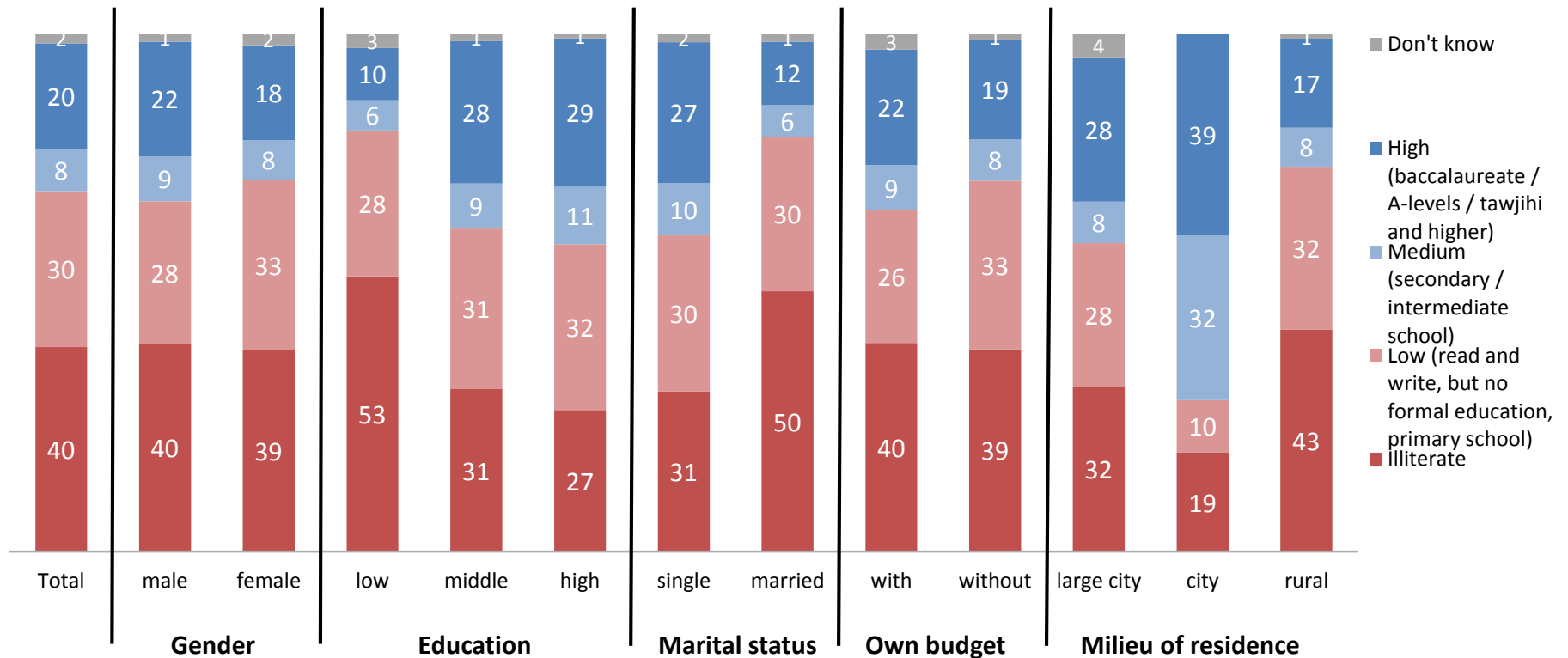

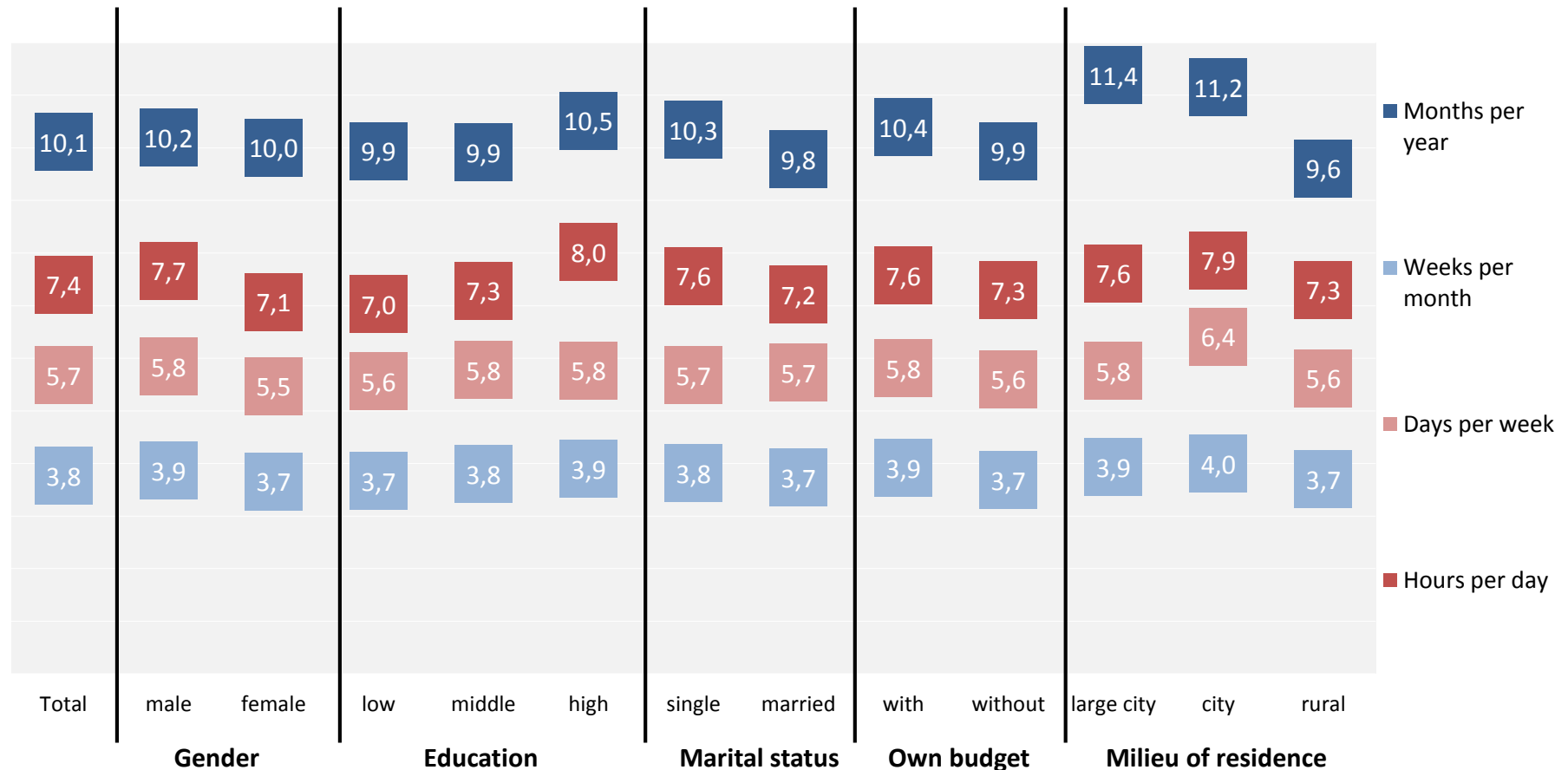

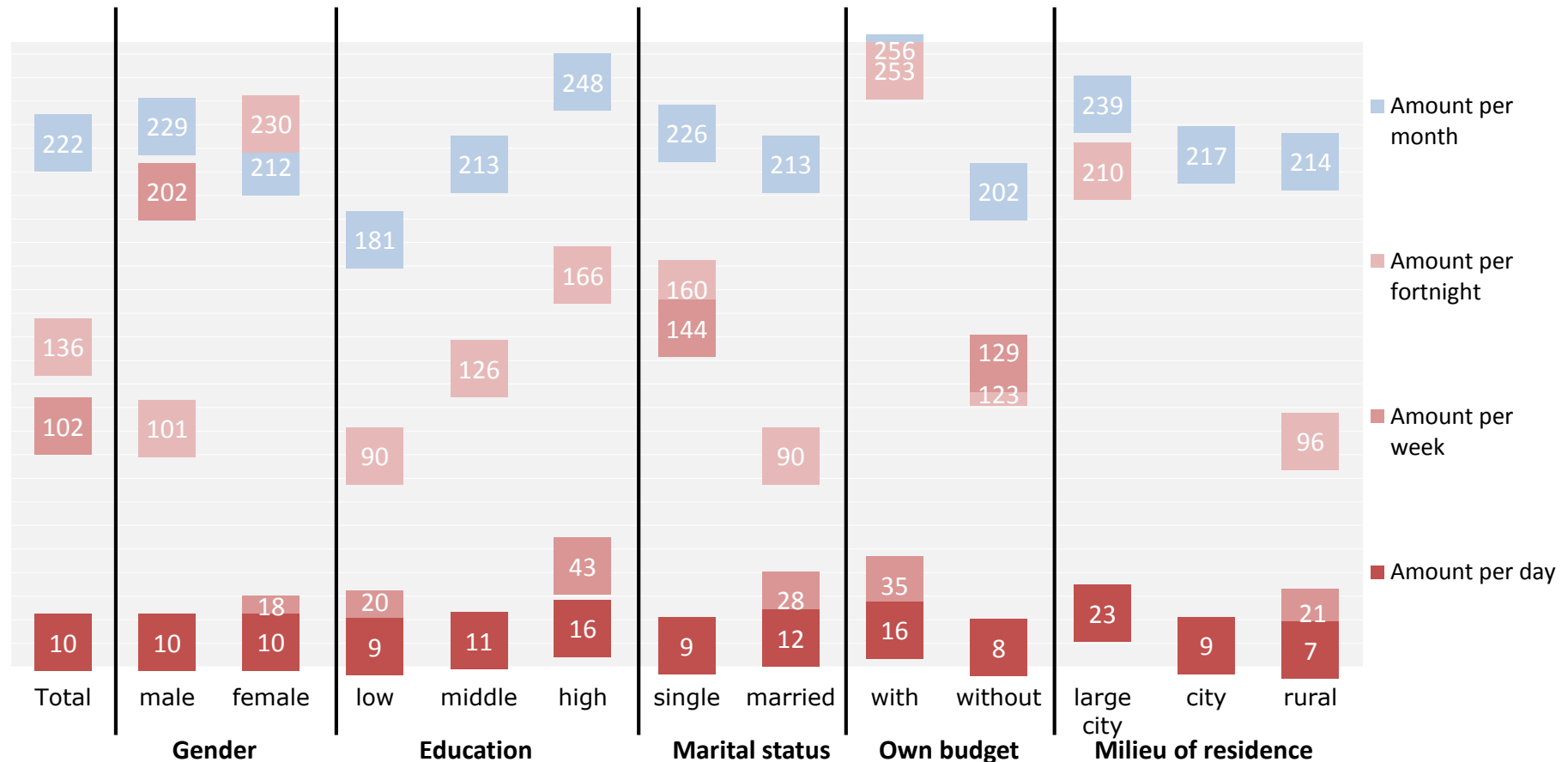

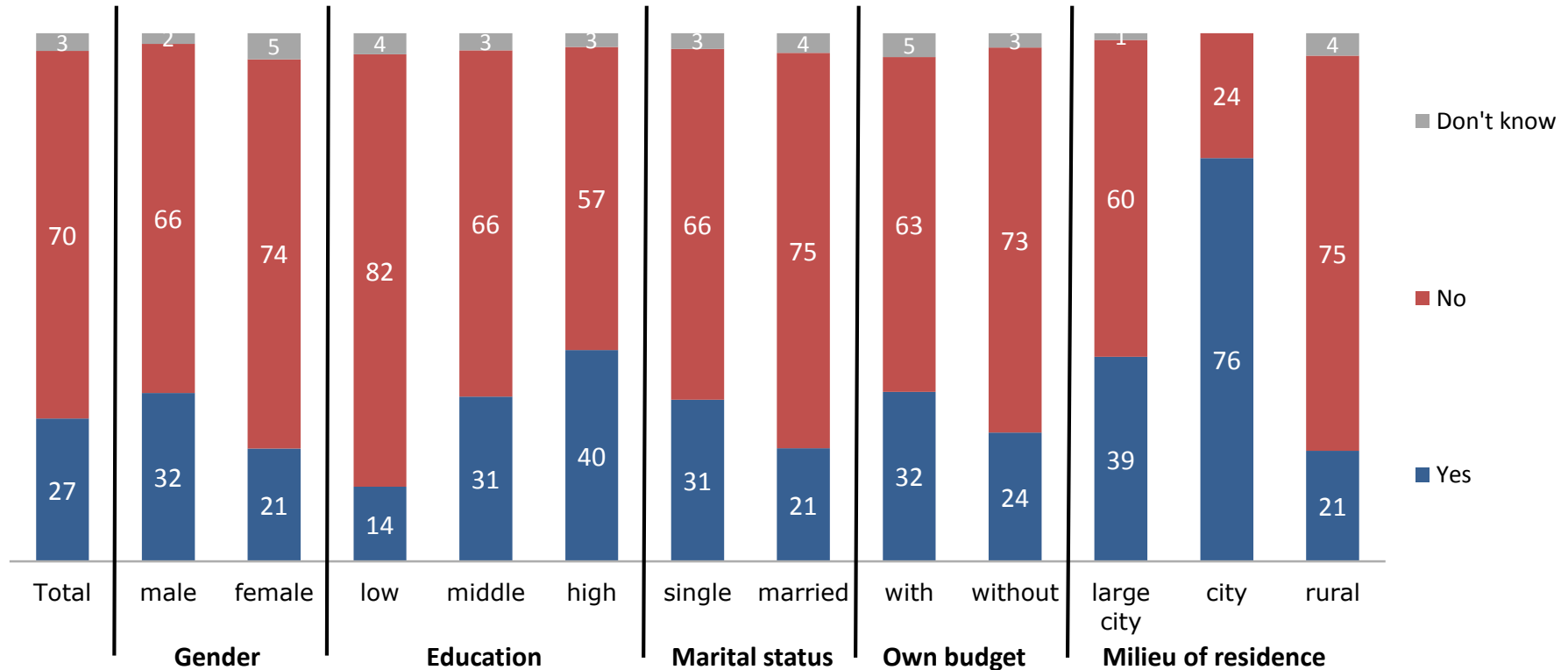
Yemen: Father's income (in Euro)

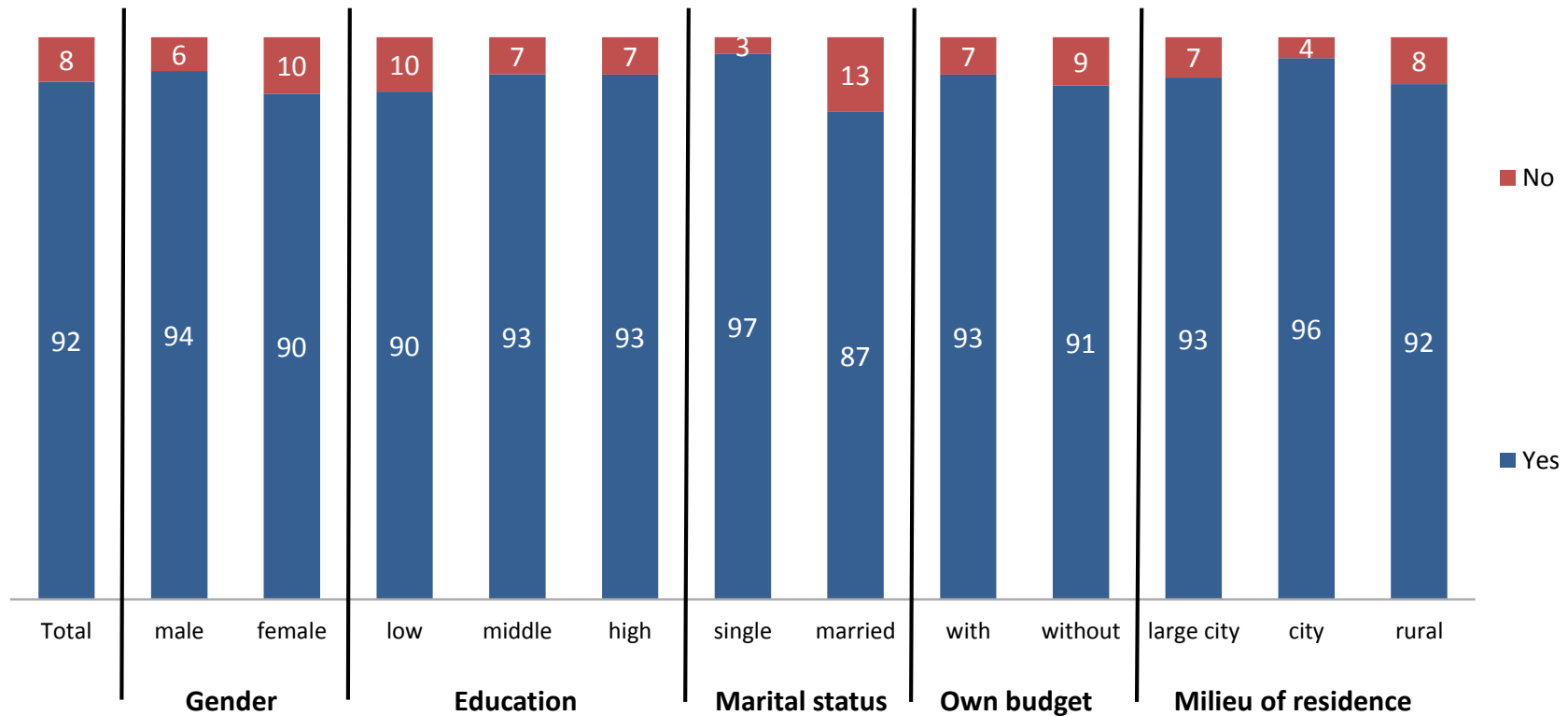

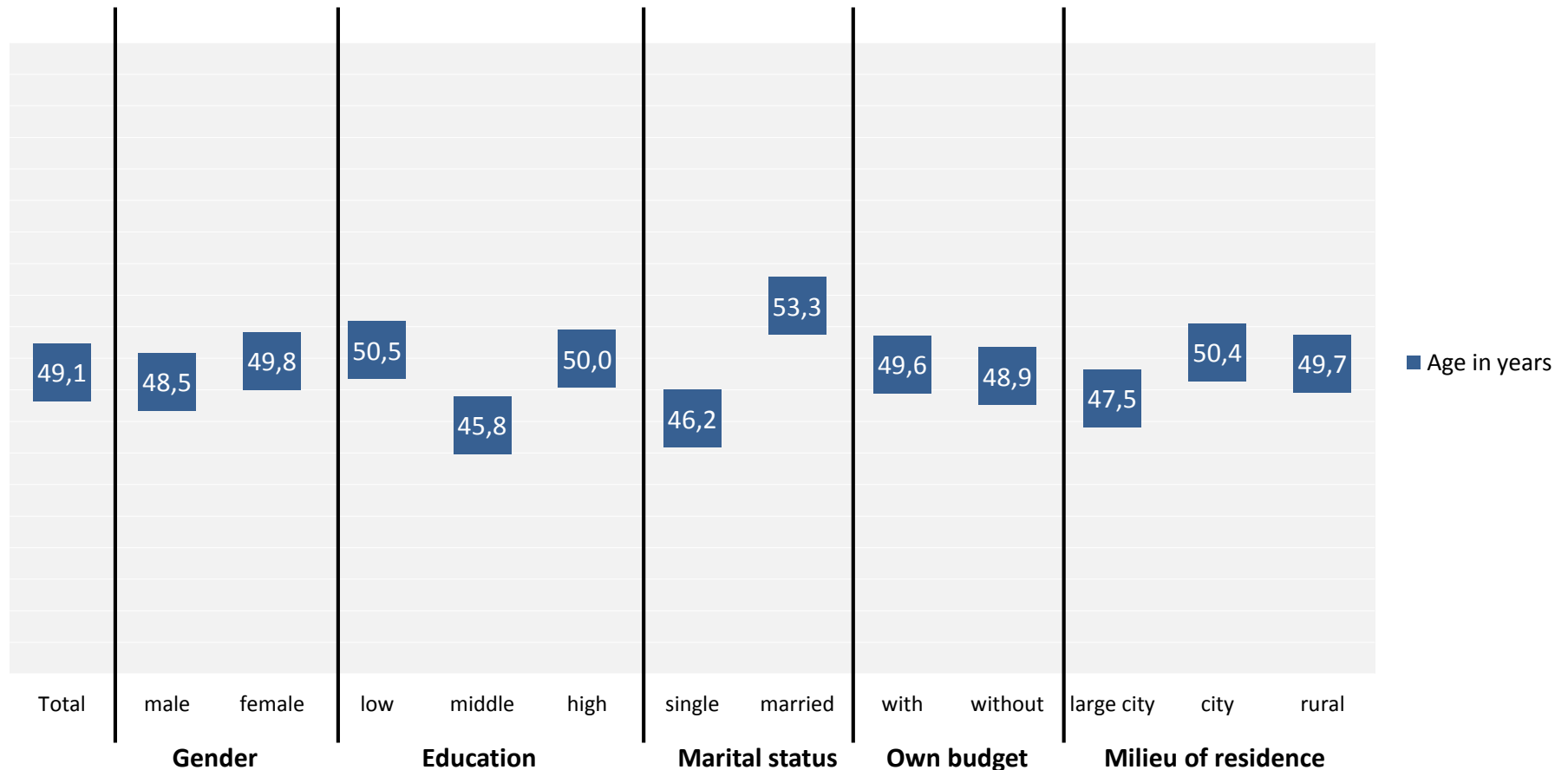

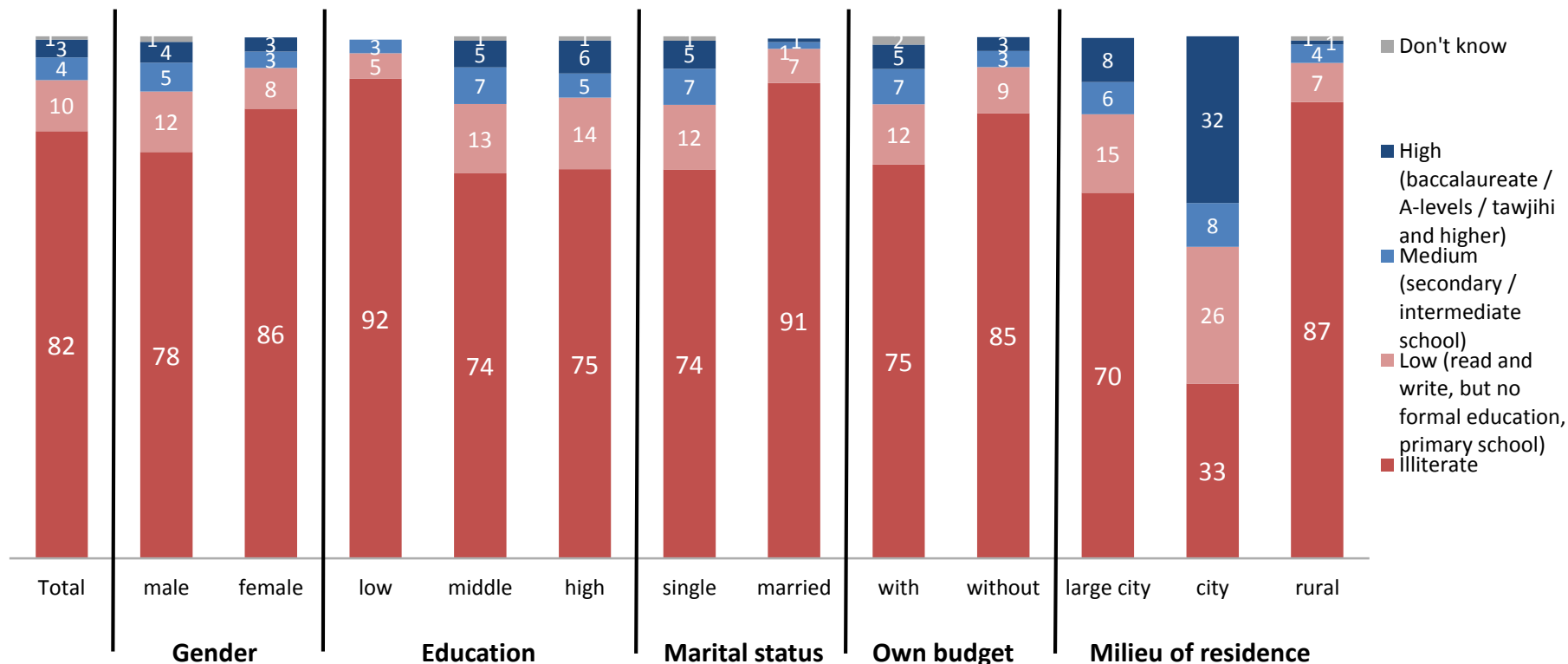

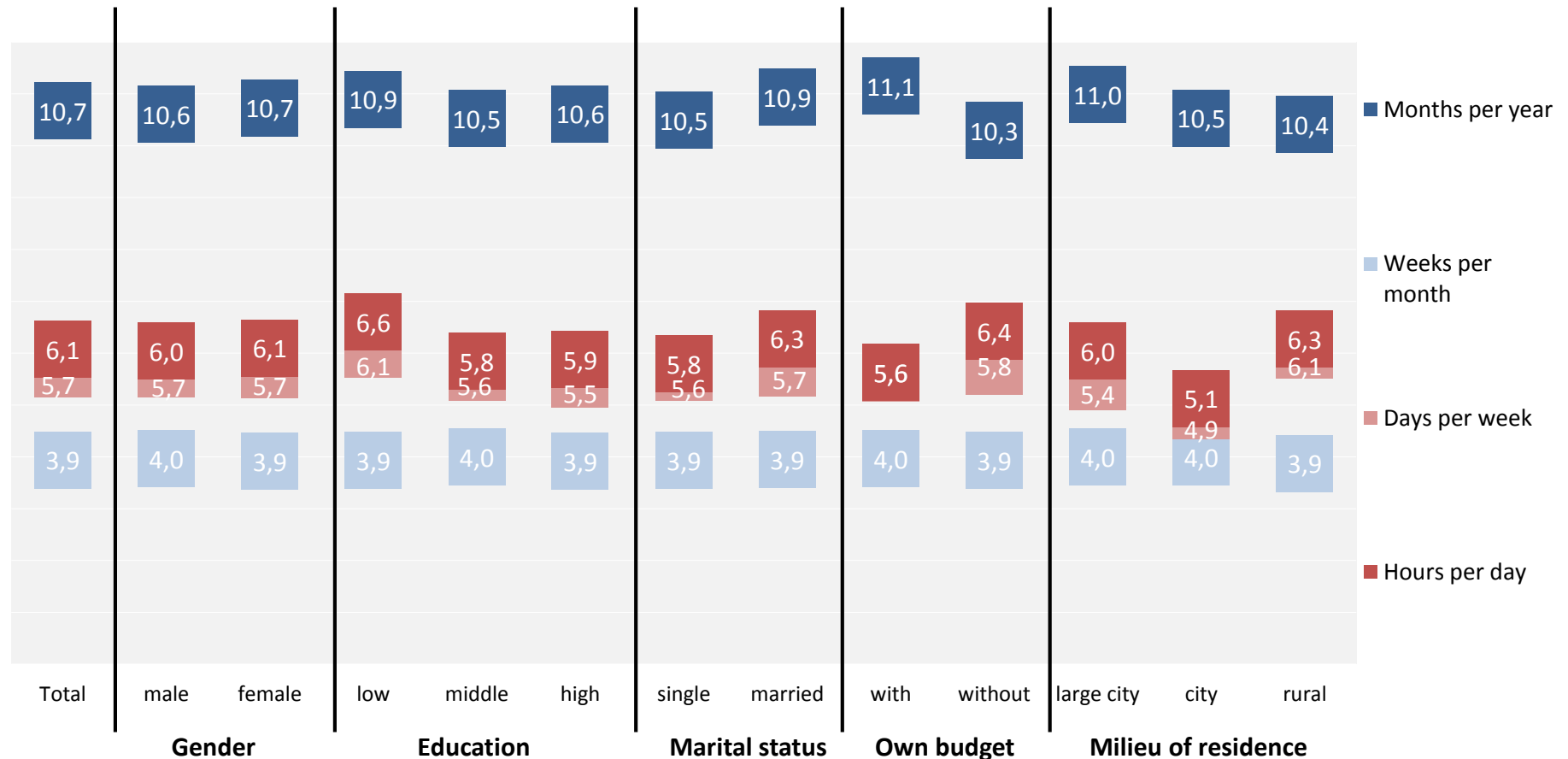

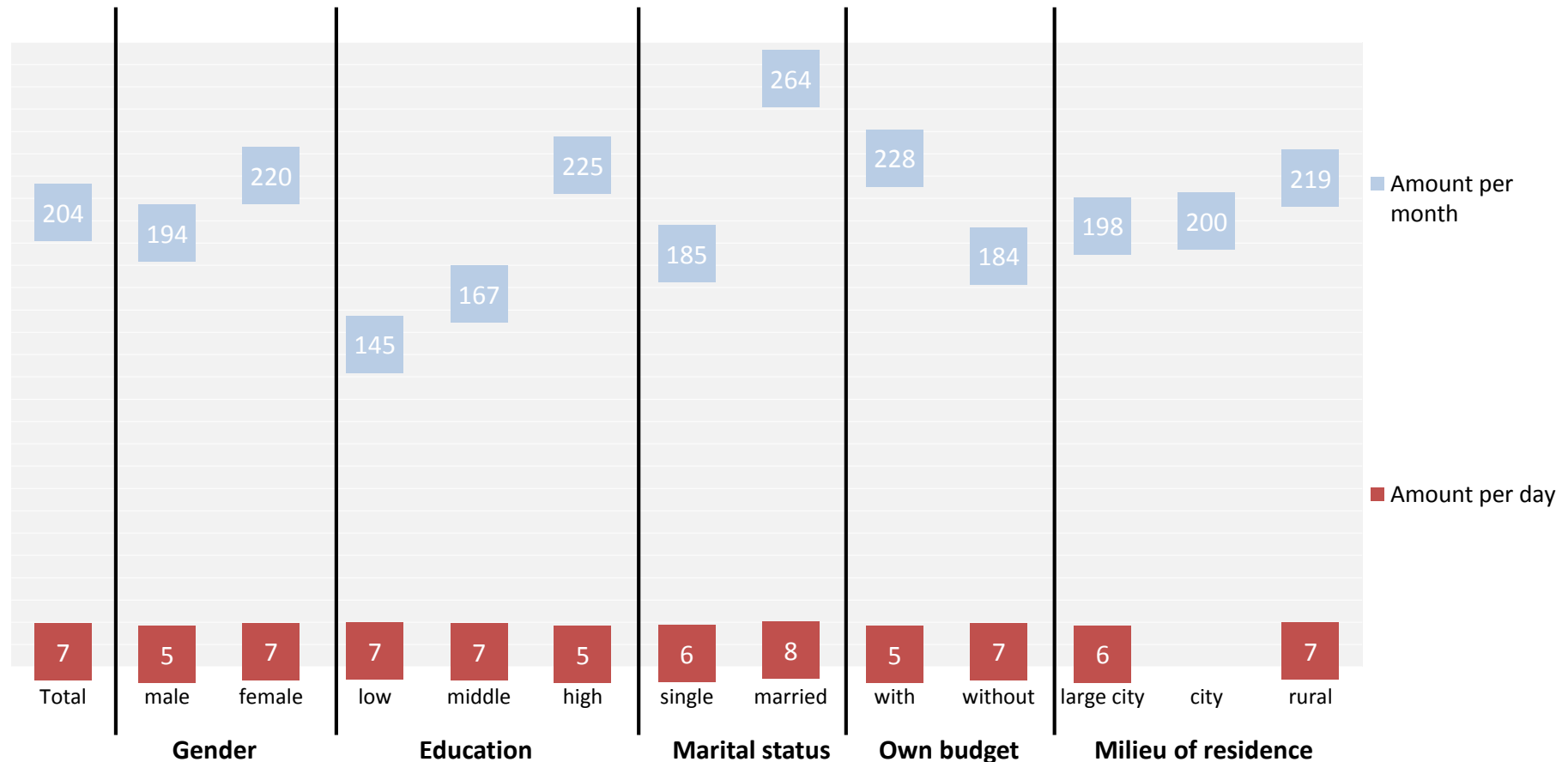

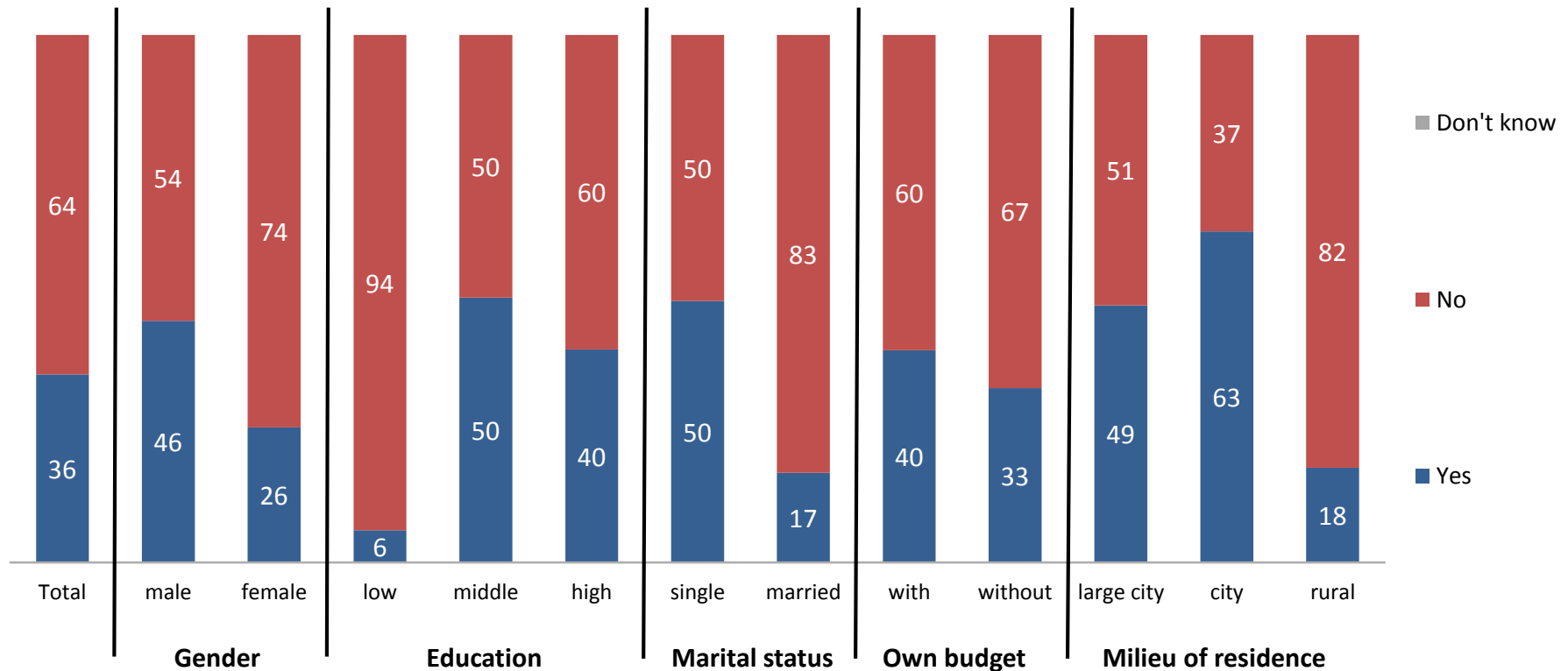
Yemen: Mother's income (in Euro)

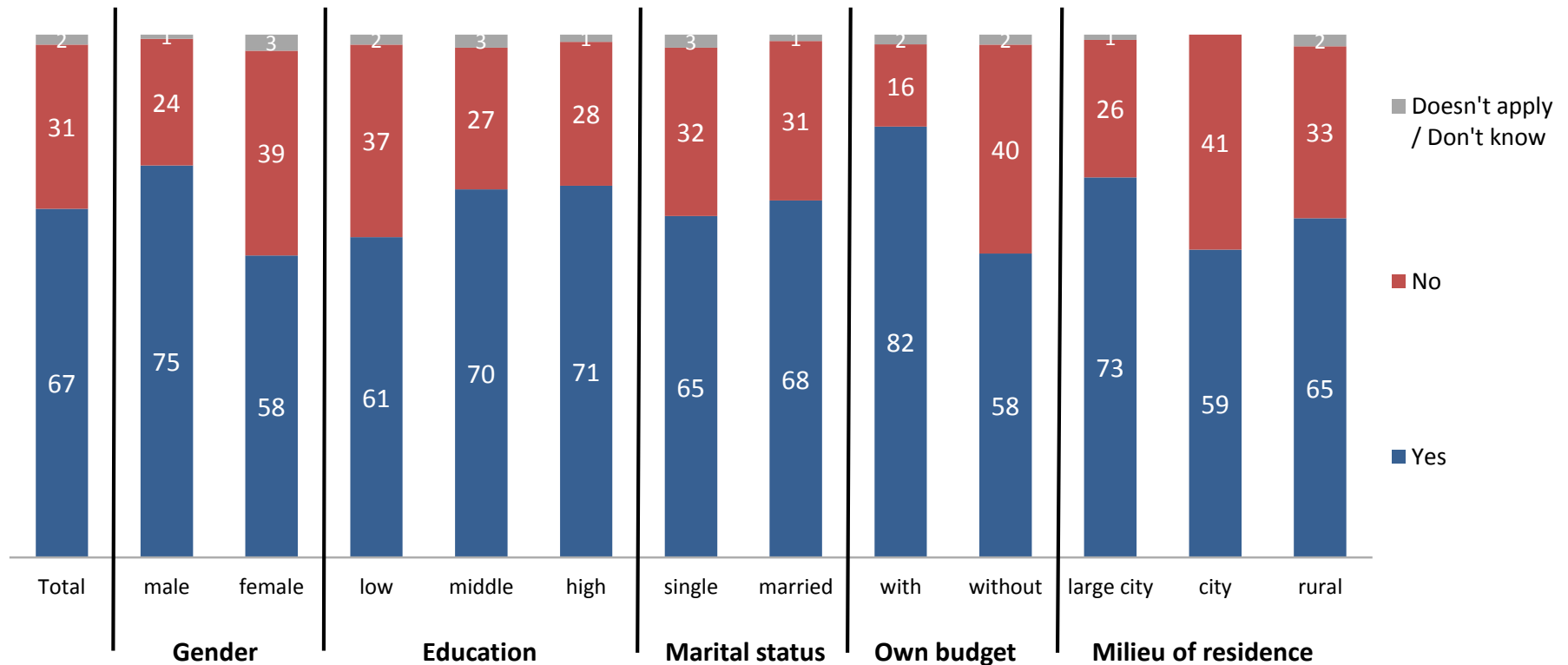

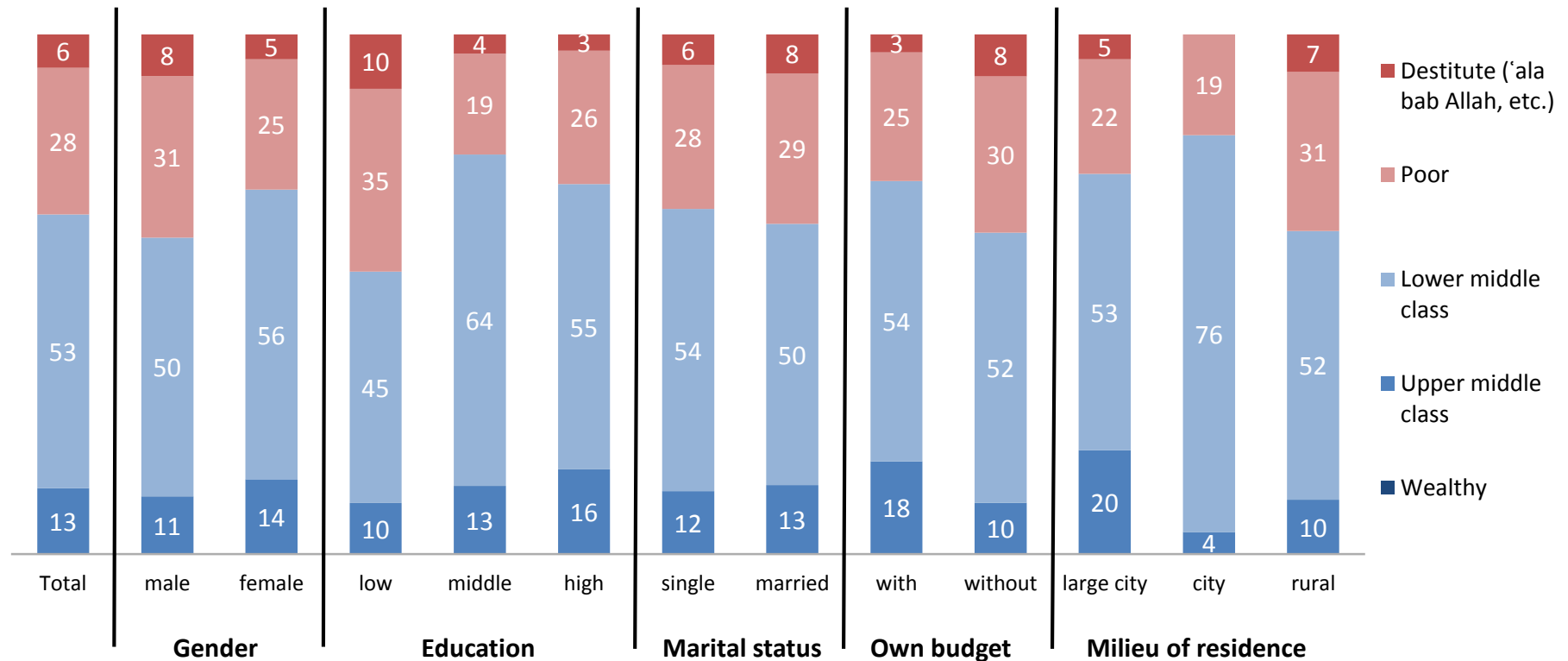

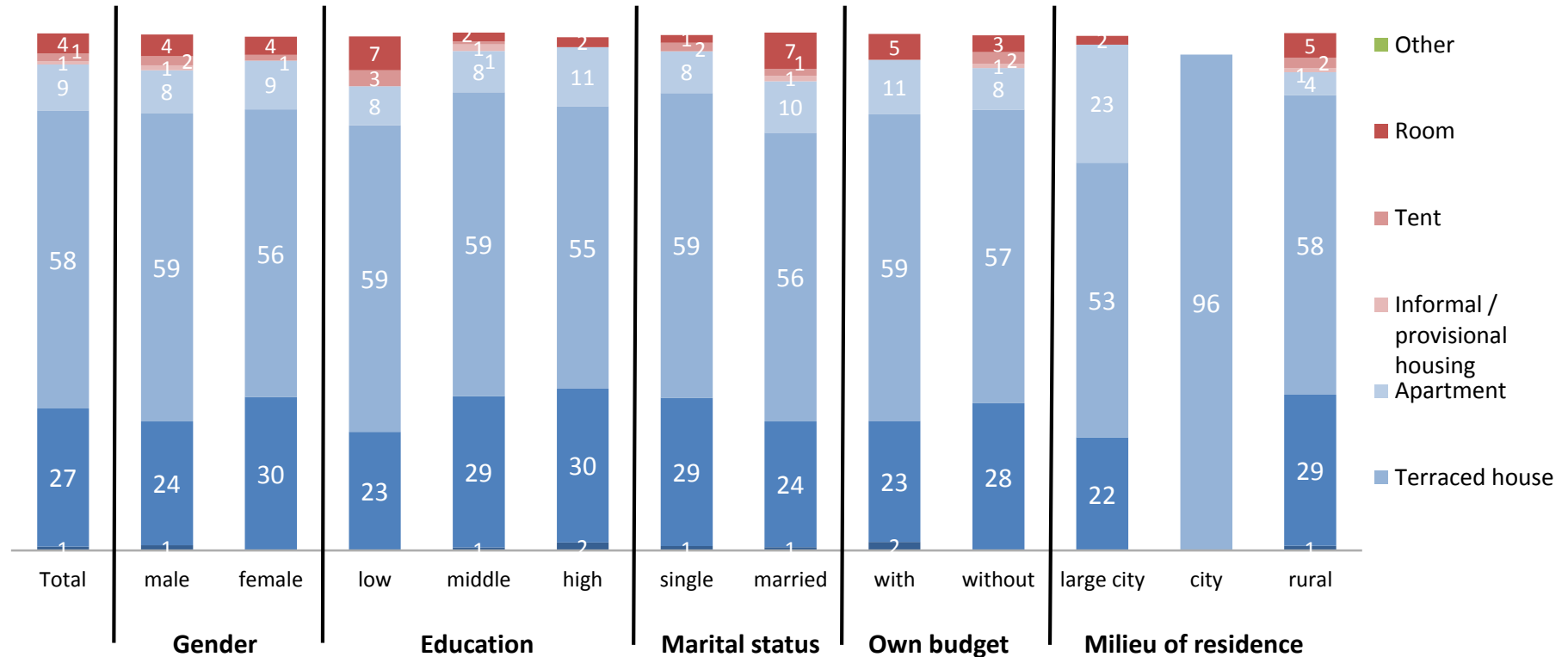

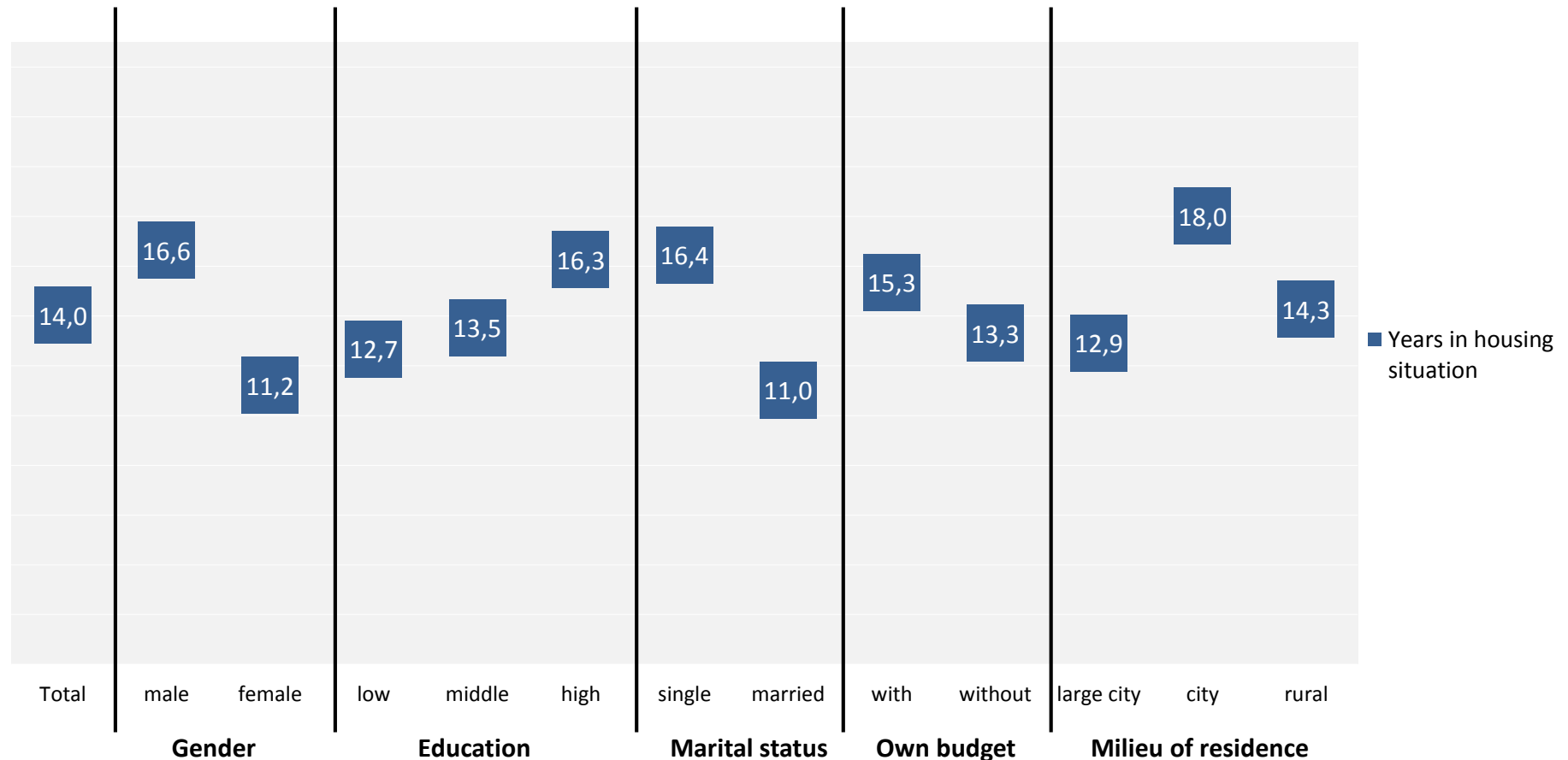
Yemen: Type of housing / building

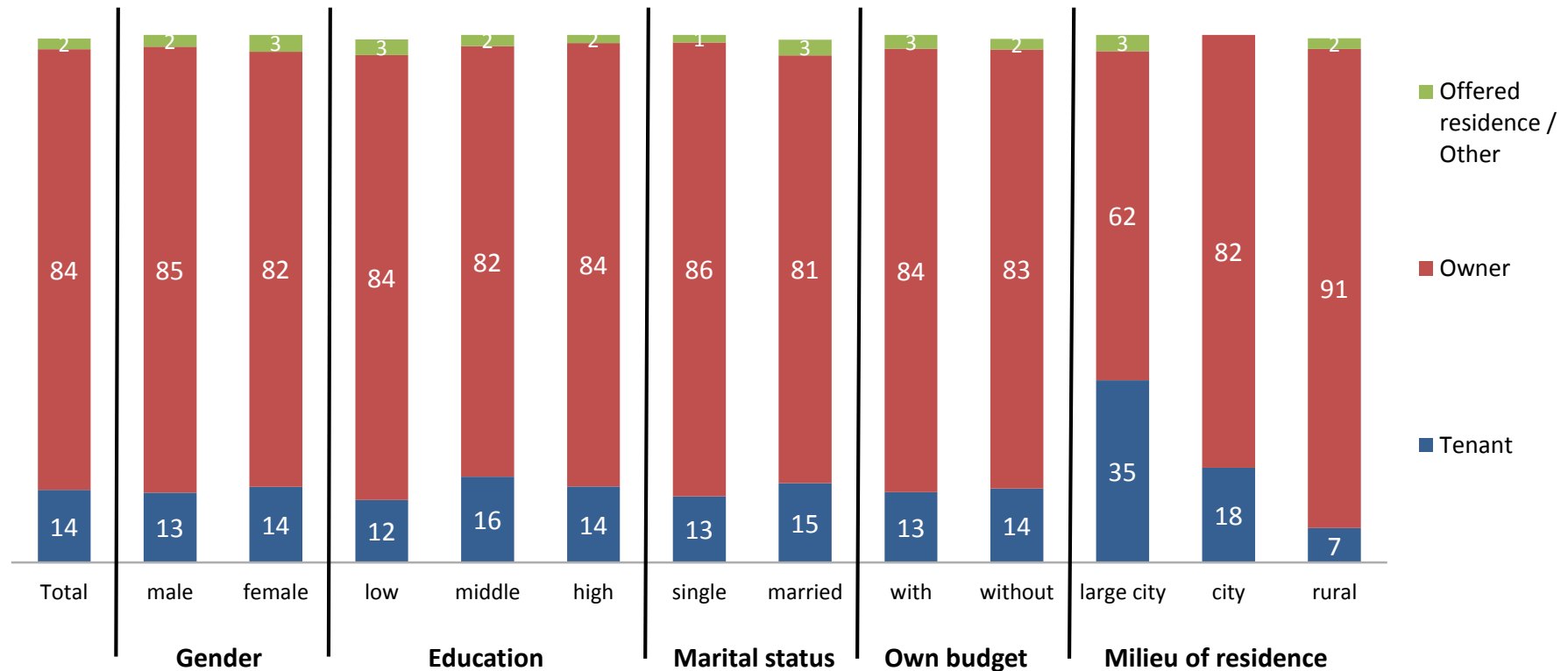
Yemen: Years in housing situation

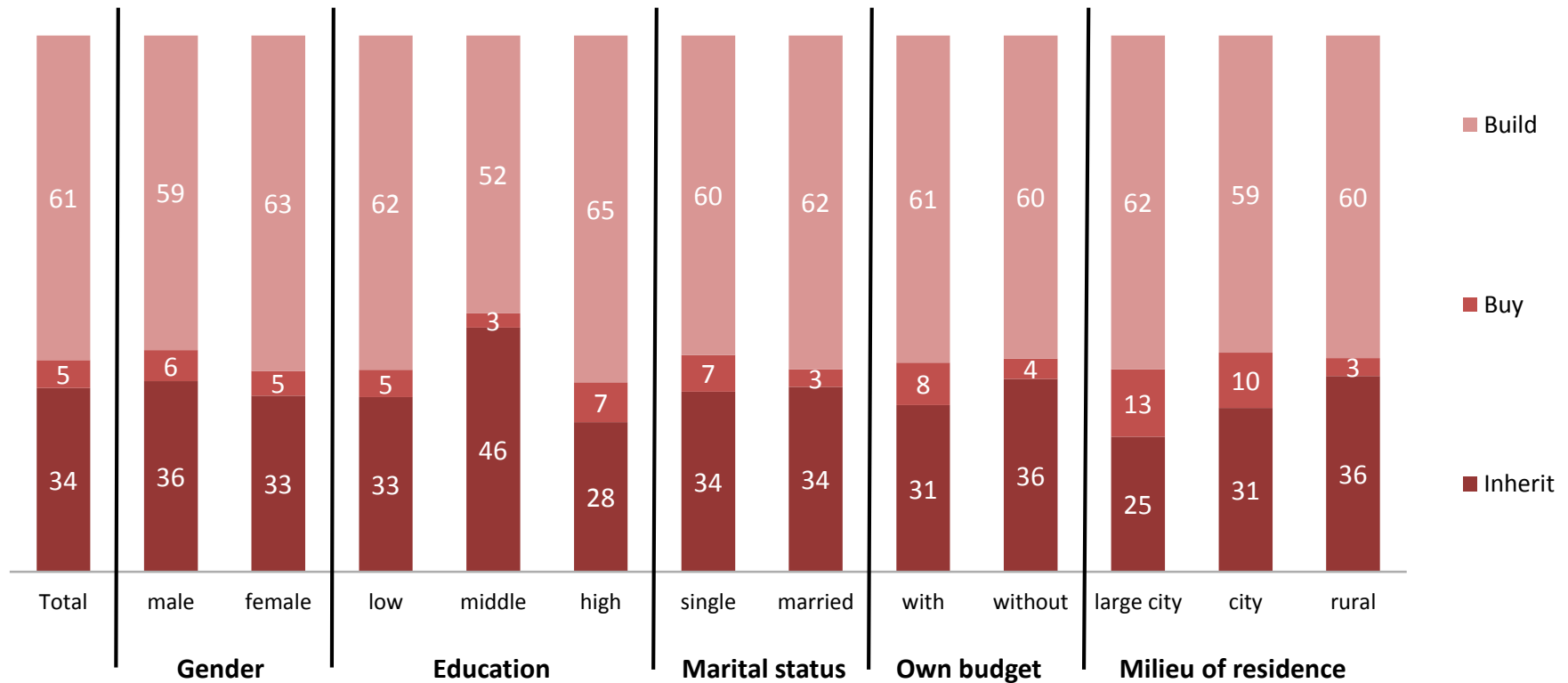

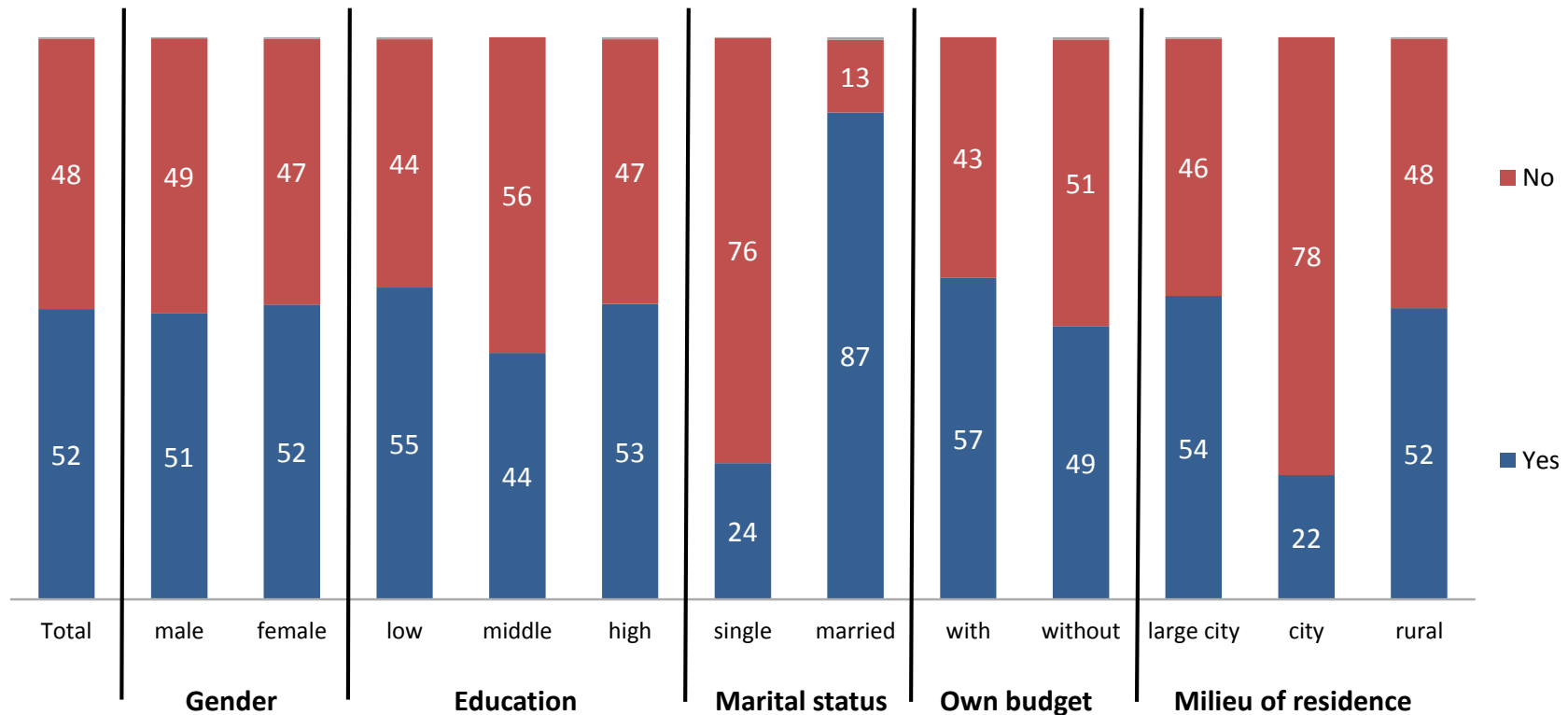

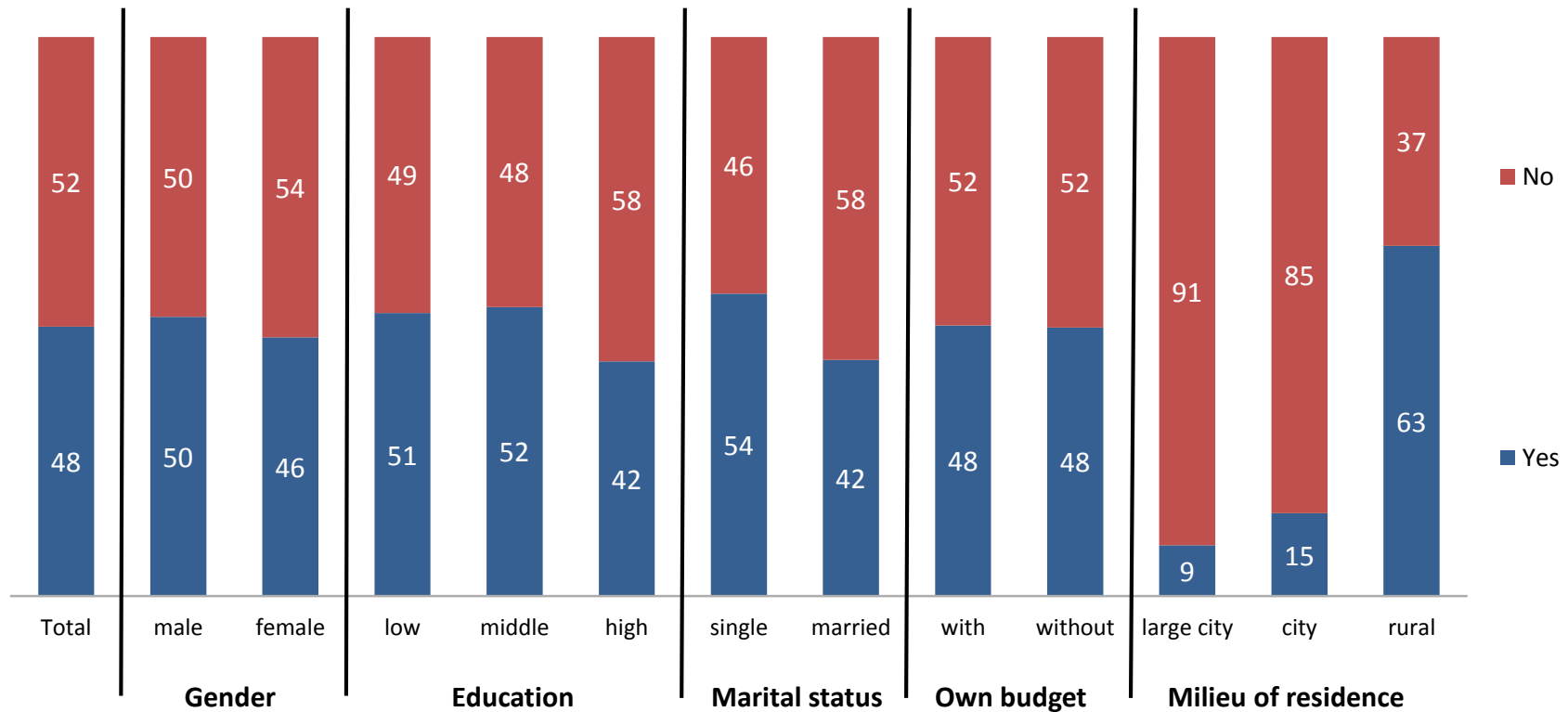

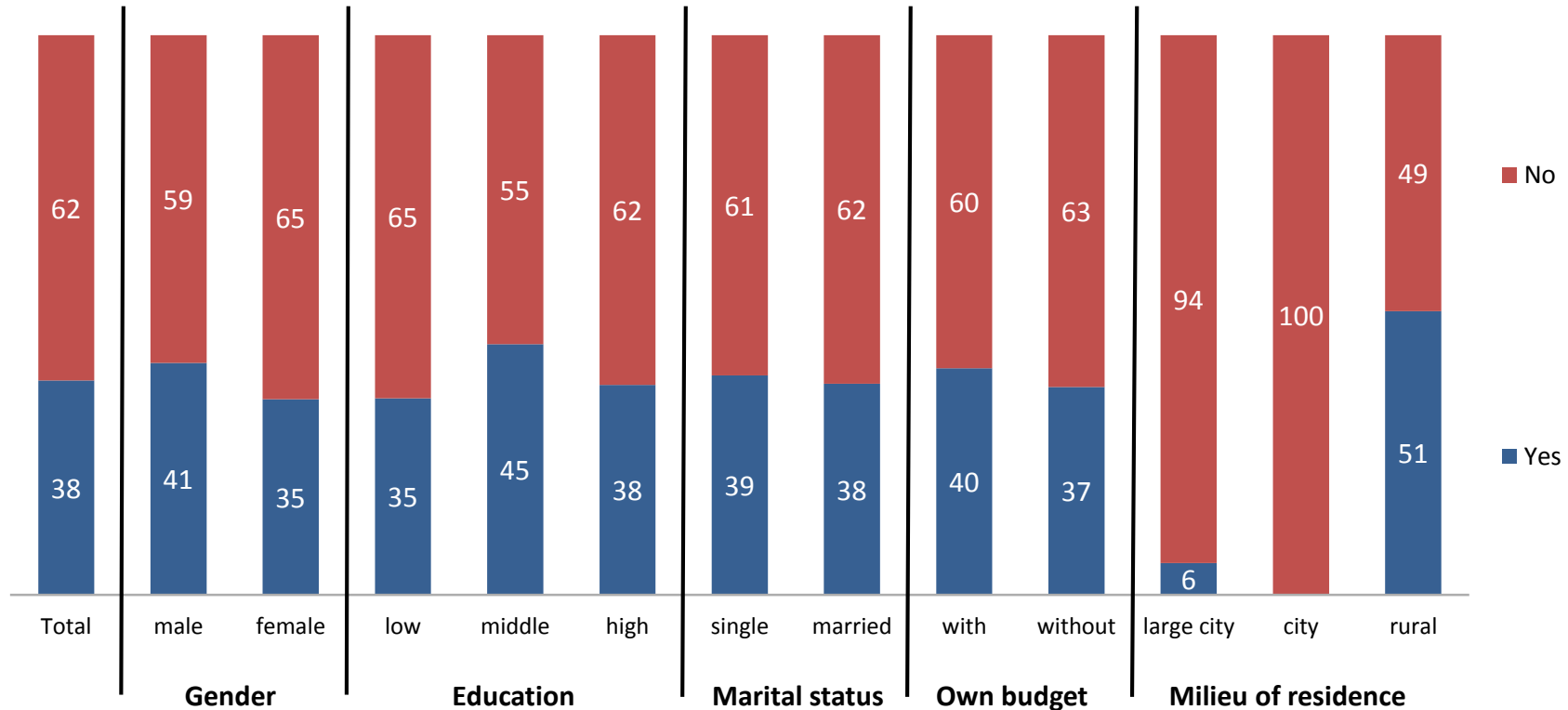

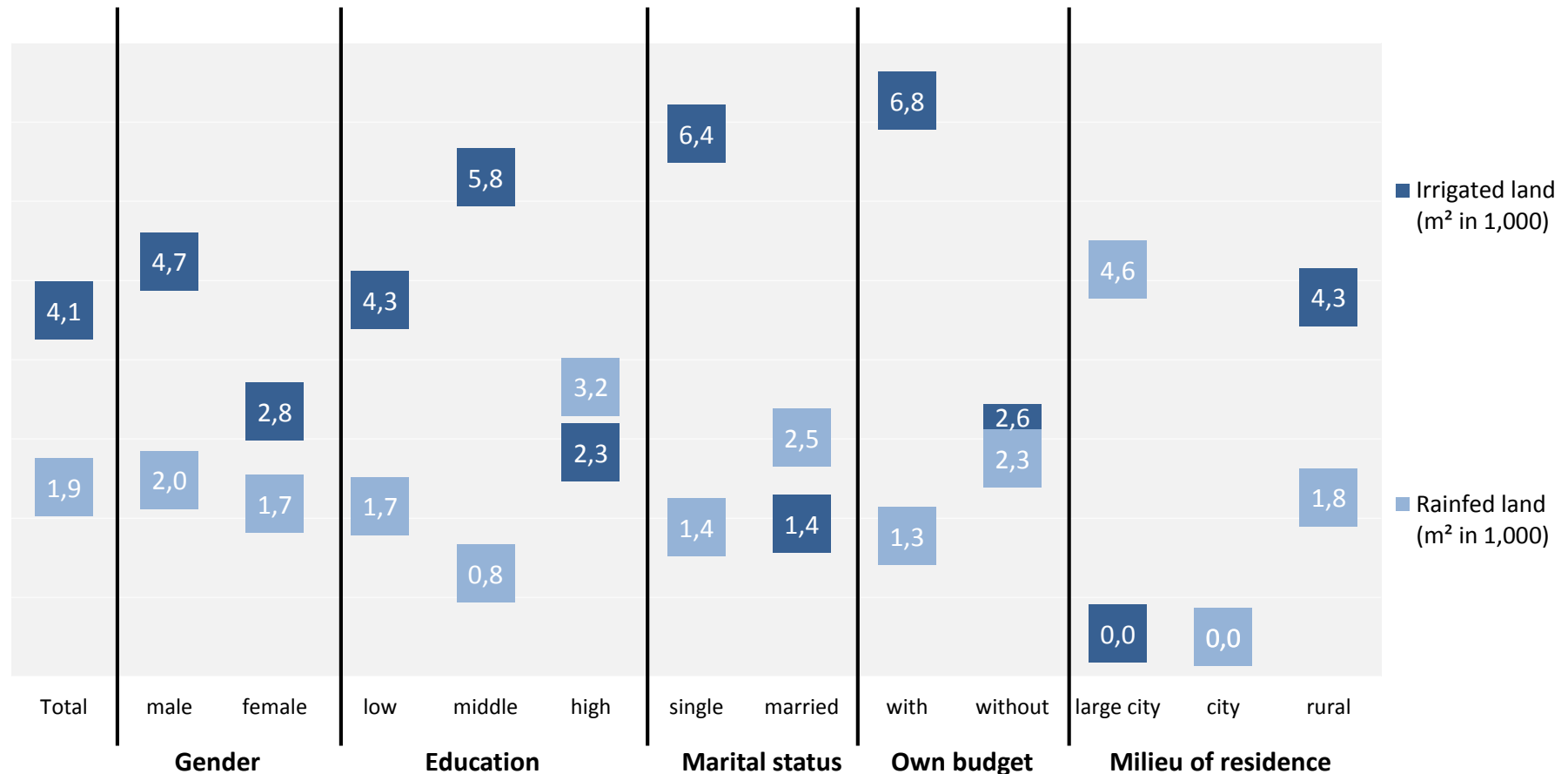
Yemen: Agricultural land owned

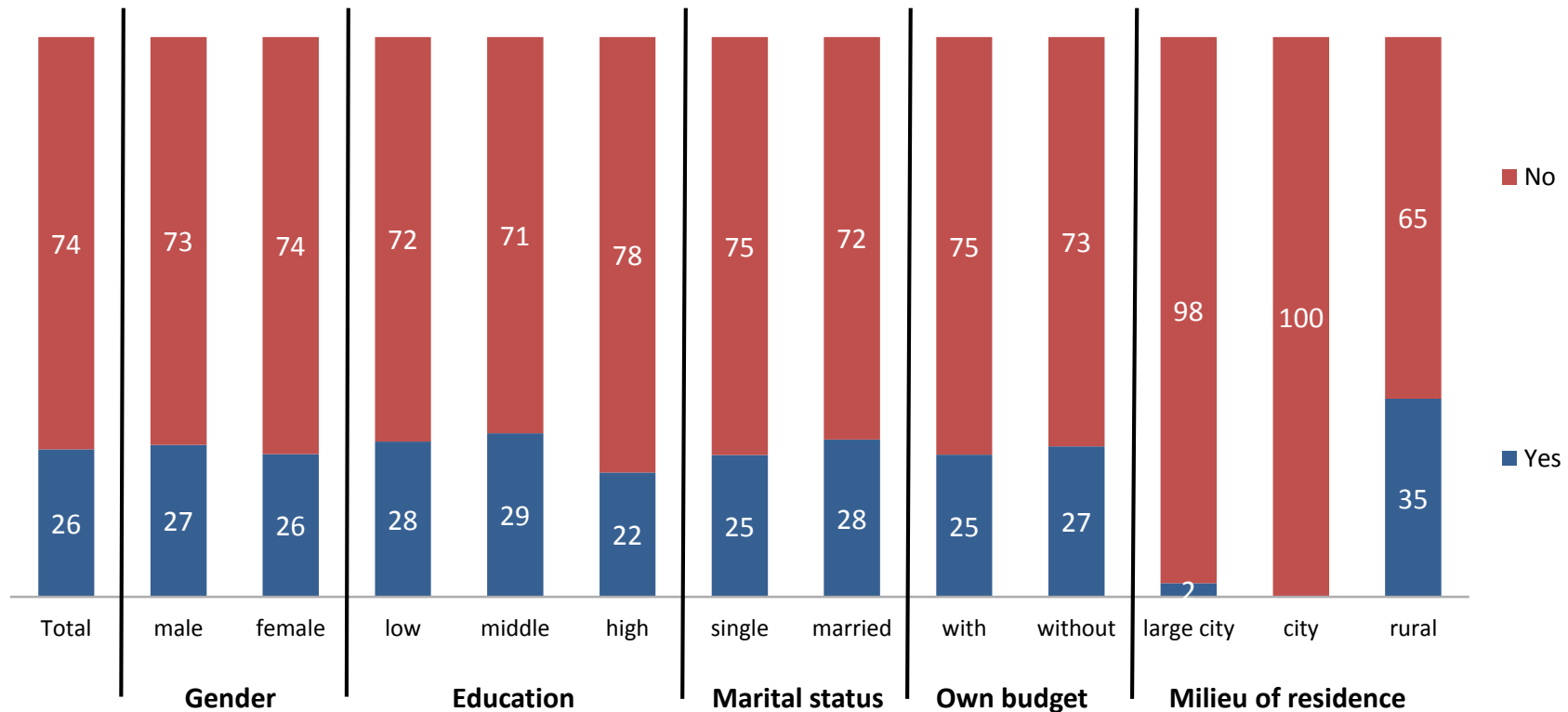
Yemen: Size of agricultural land owned

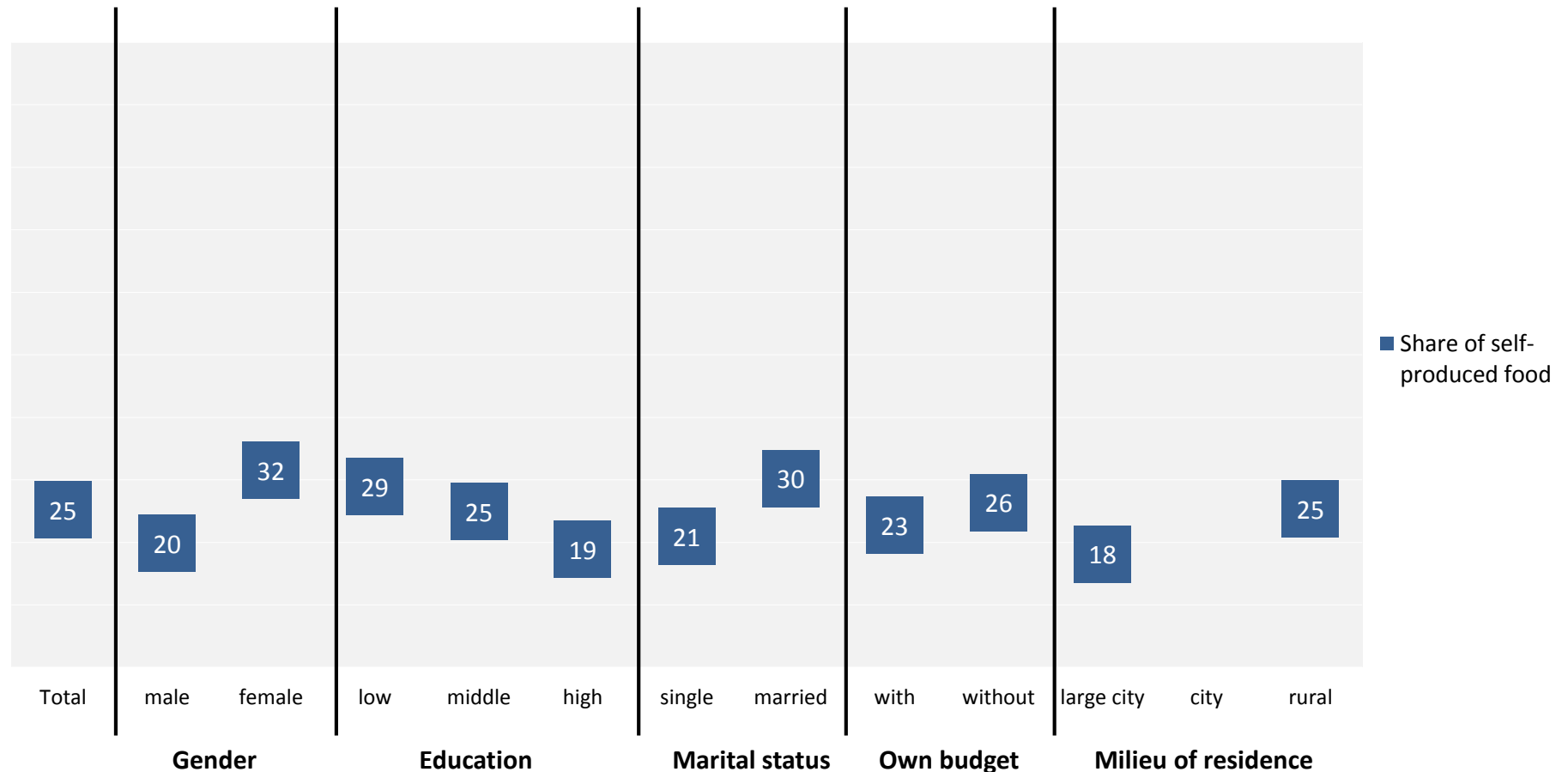

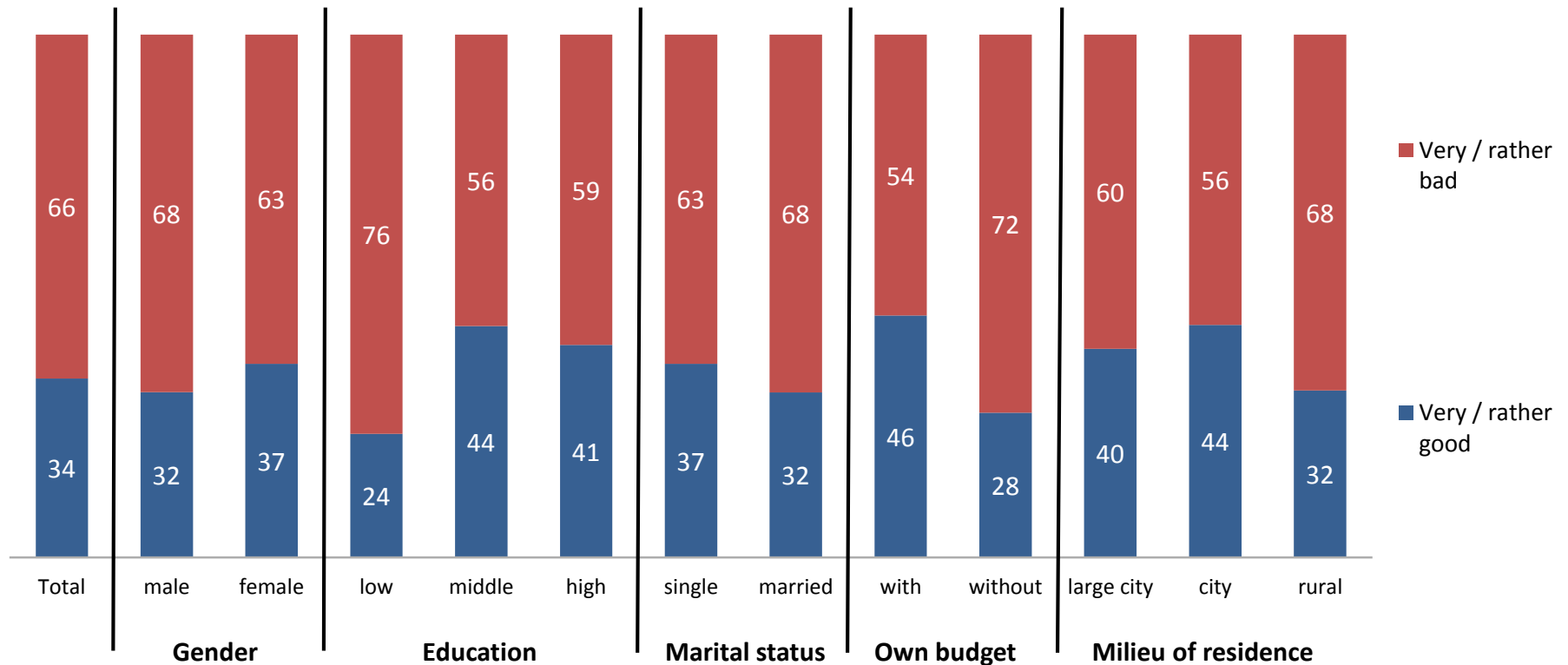

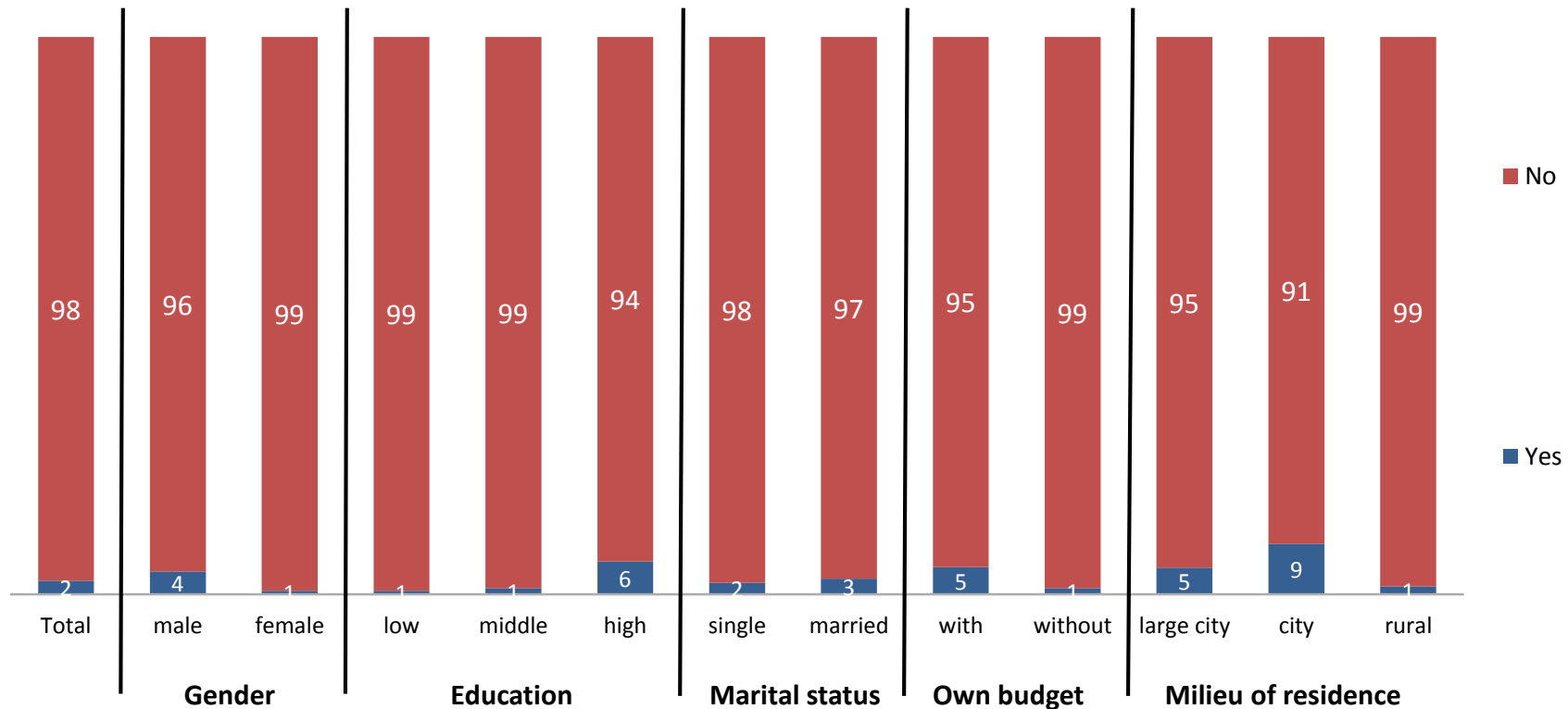

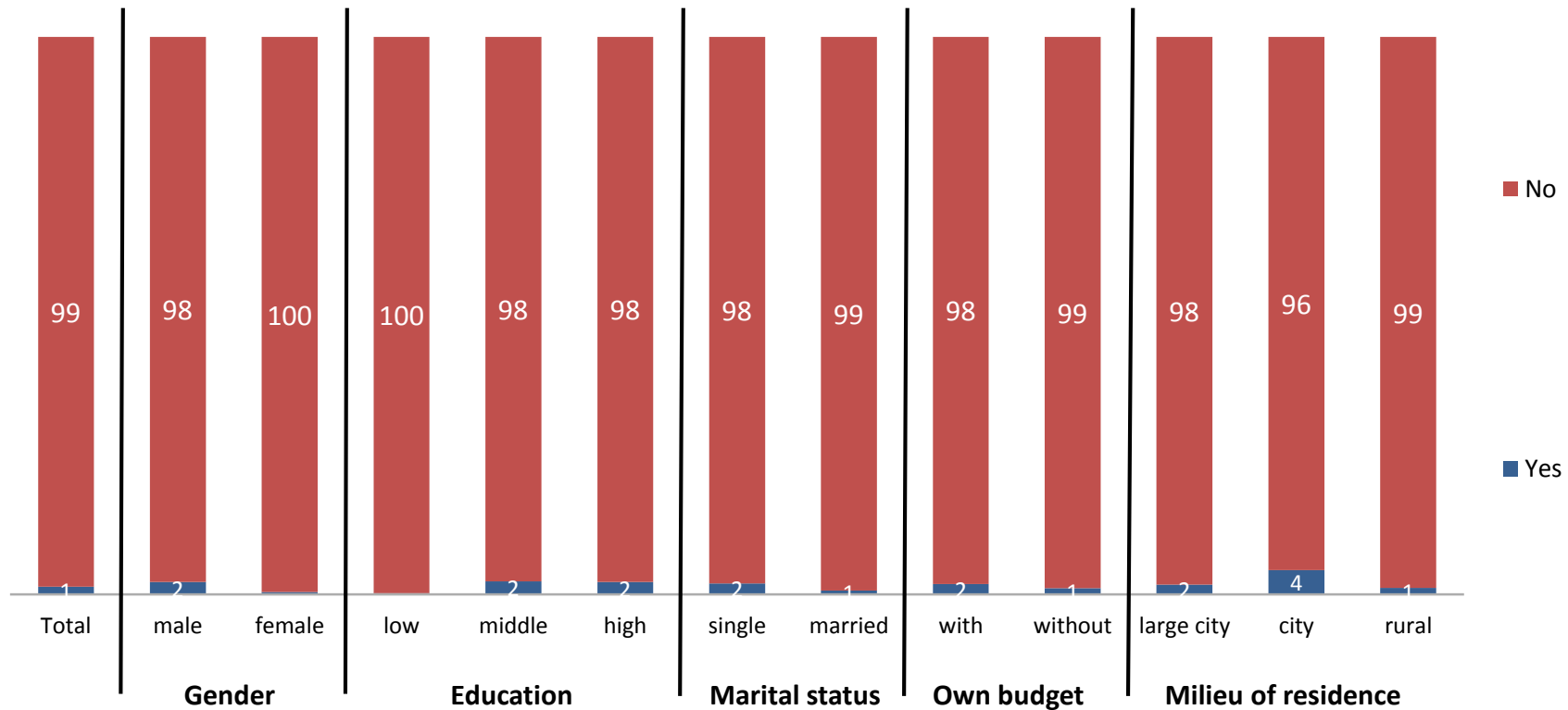
Yemen: Own private bank or postal account

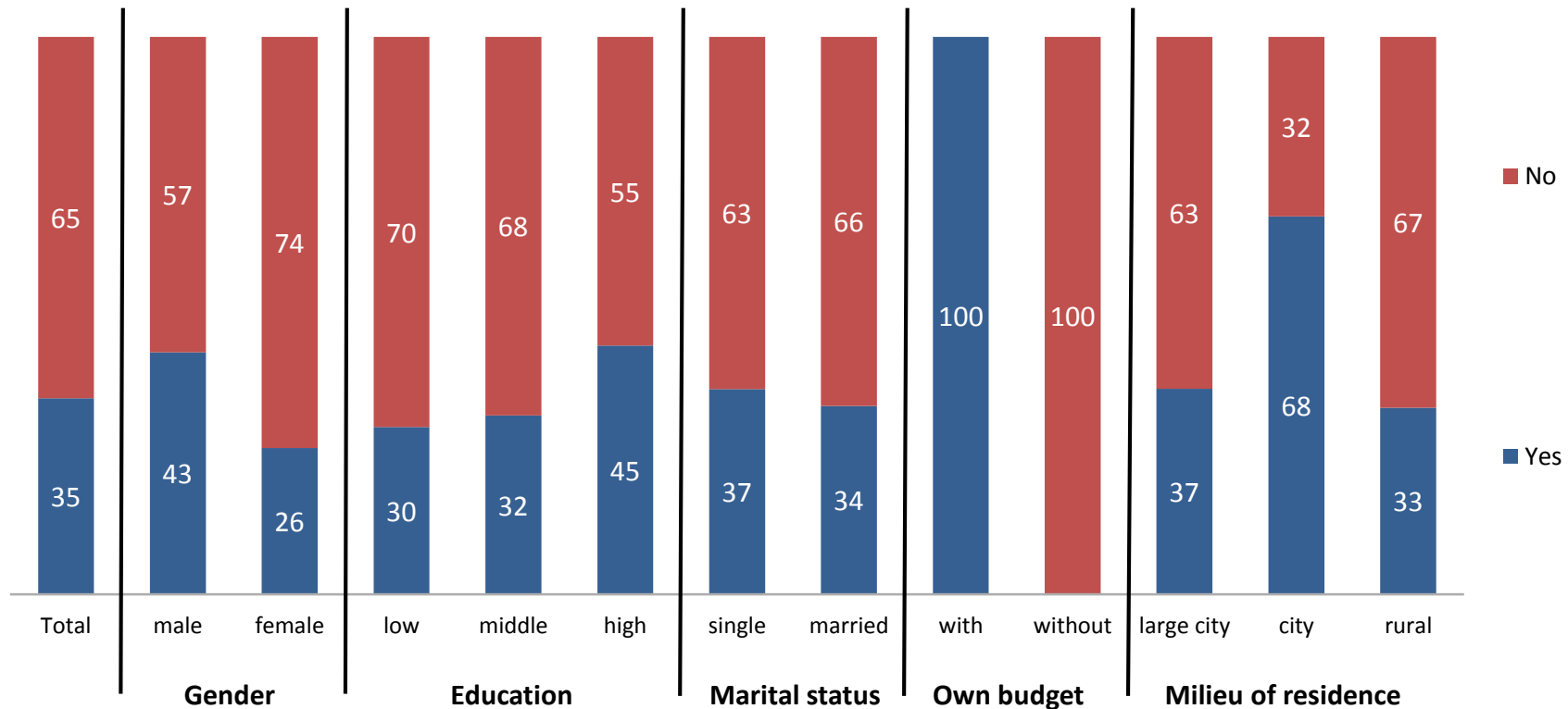

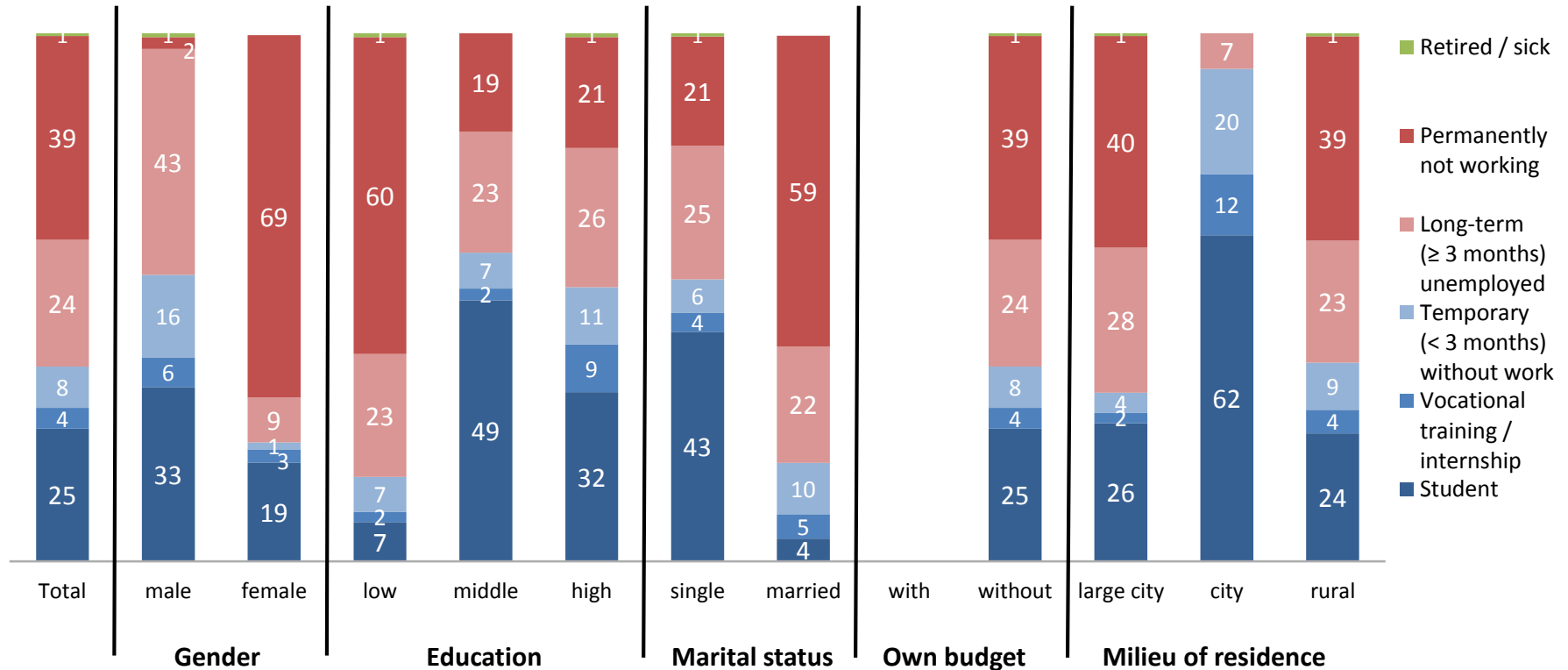

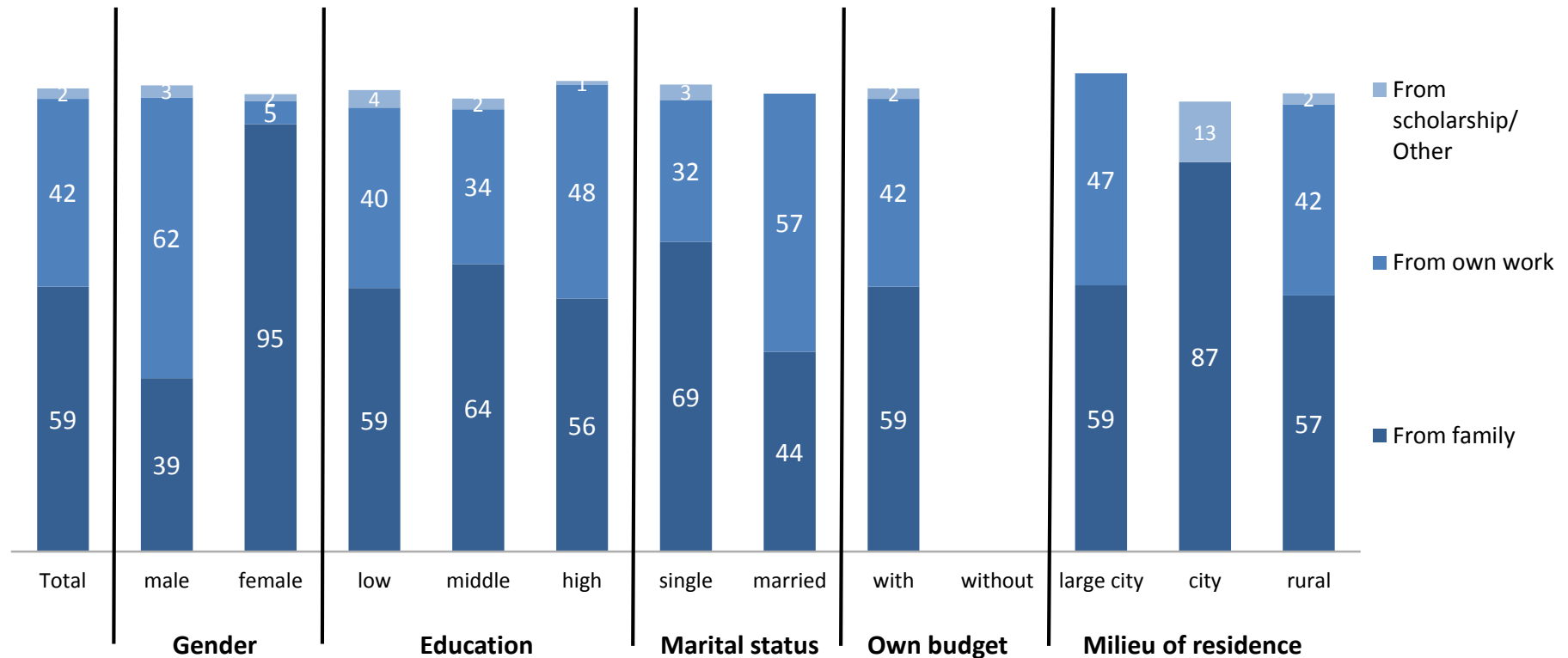
Yemen: No money at disposal – current situation

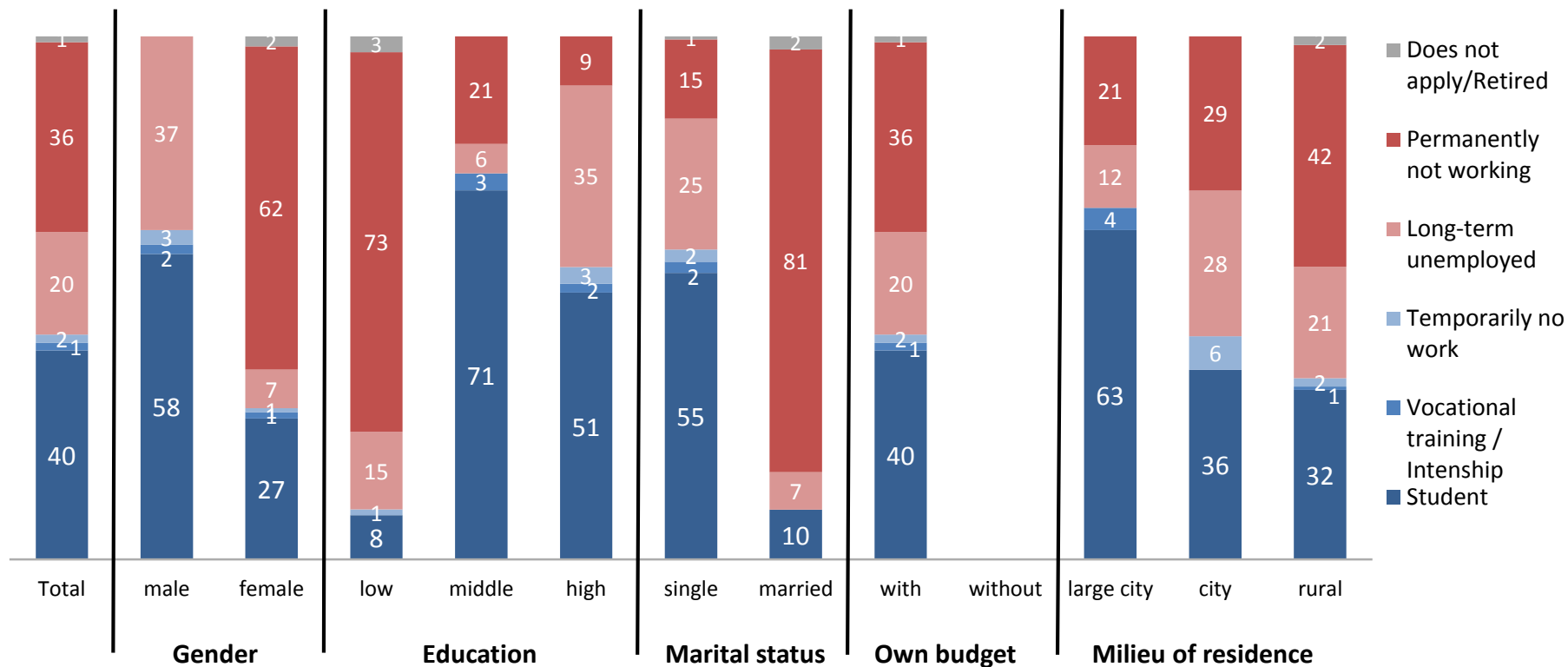
Yemen: Sources of budget

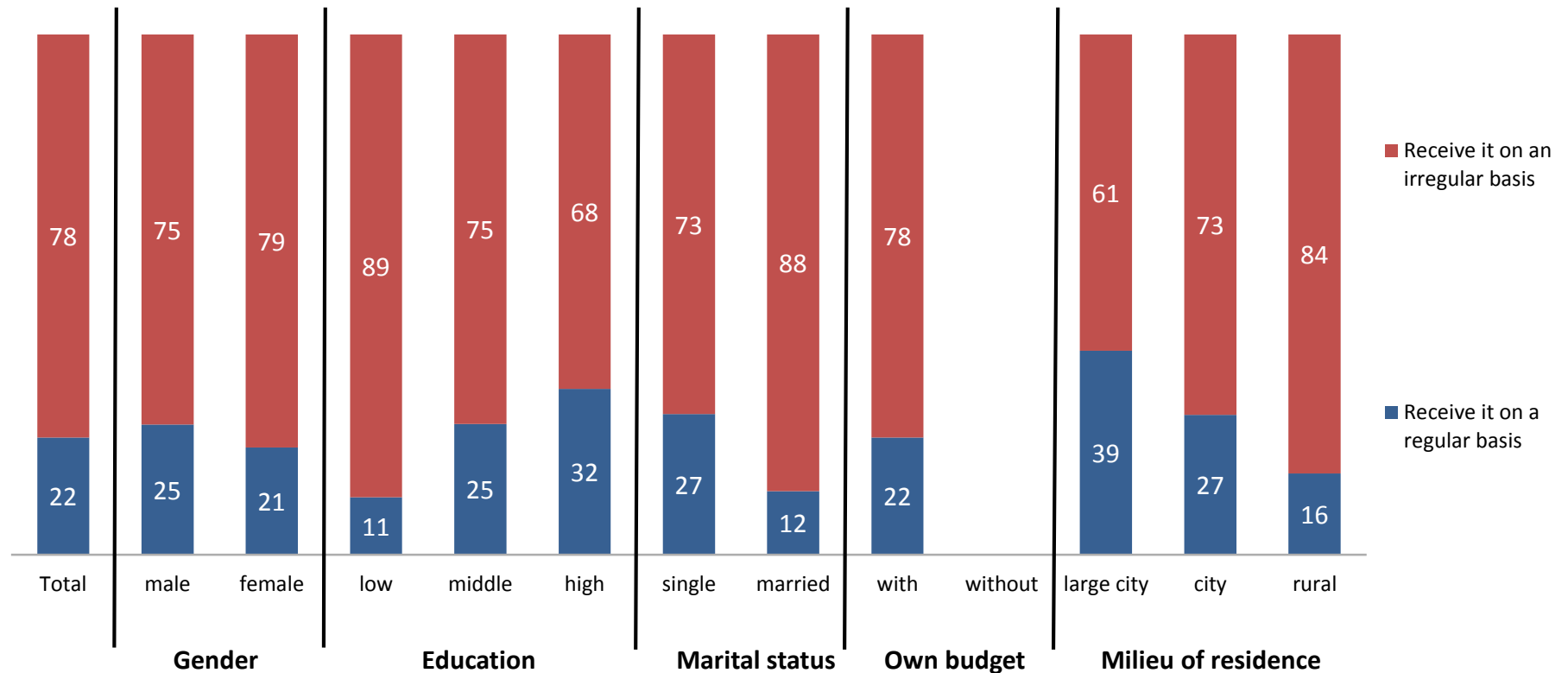

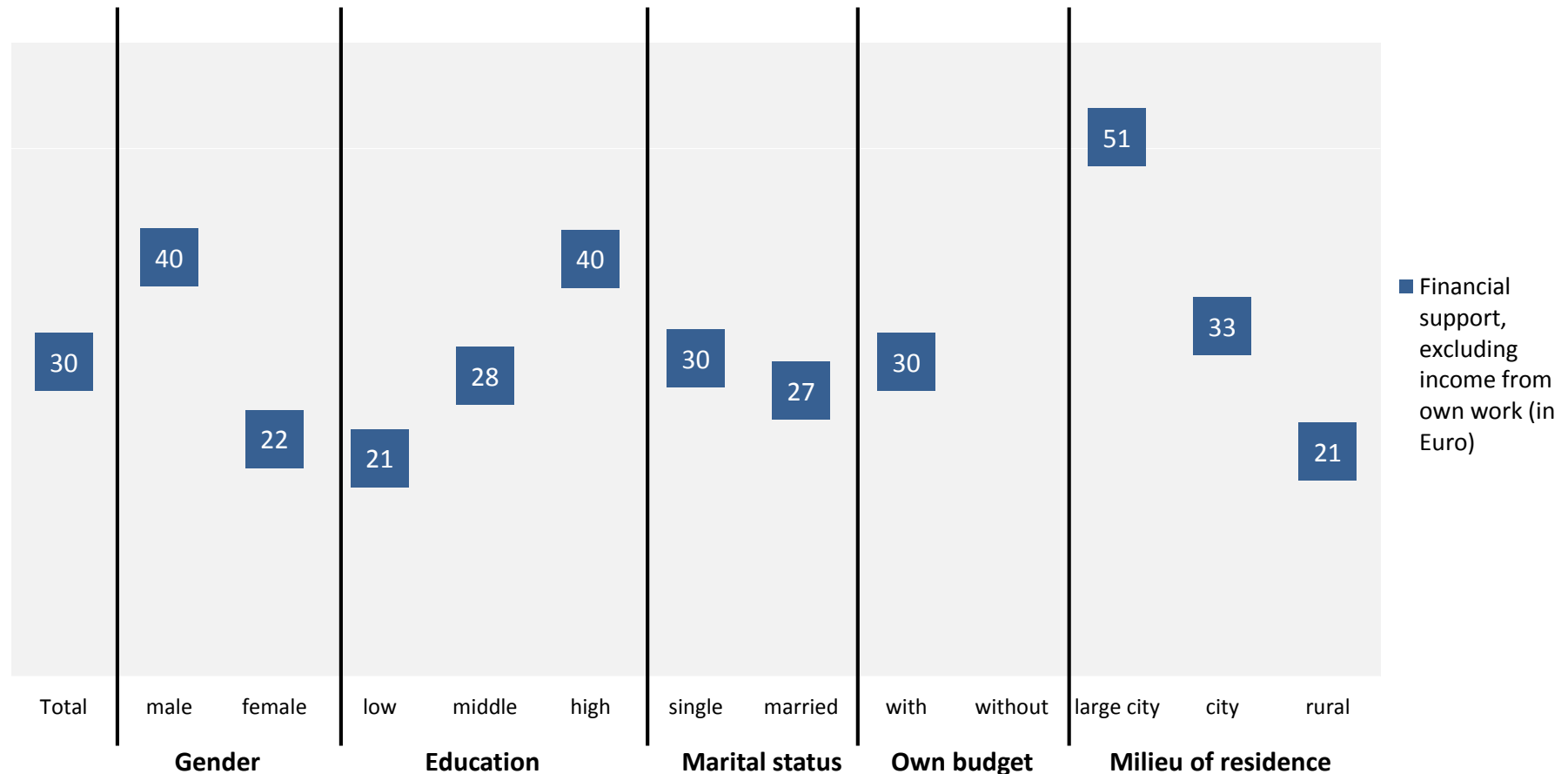

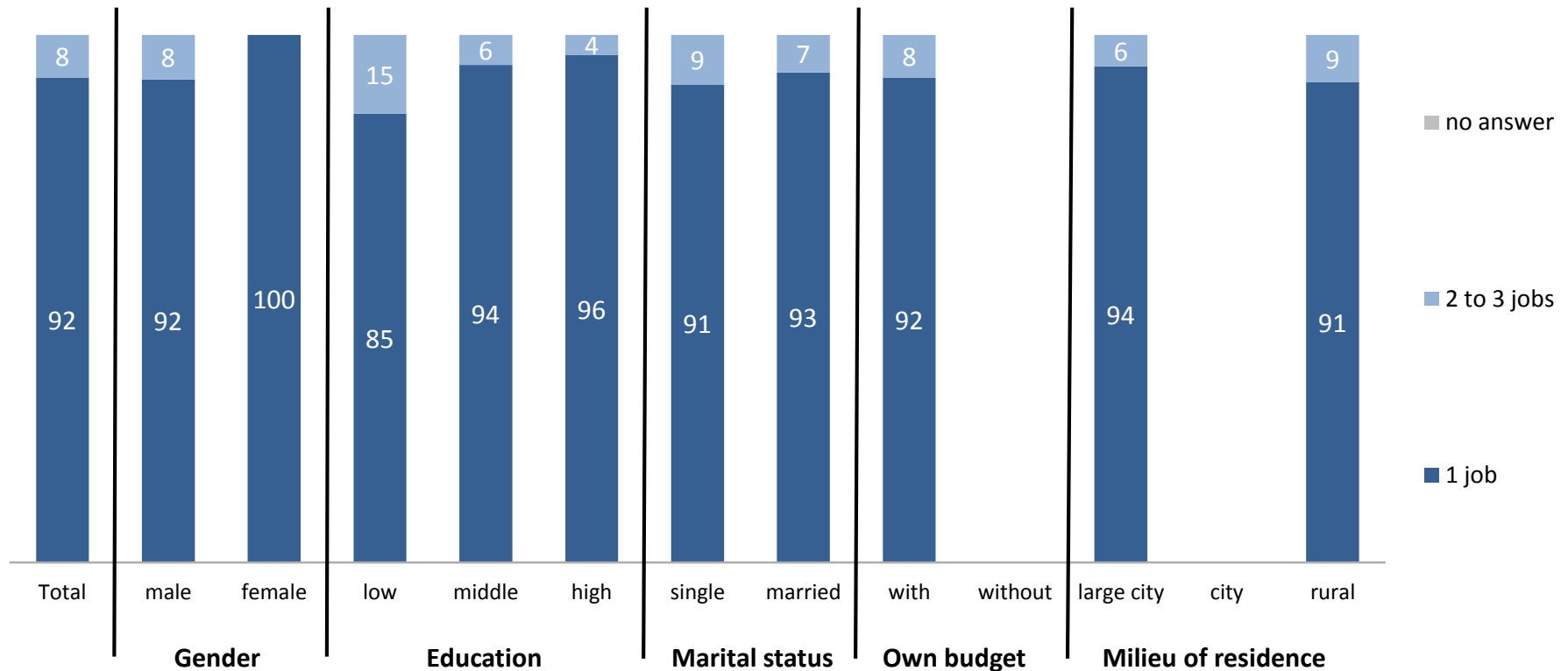

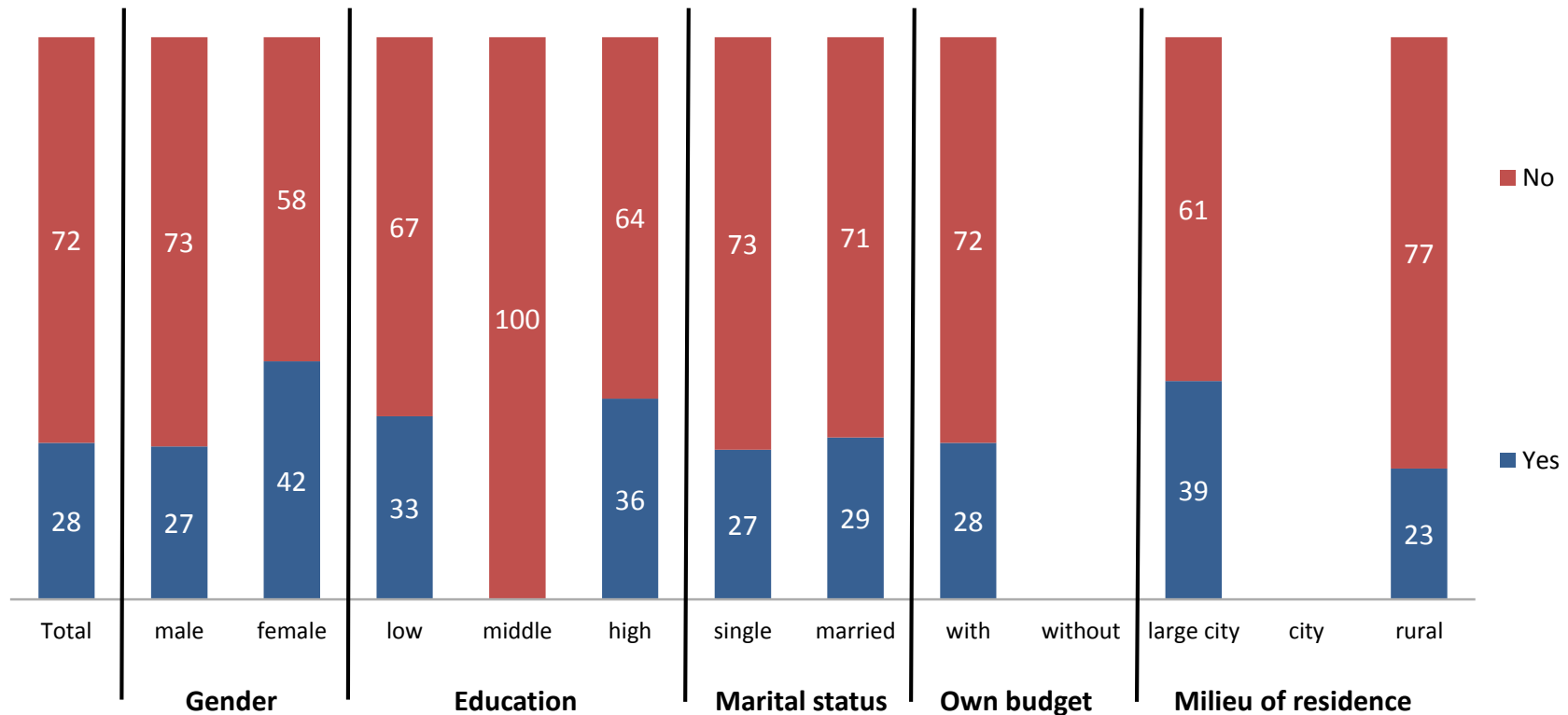
Yemen: Frequency of work – most important job

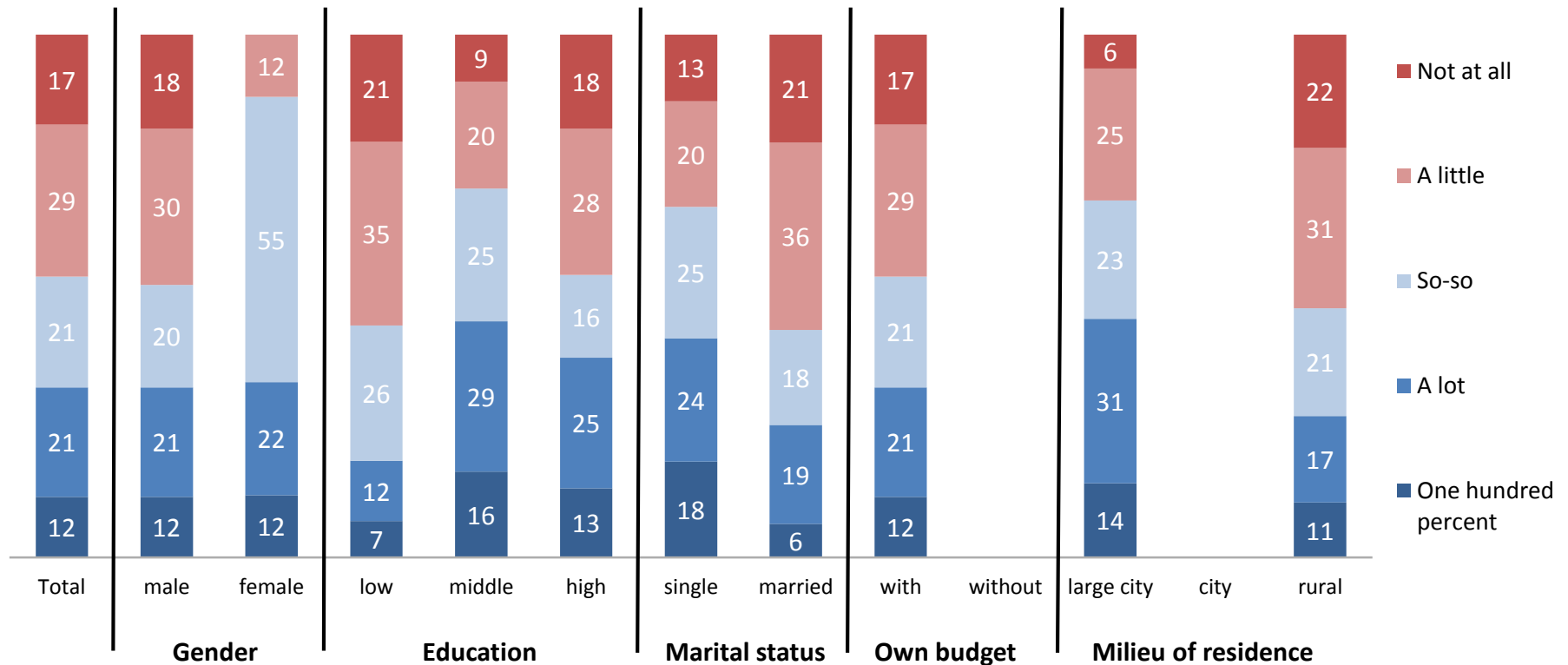

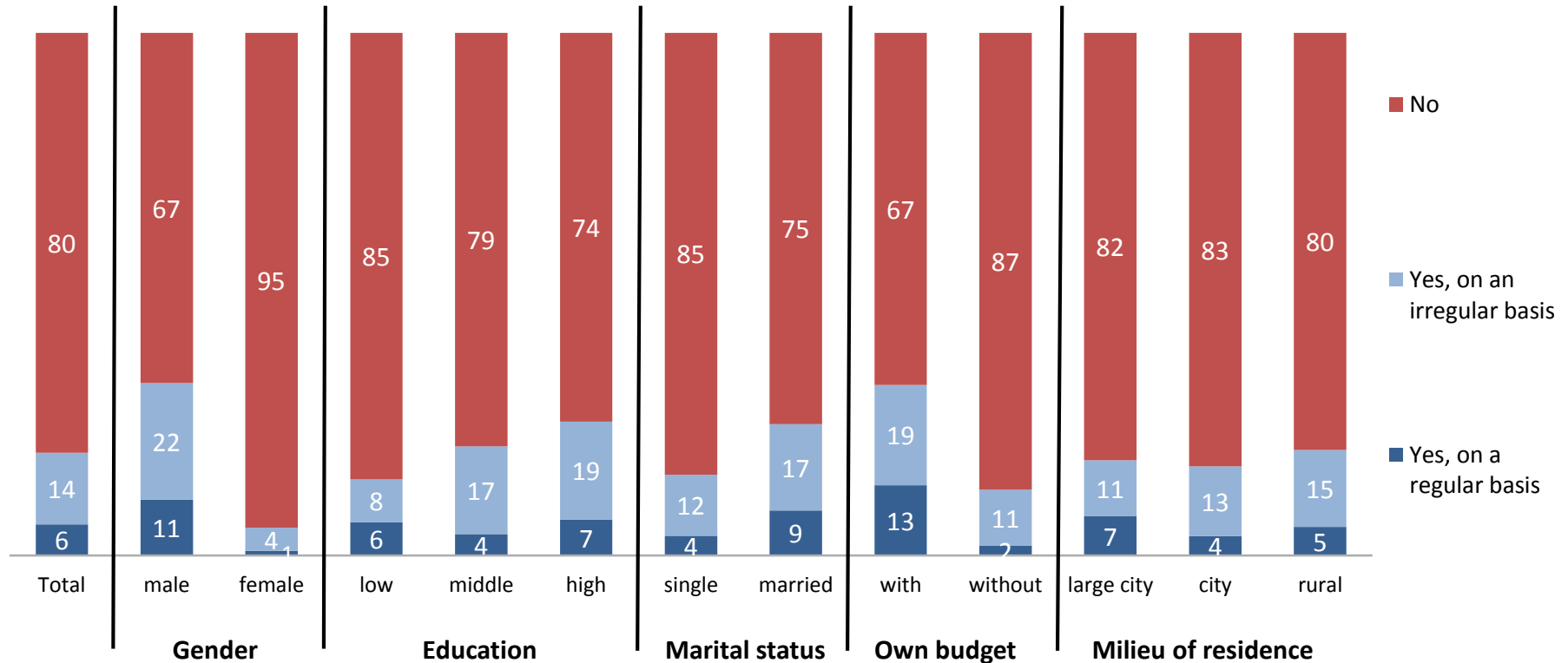

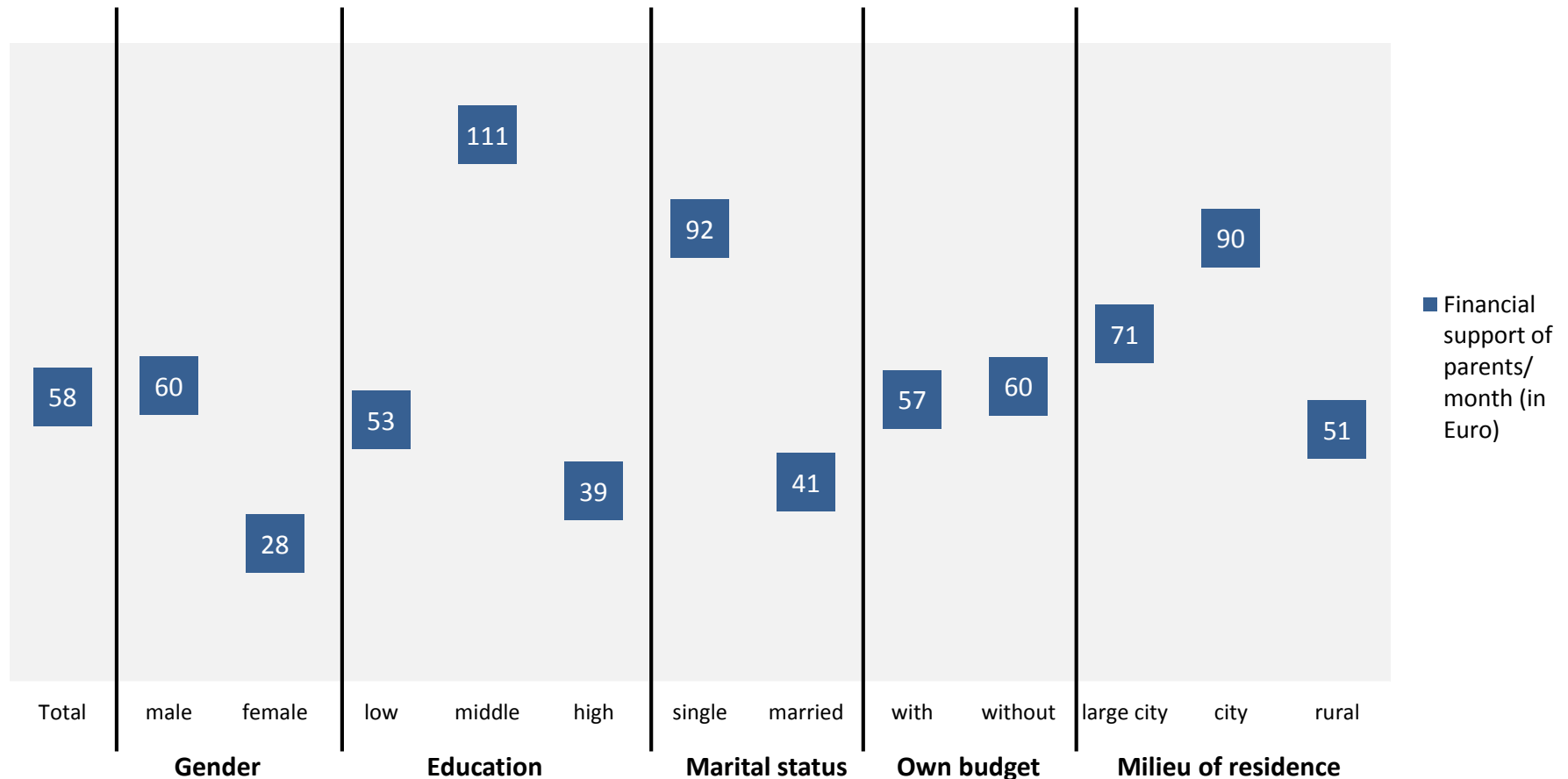

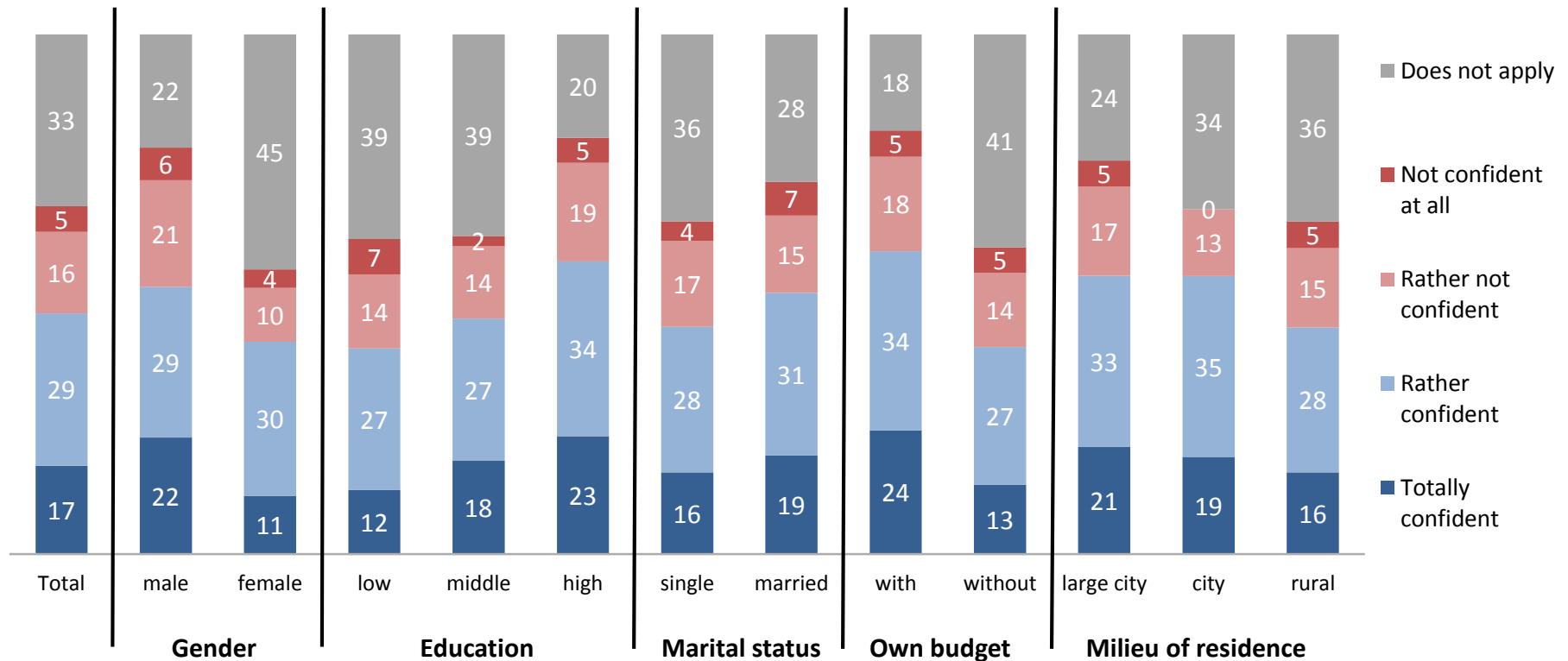

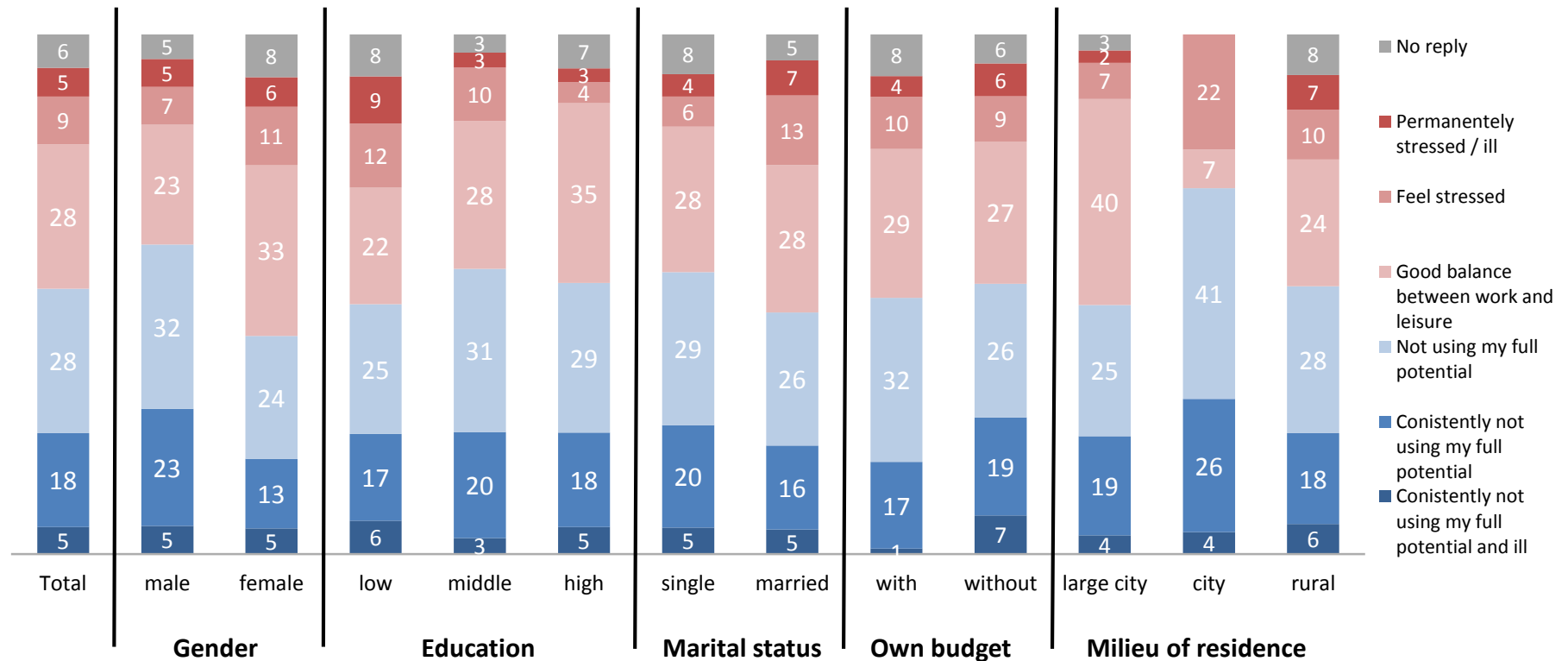
Yemen: Confidence in realizing job wishes

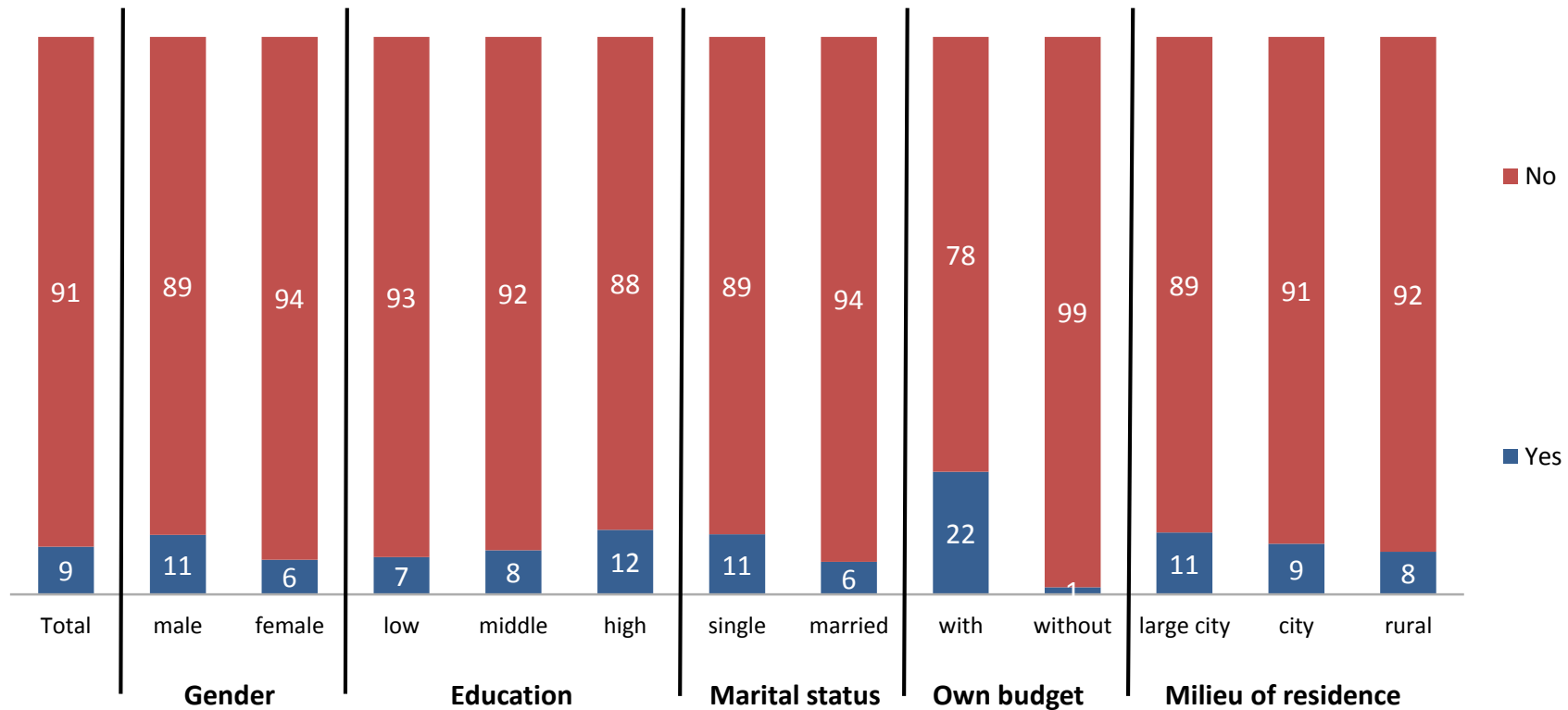
Yemen: Performance level

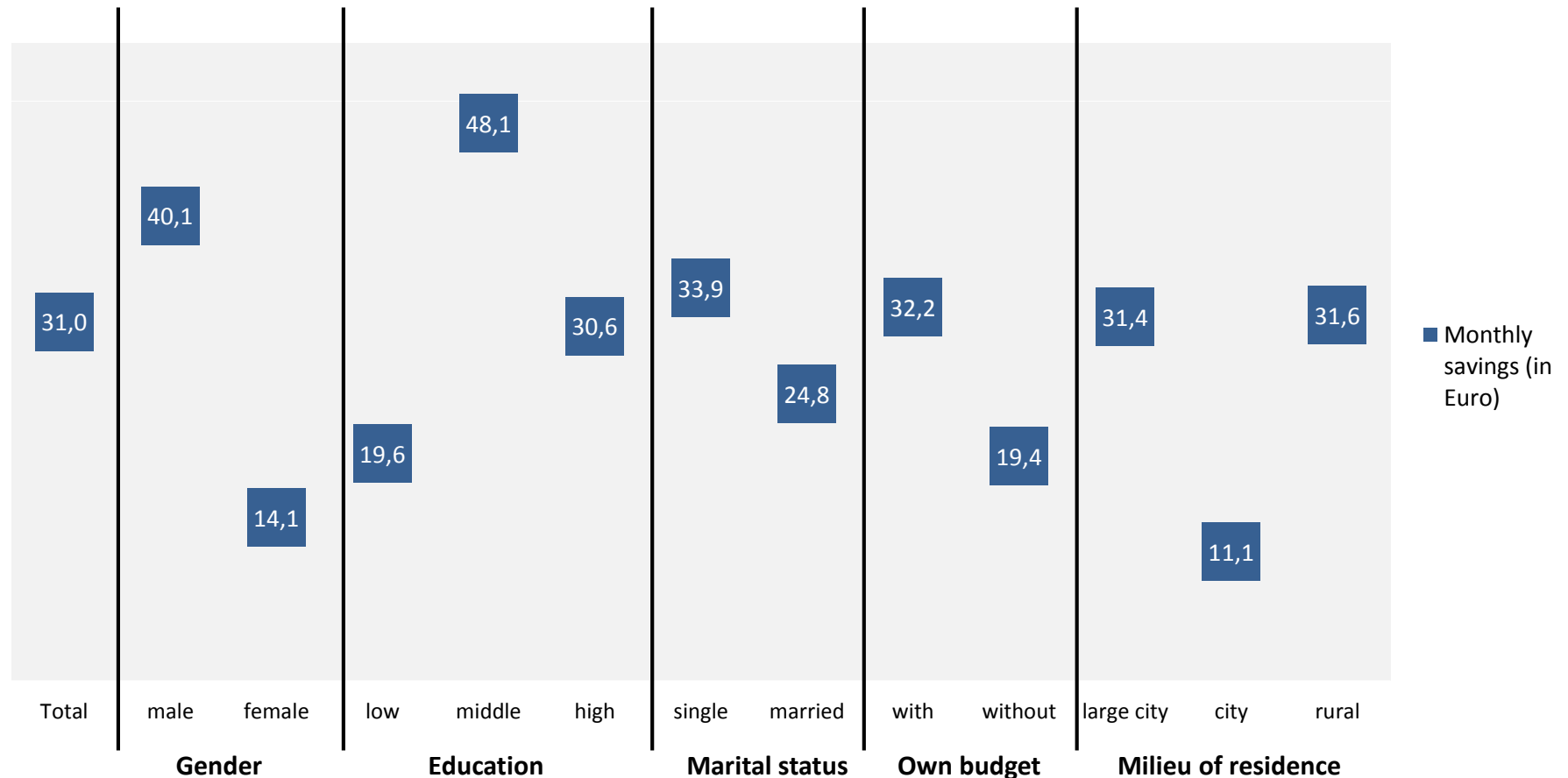

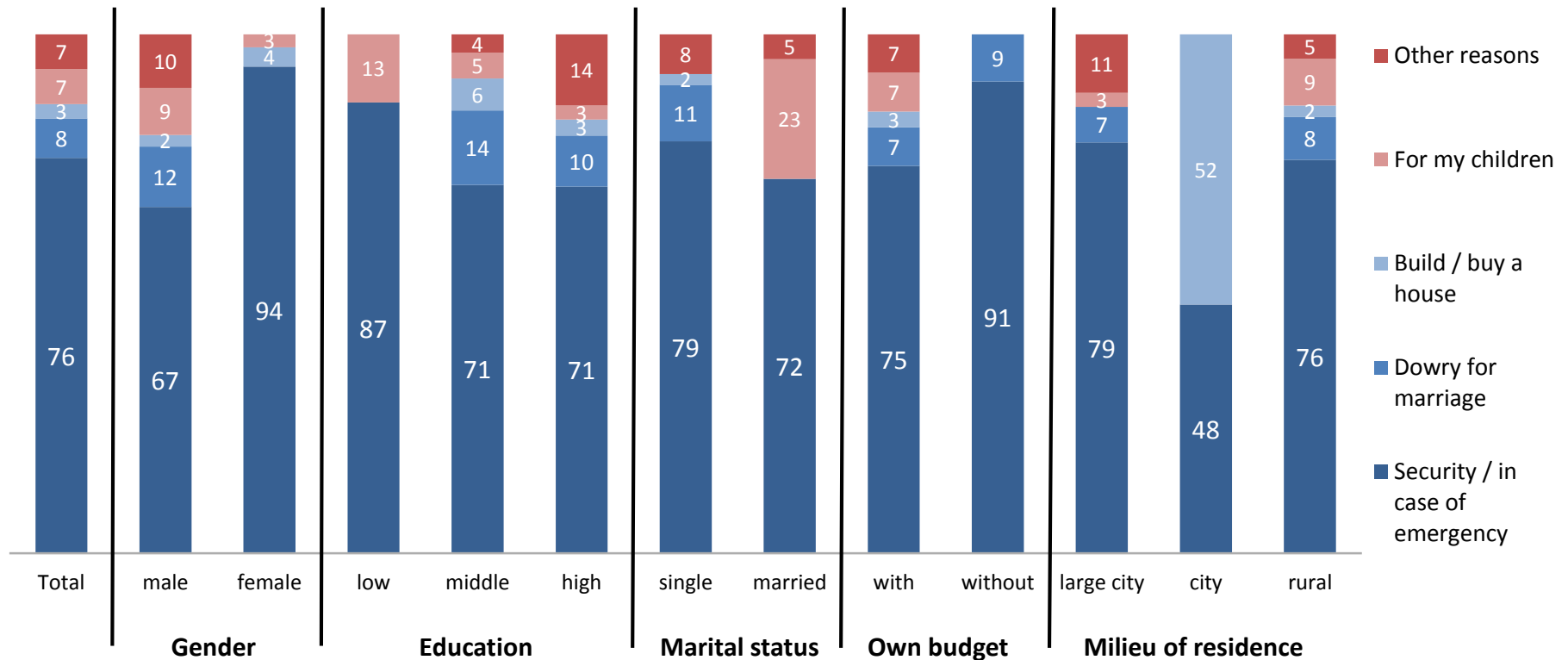
Yemen: Savings per month

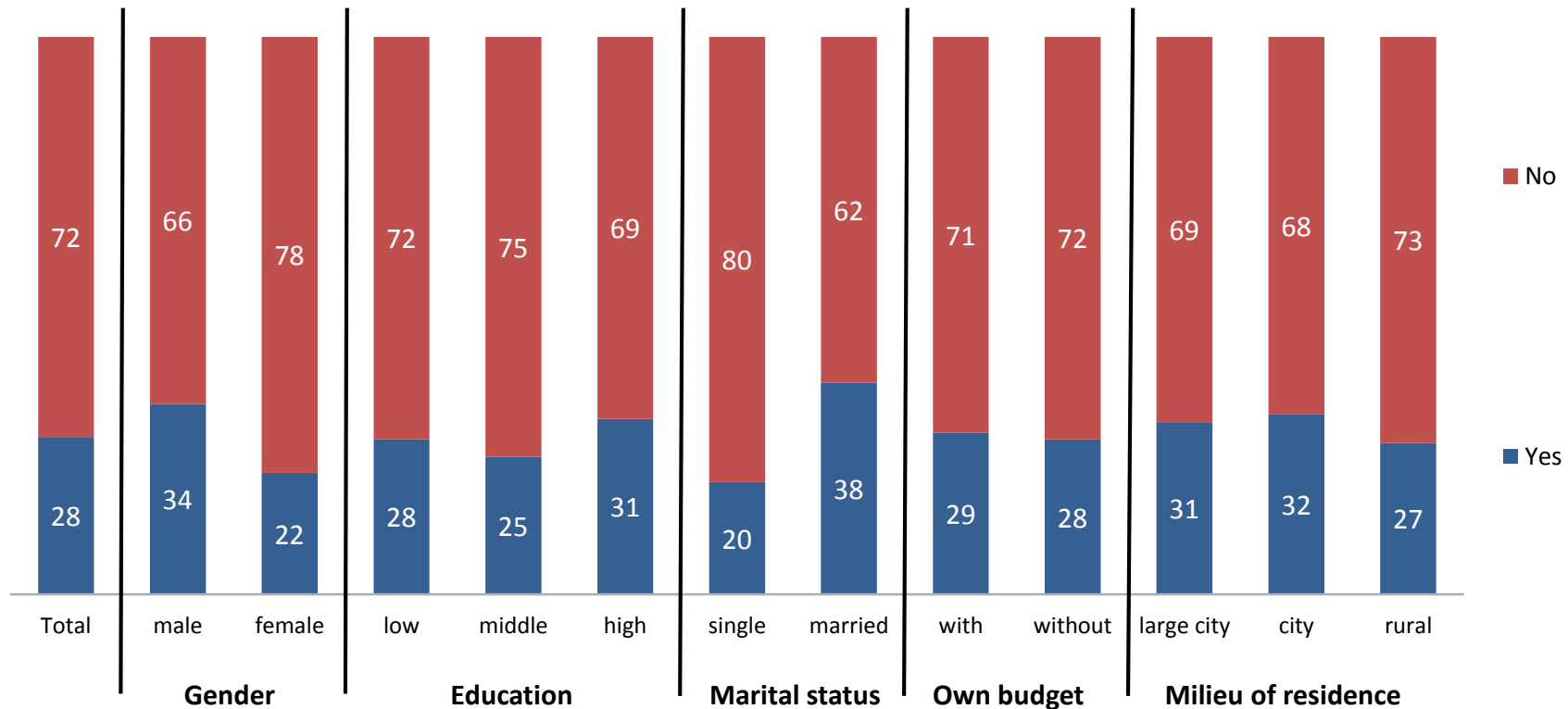
Yemen: Purpose of savings

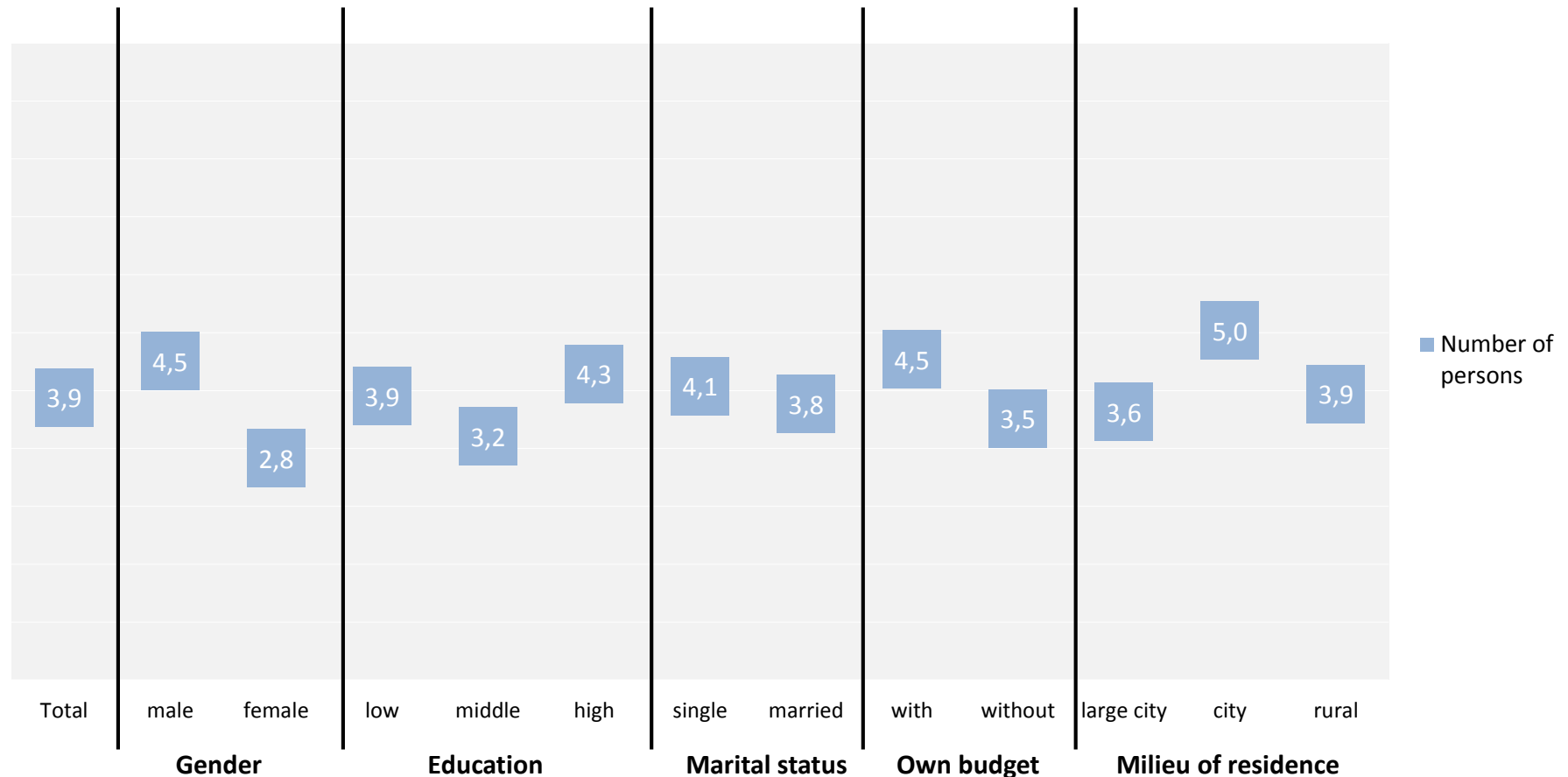

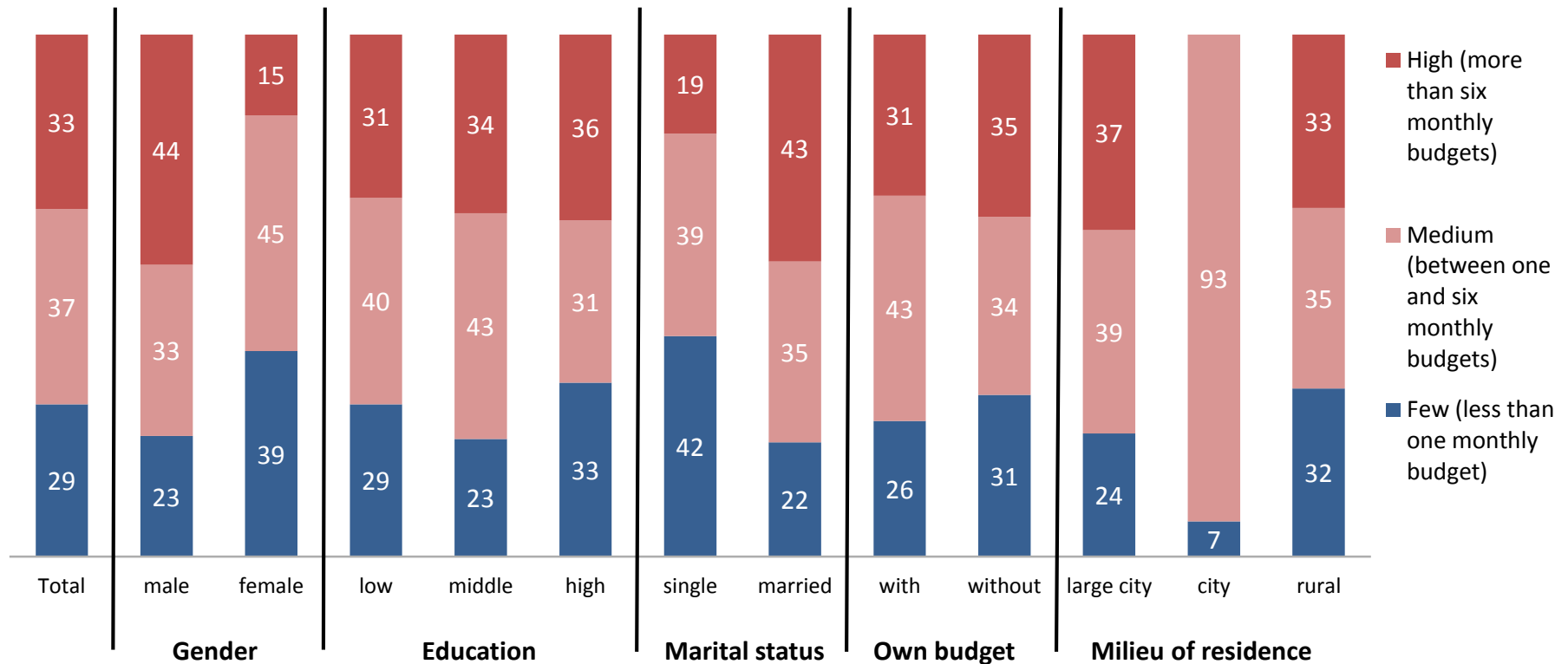

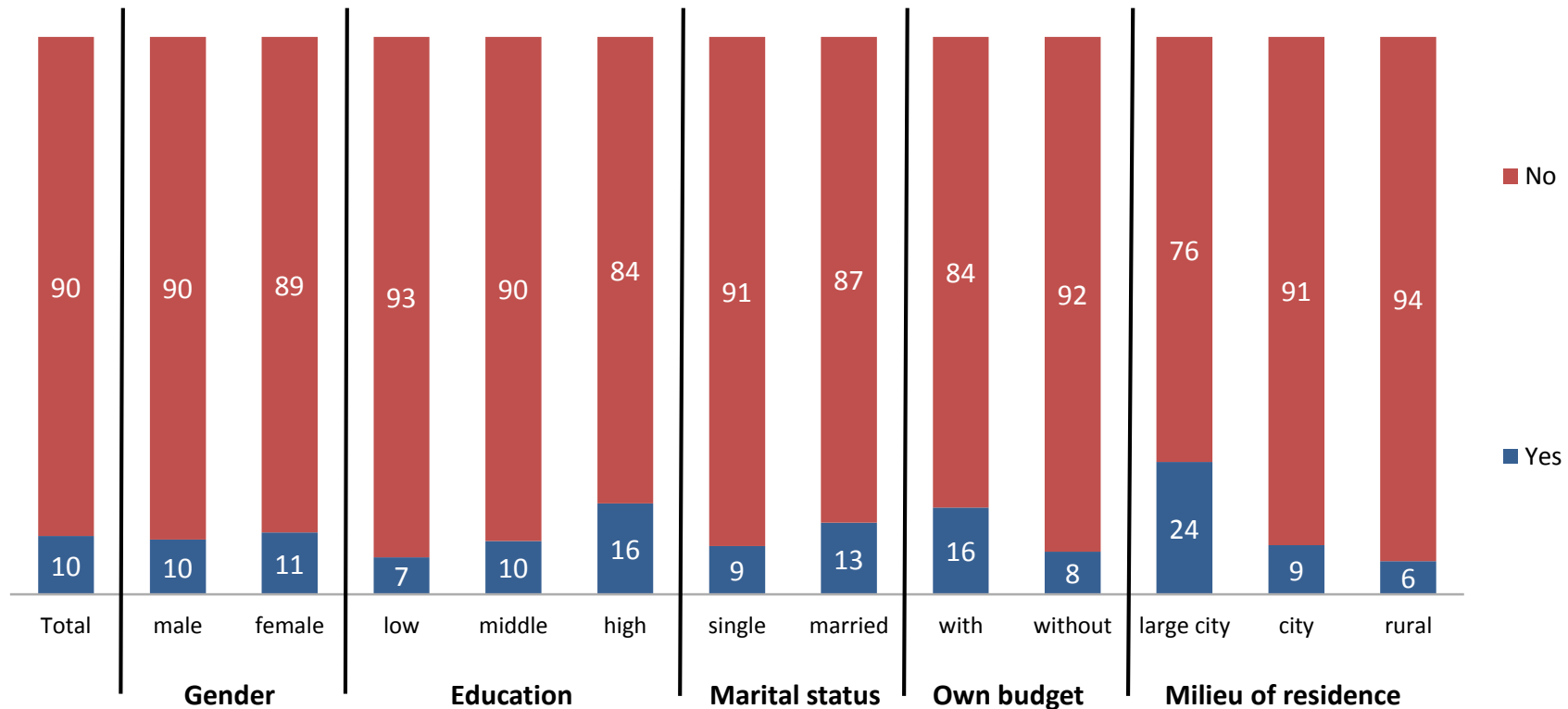
Yemen: Amount of debts

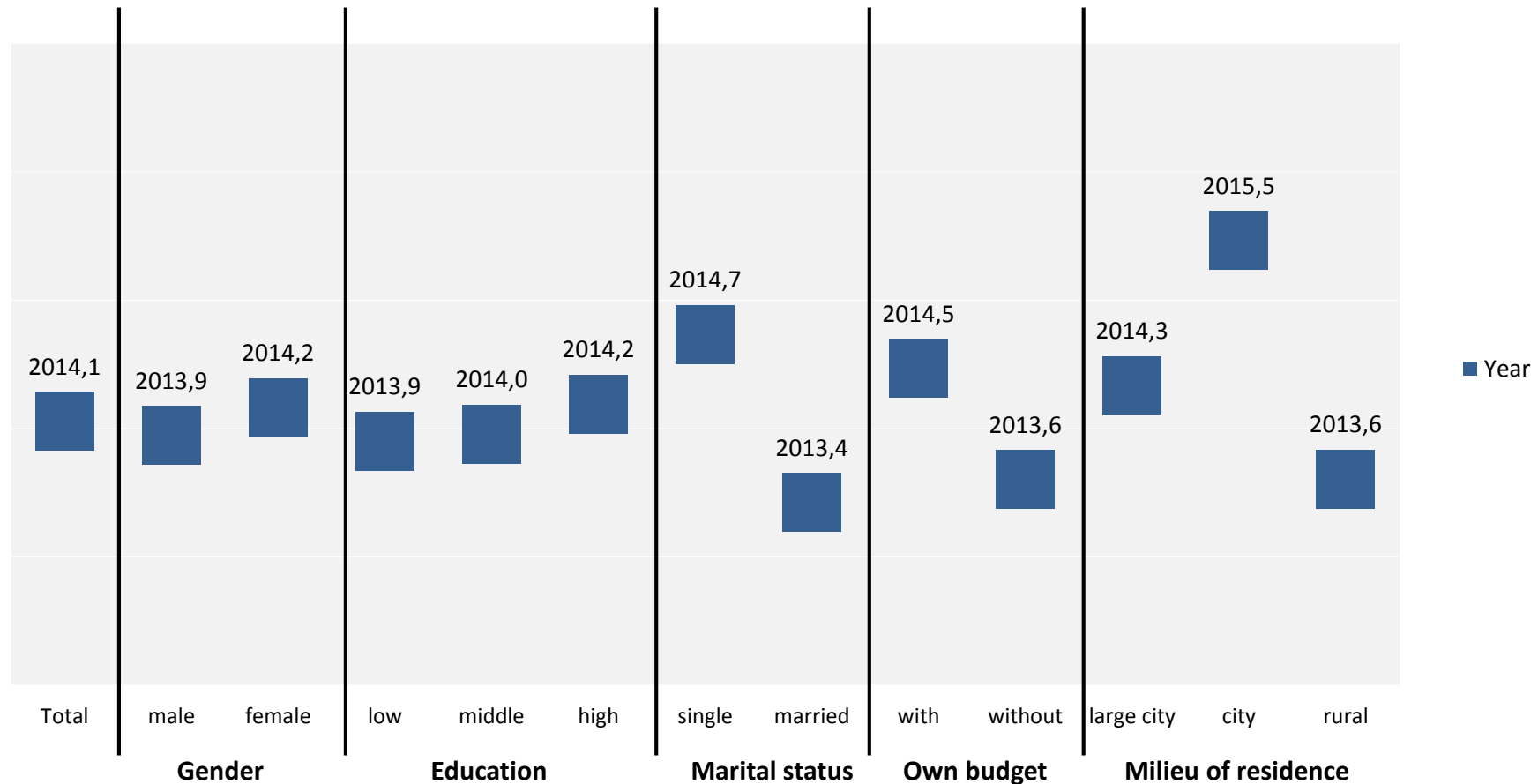

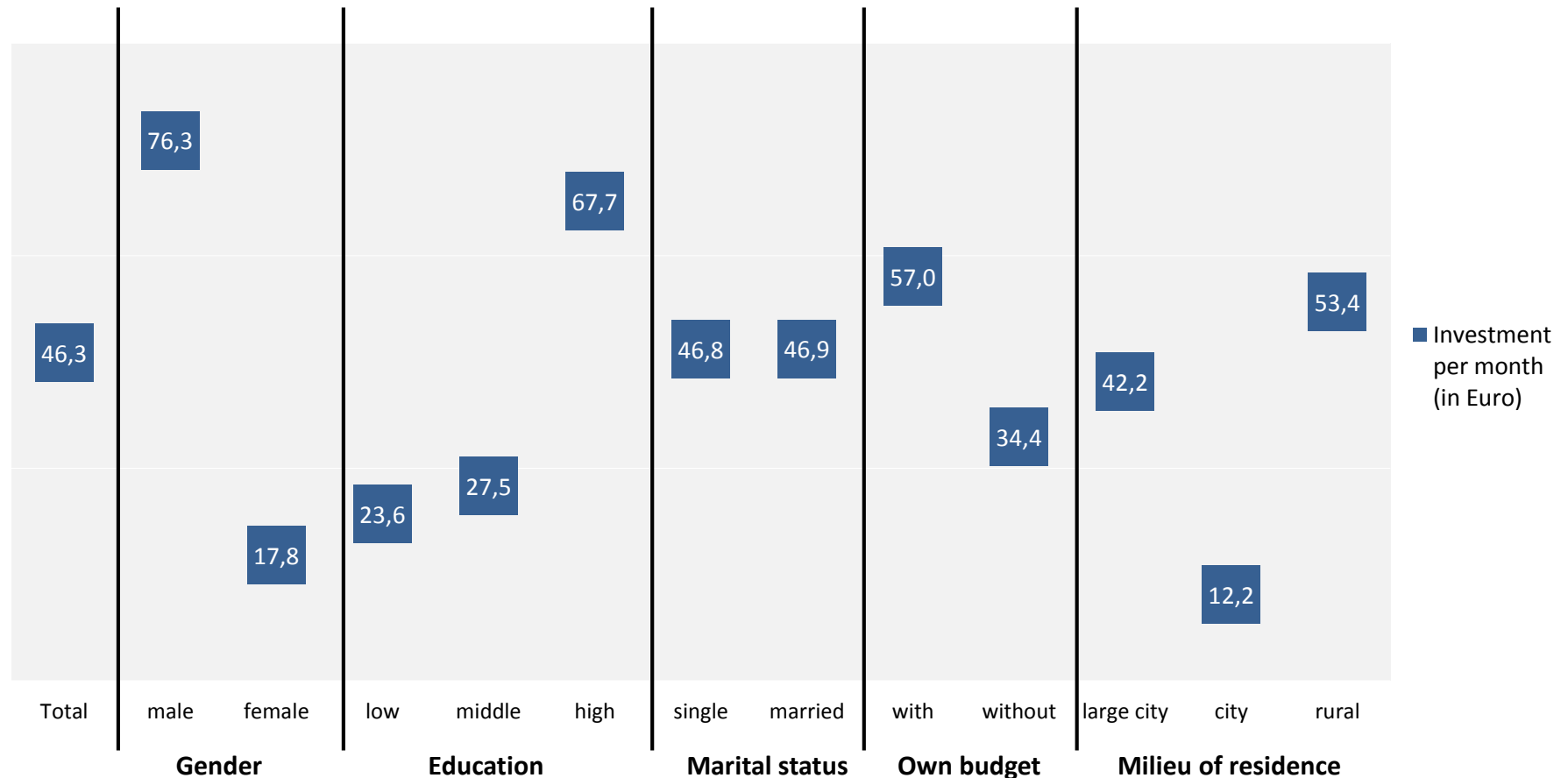

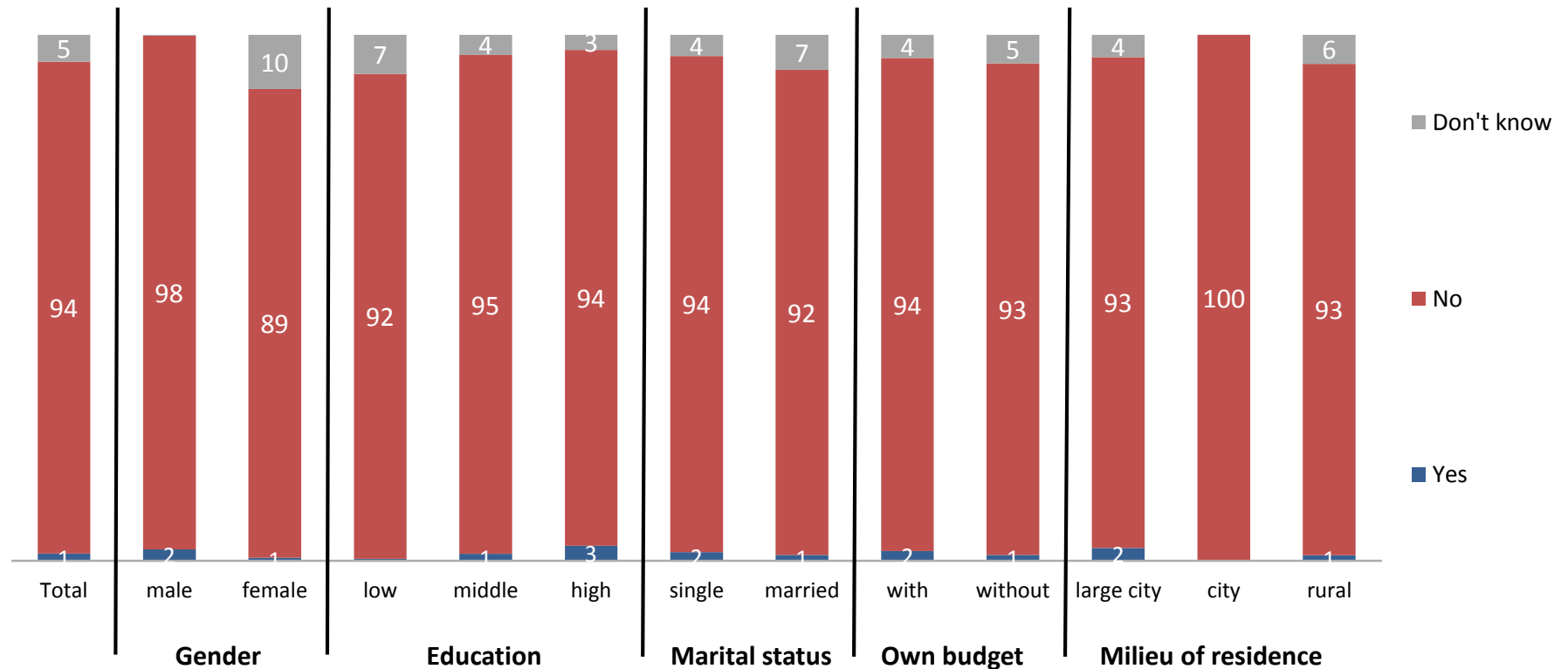
Yemen: Investment per month

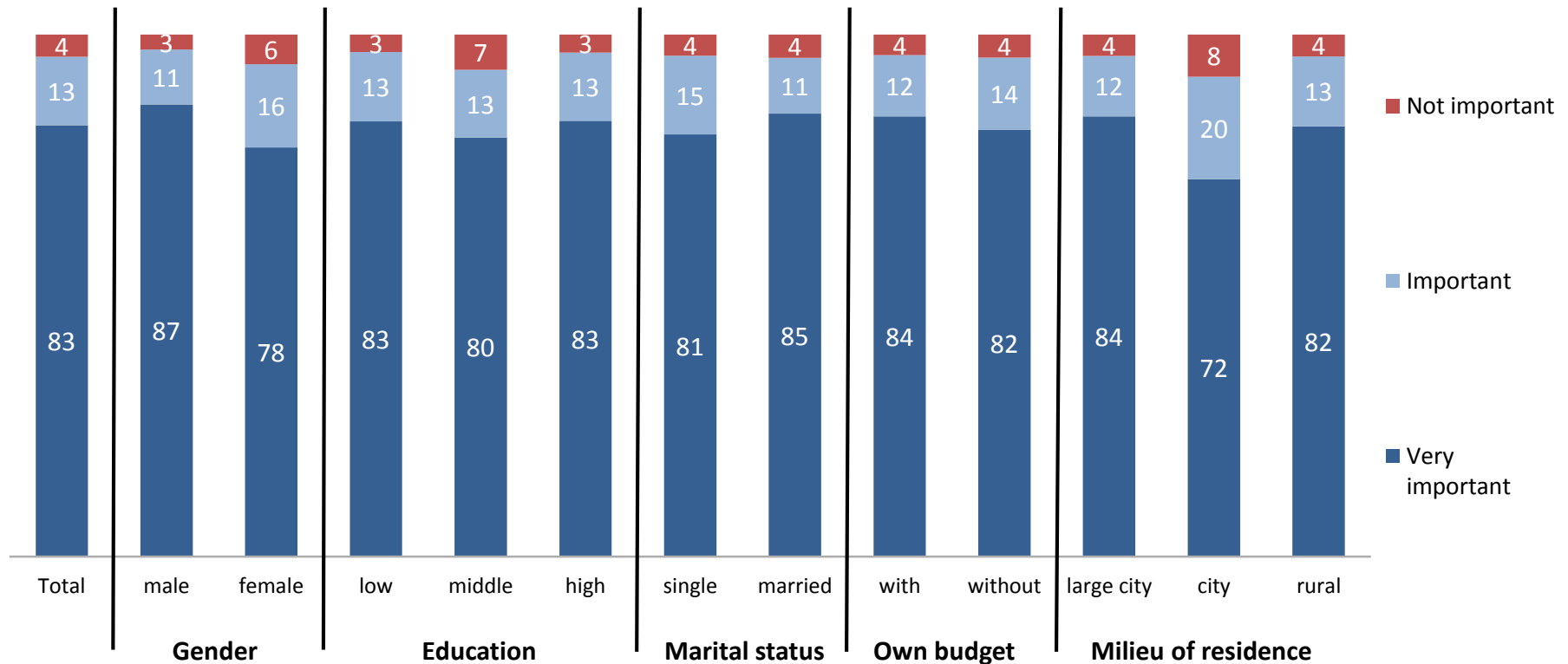

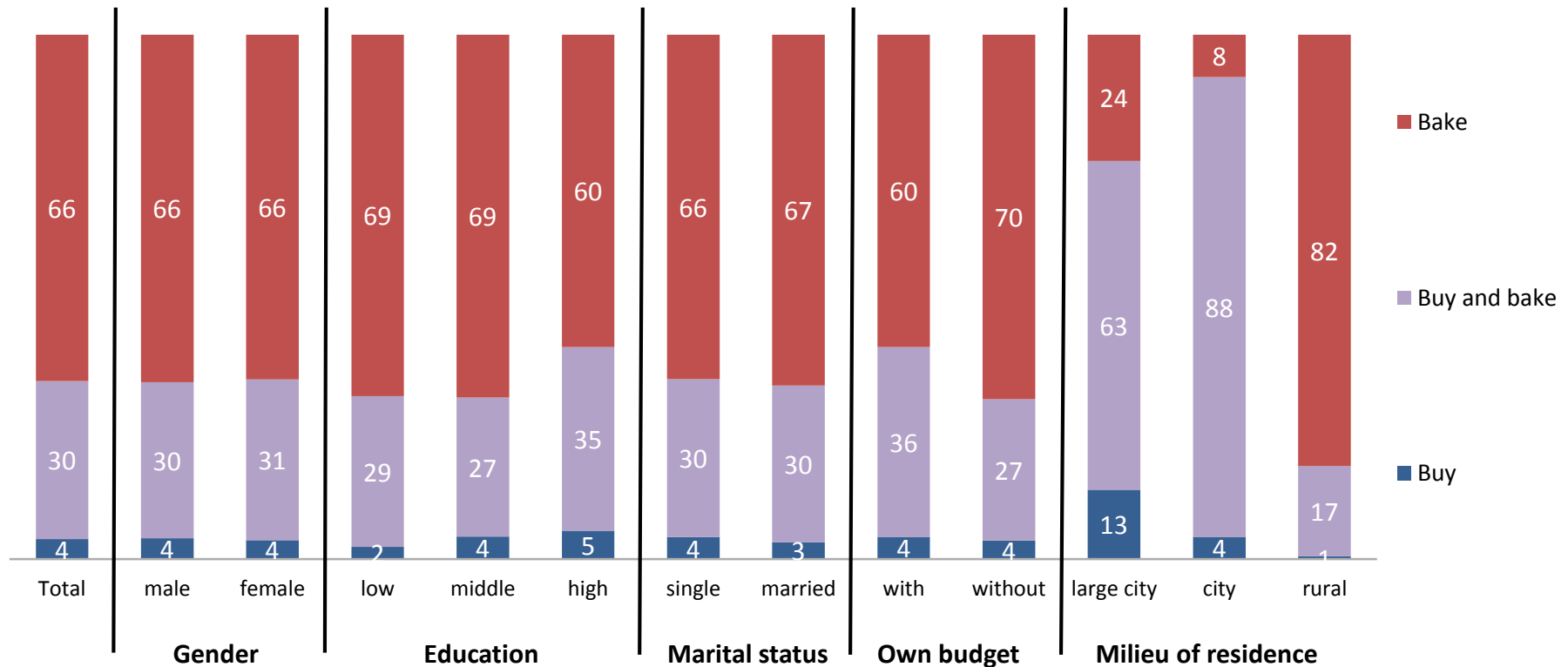
Yemen: Importance of cheap bread

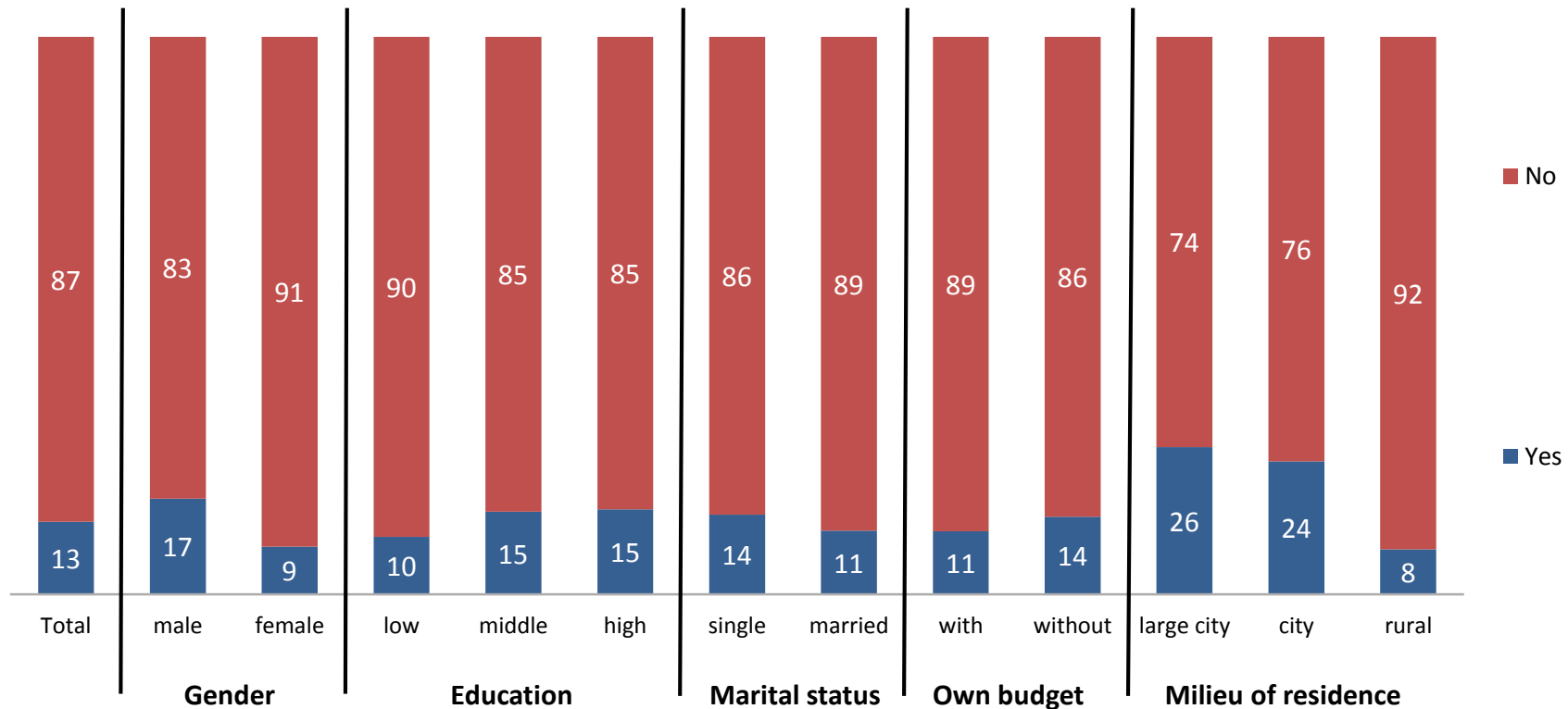
Yemen: Producing bread

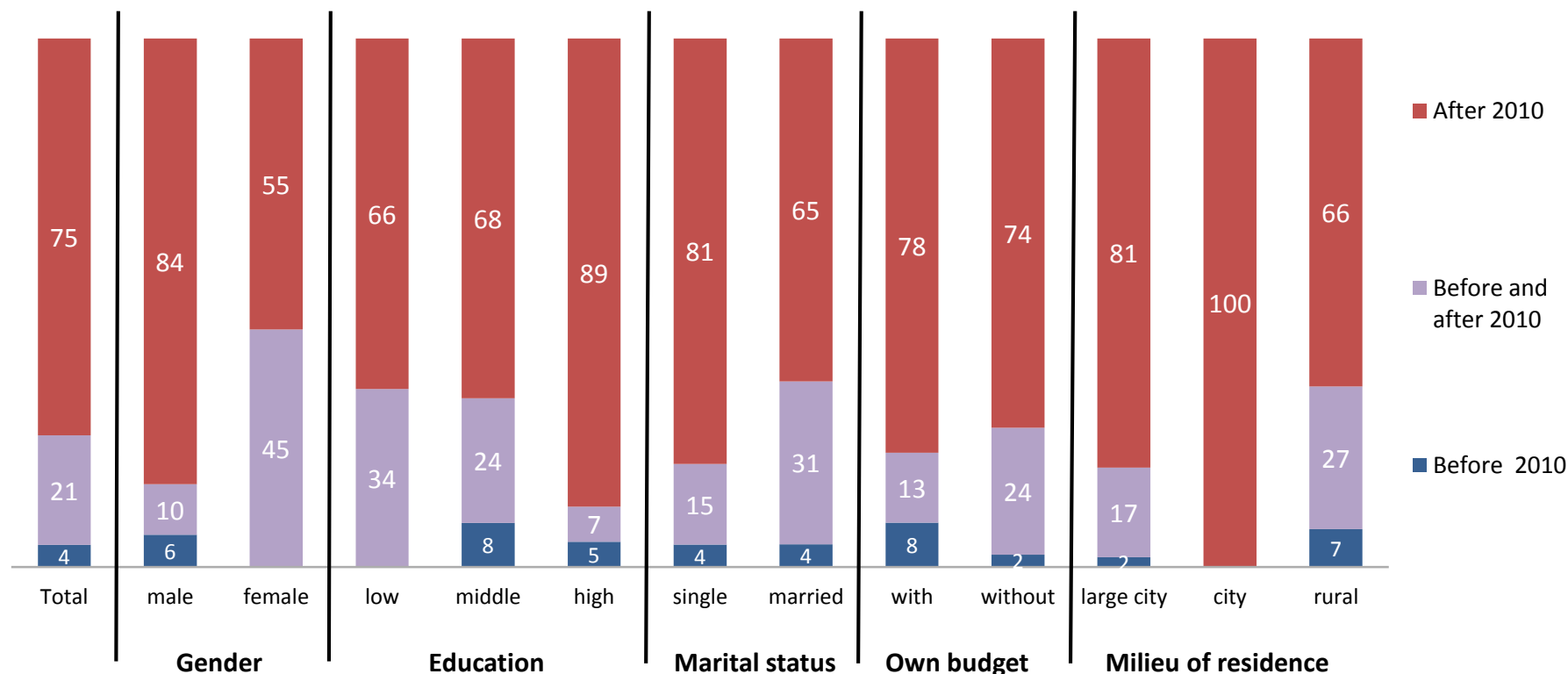
Yemen: Bread supply

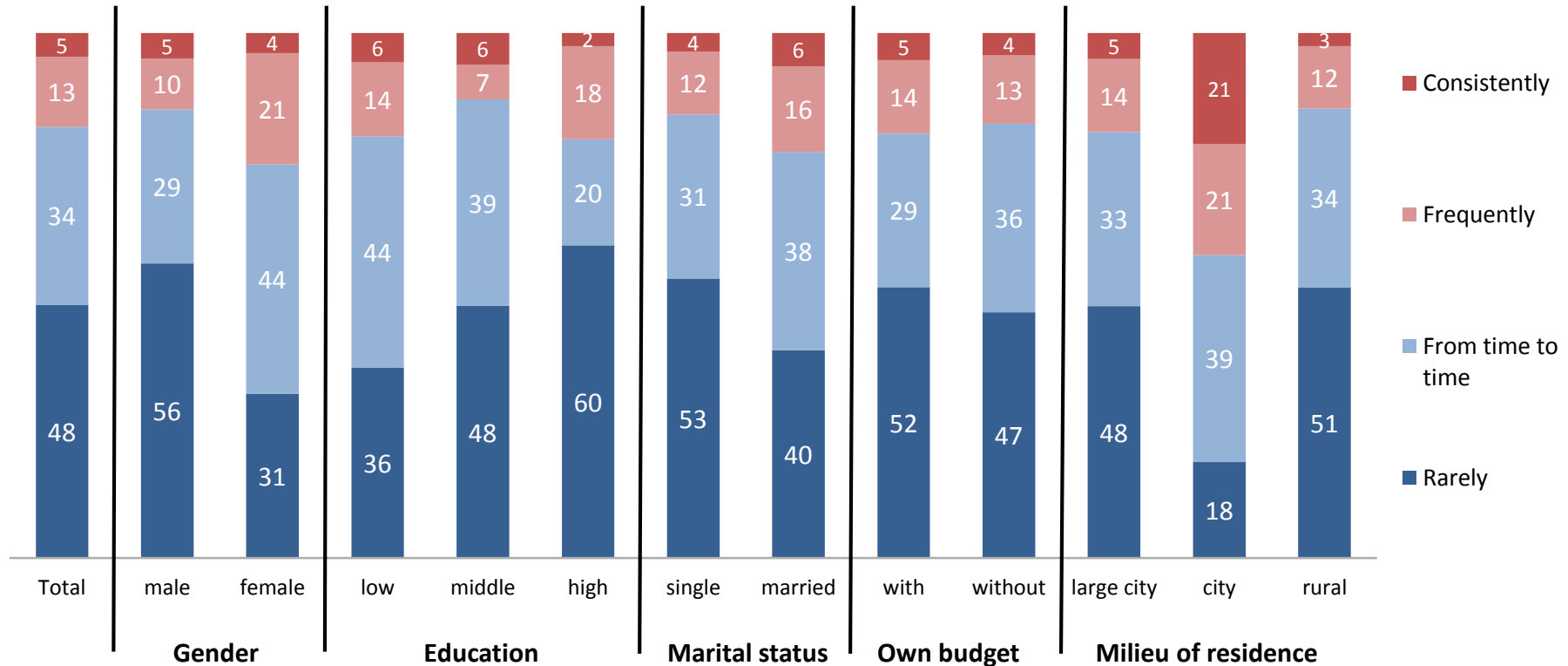

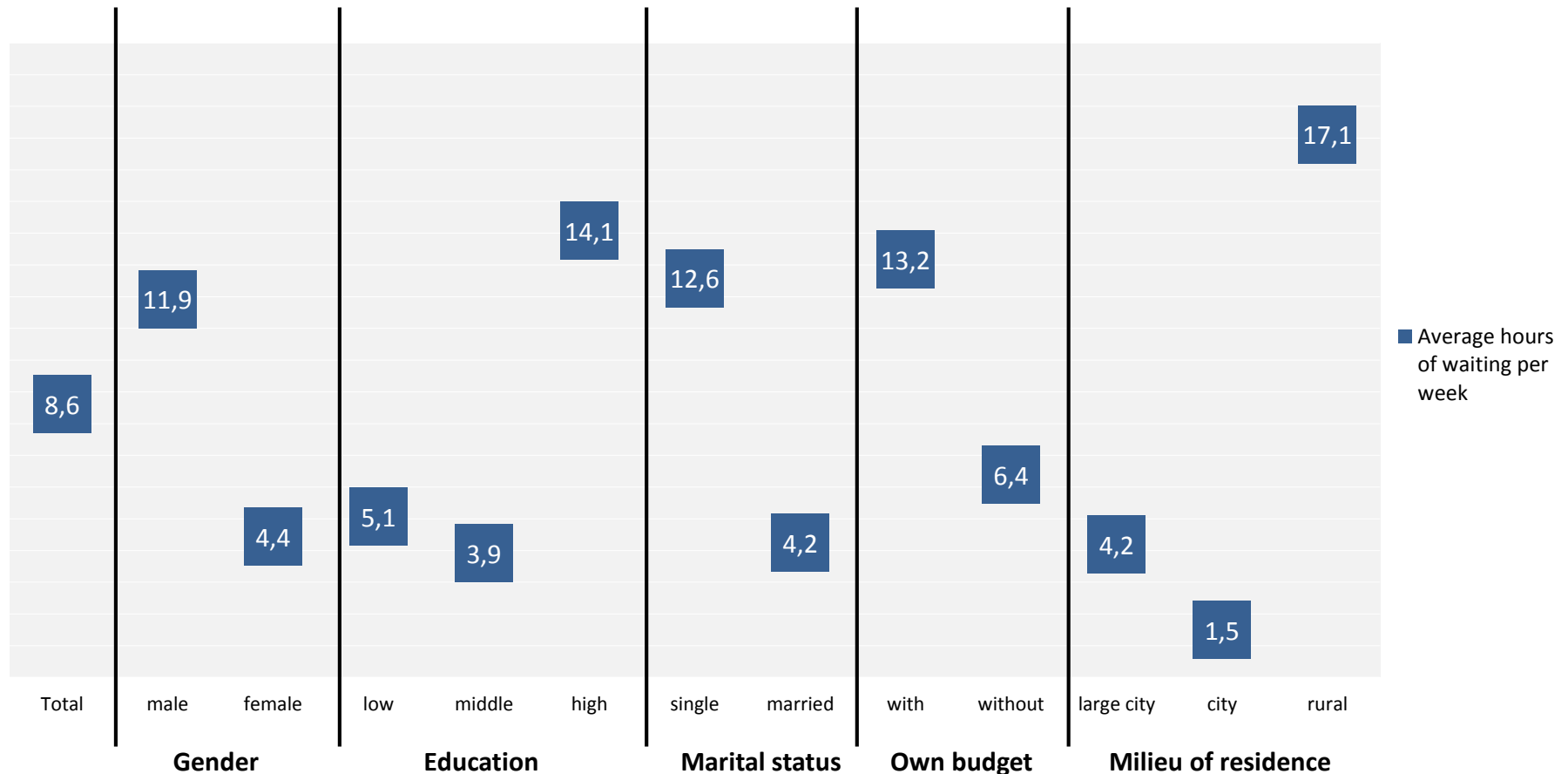

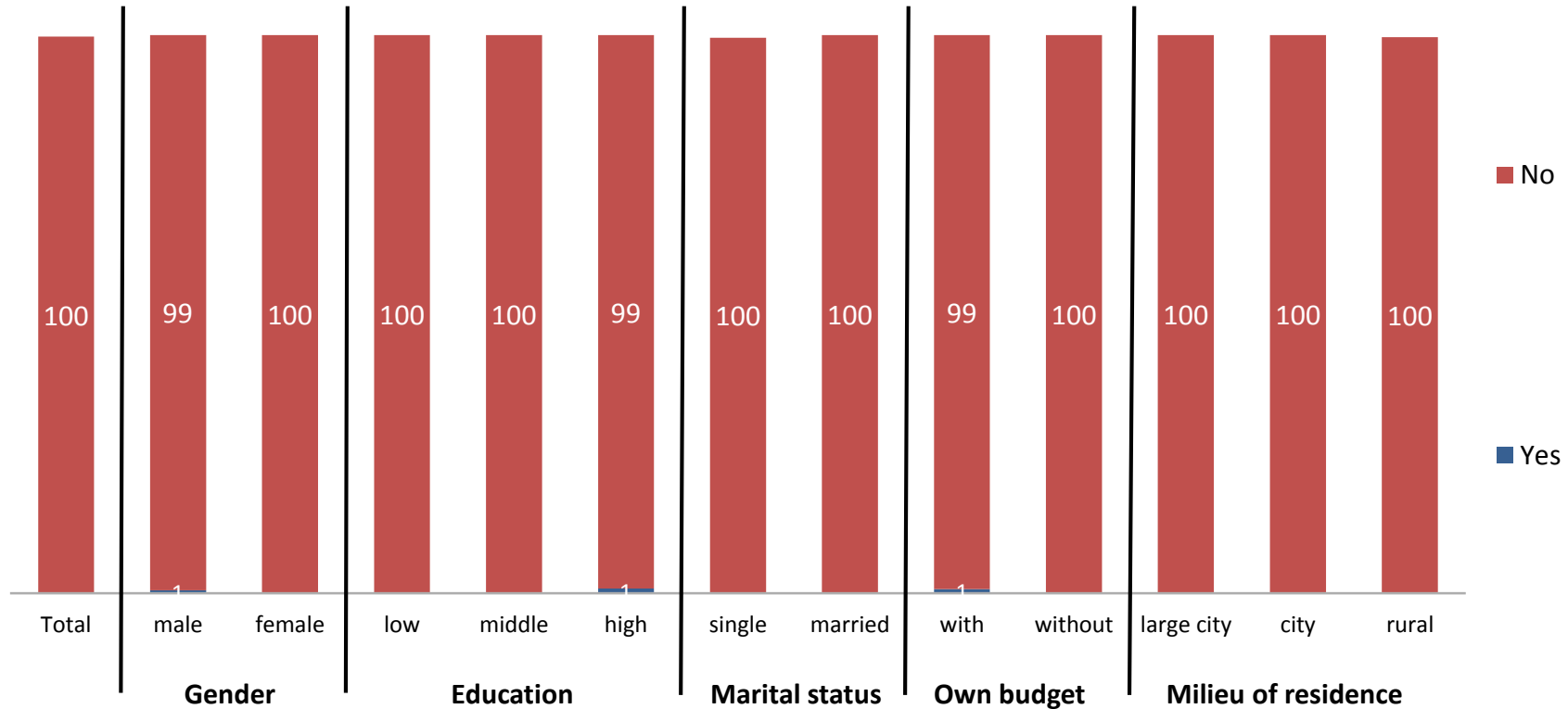
Yemen: Average hours of waiting for bread per week

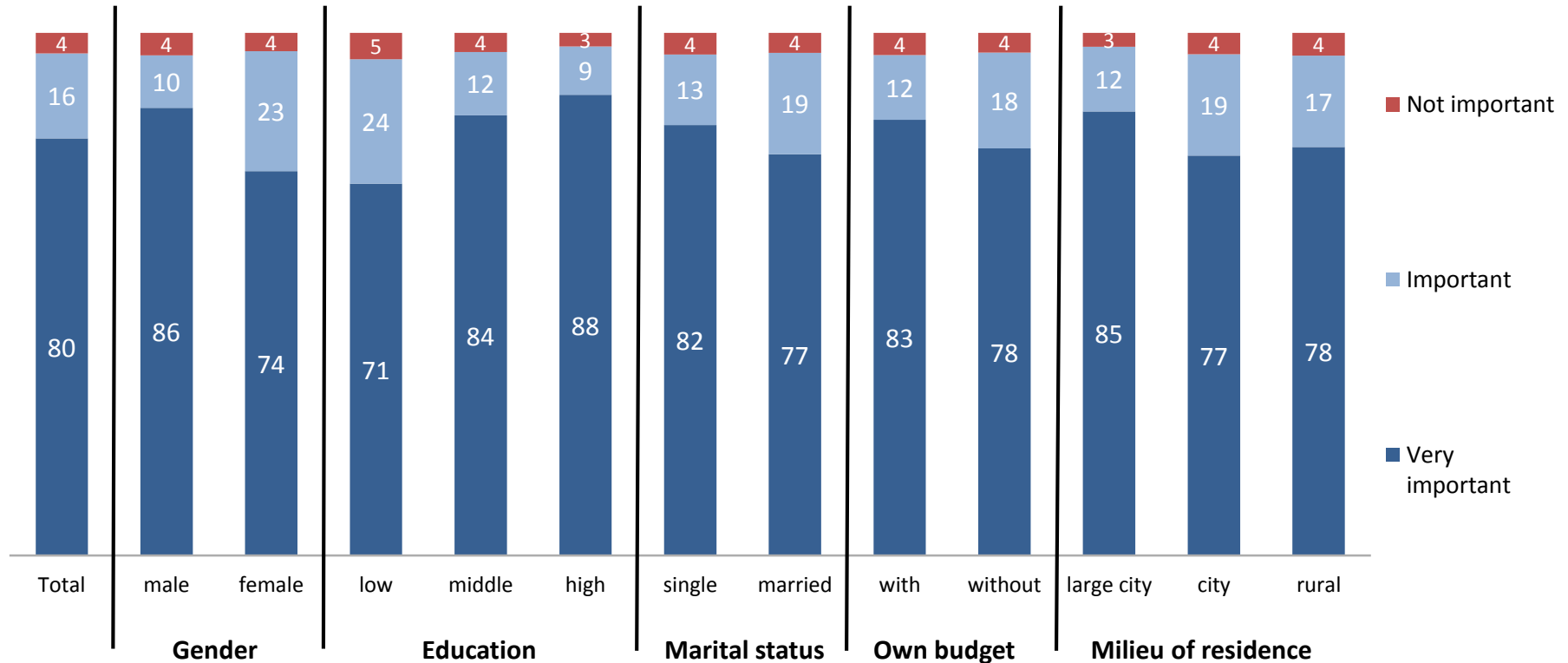

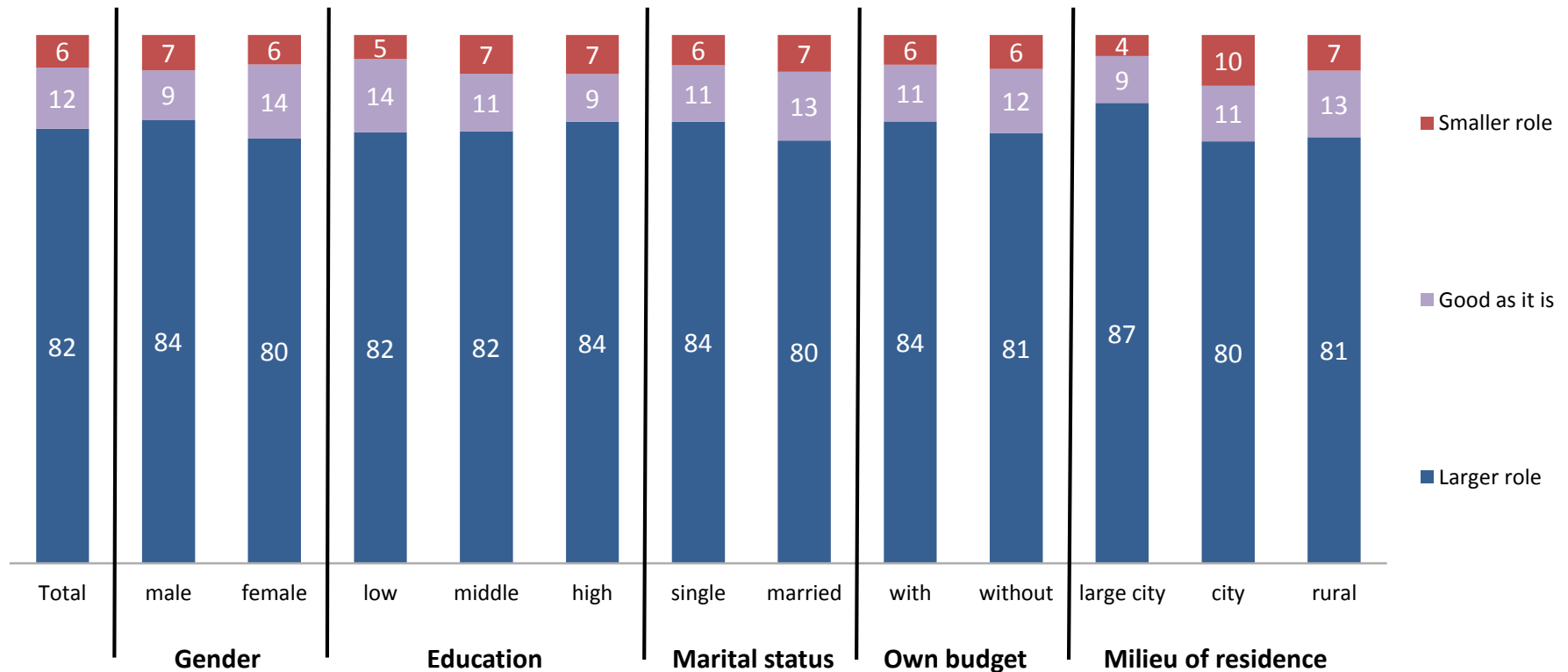

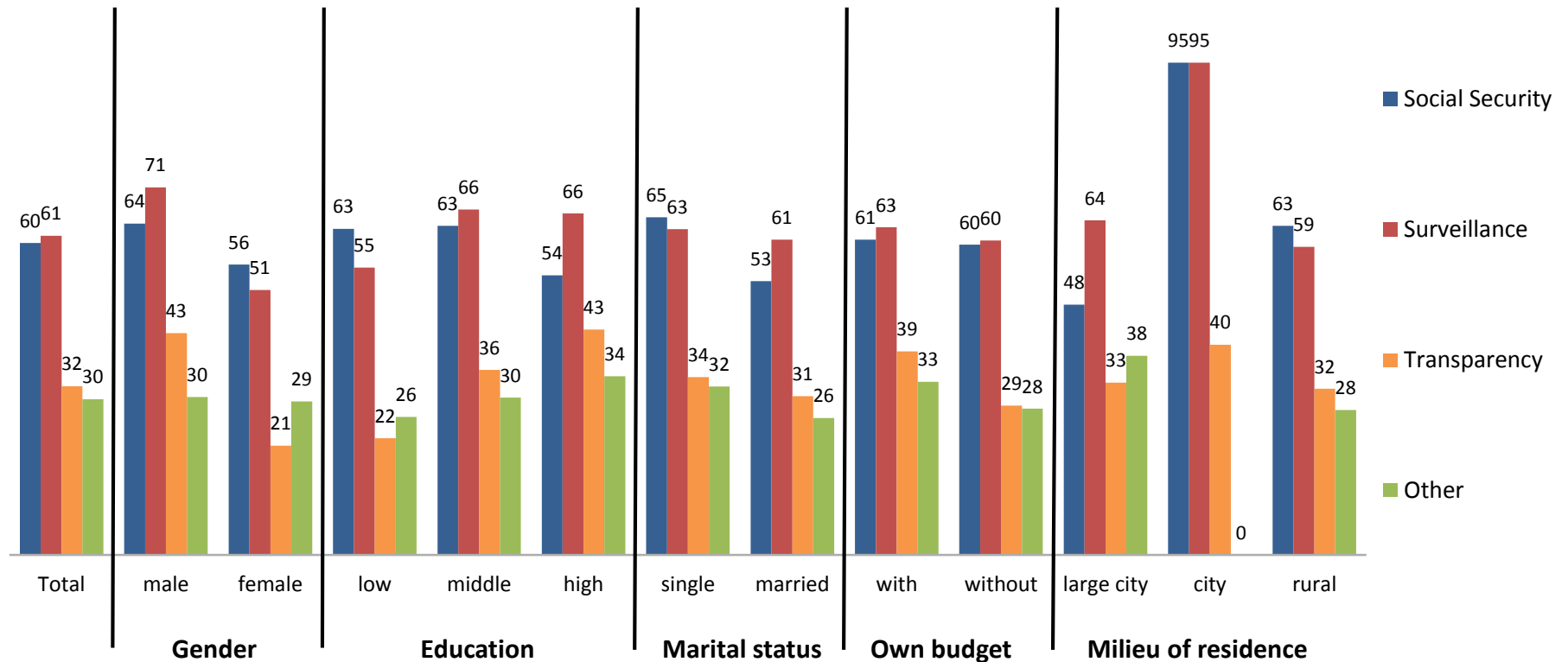
Yemen: Role of state in daily life

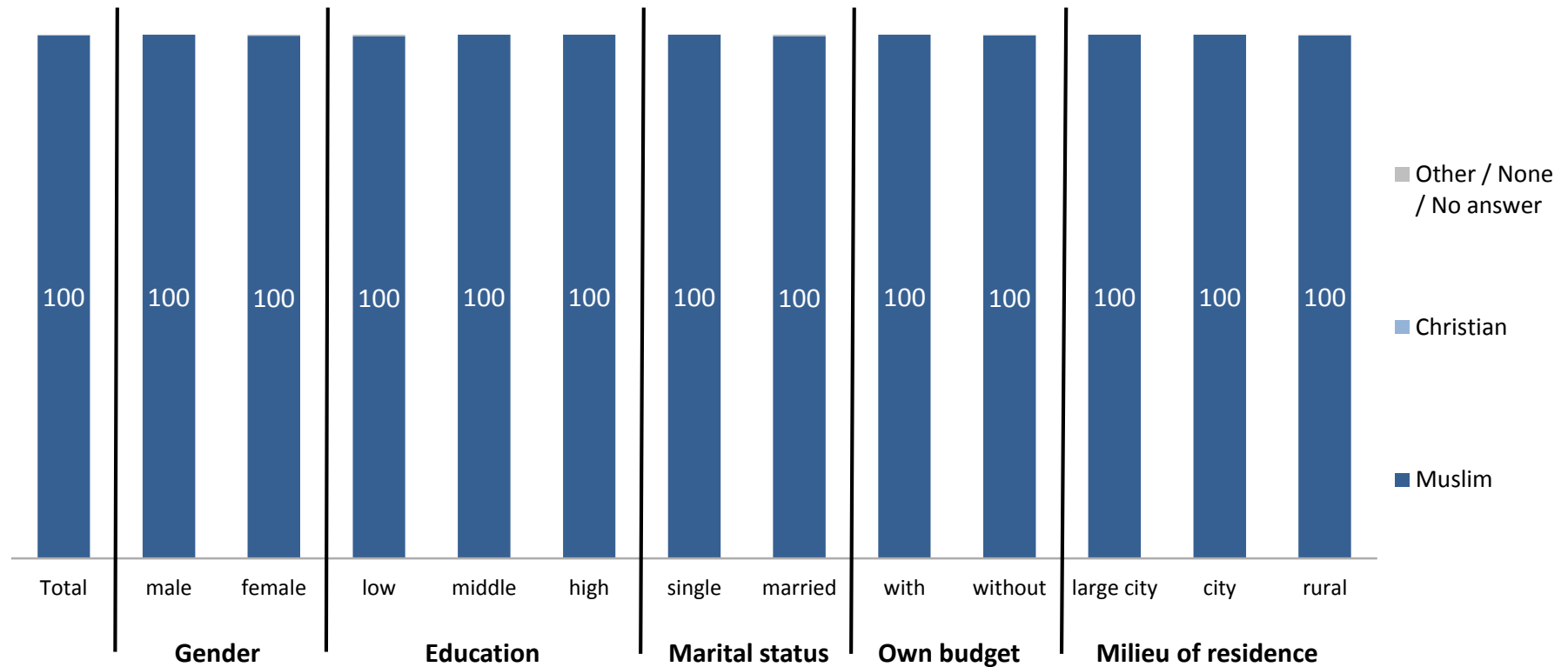

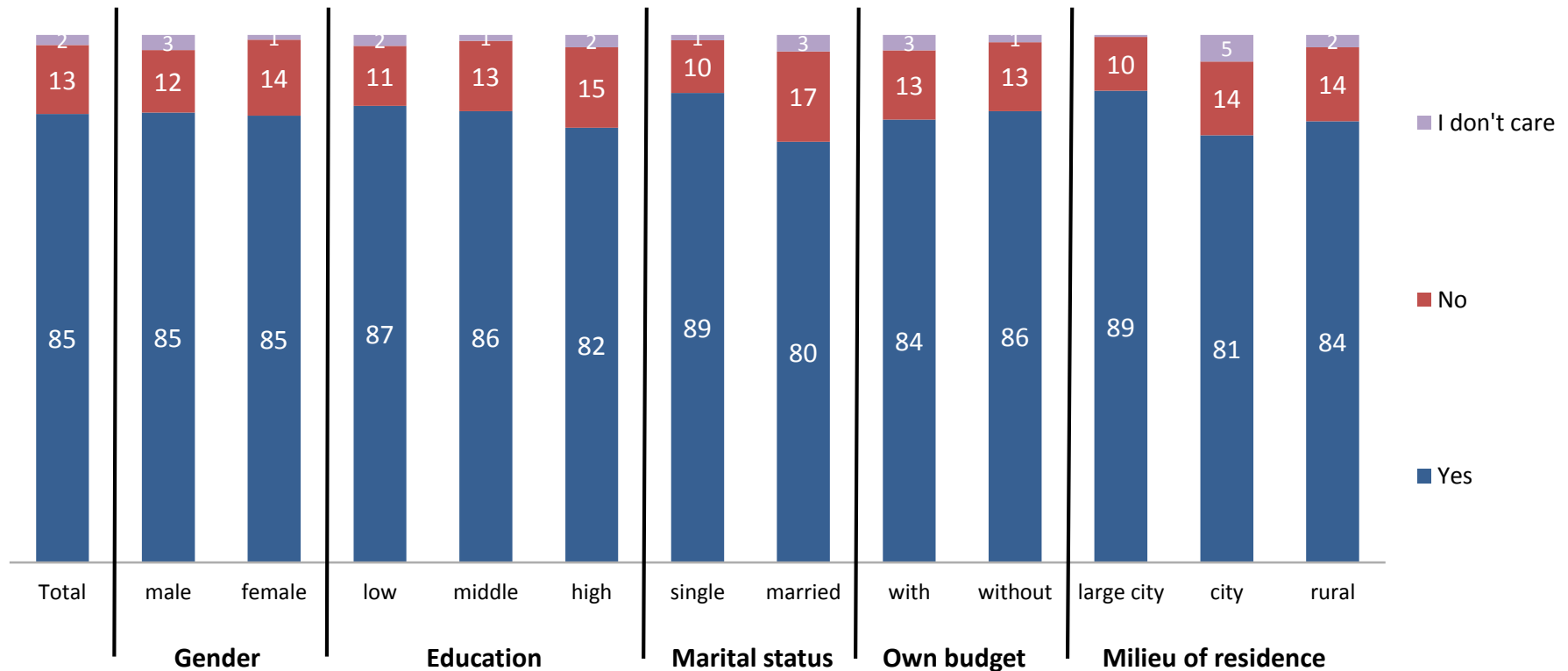

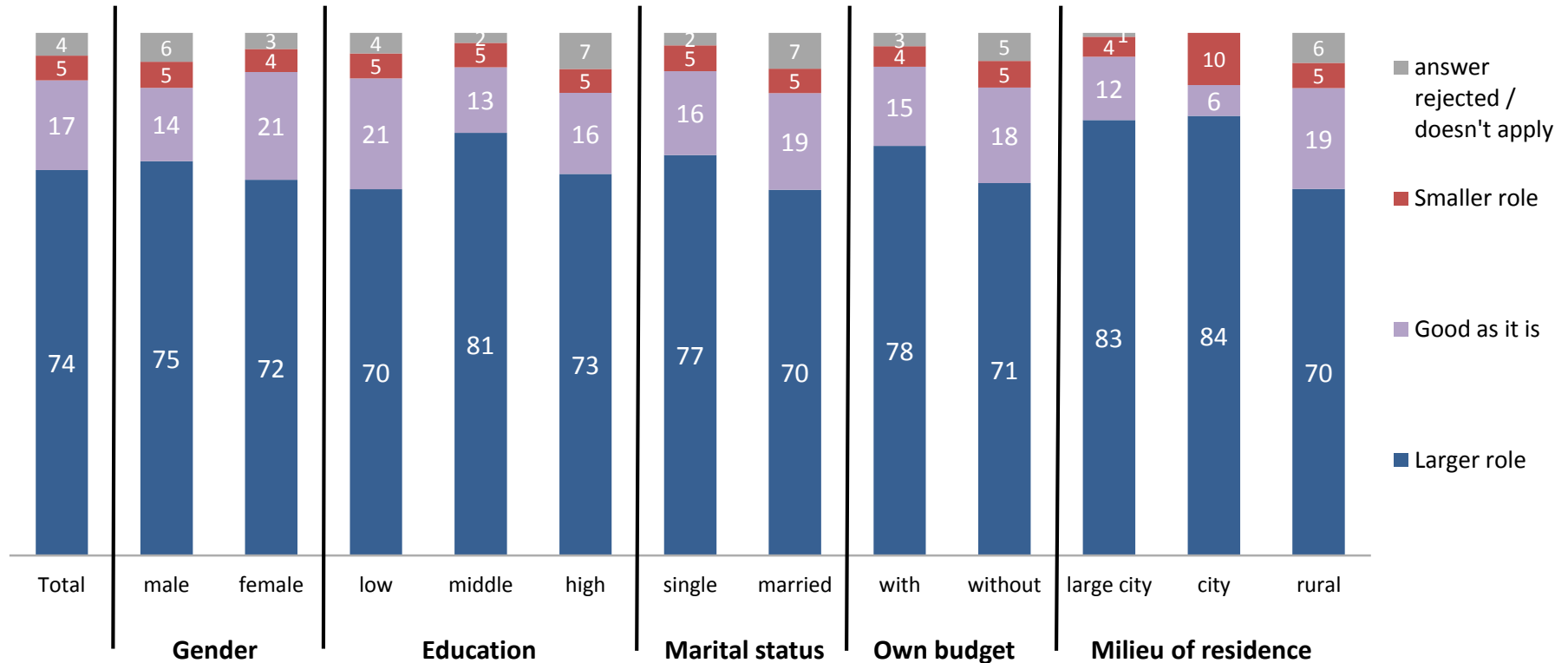
Yemen: Religion as private matter

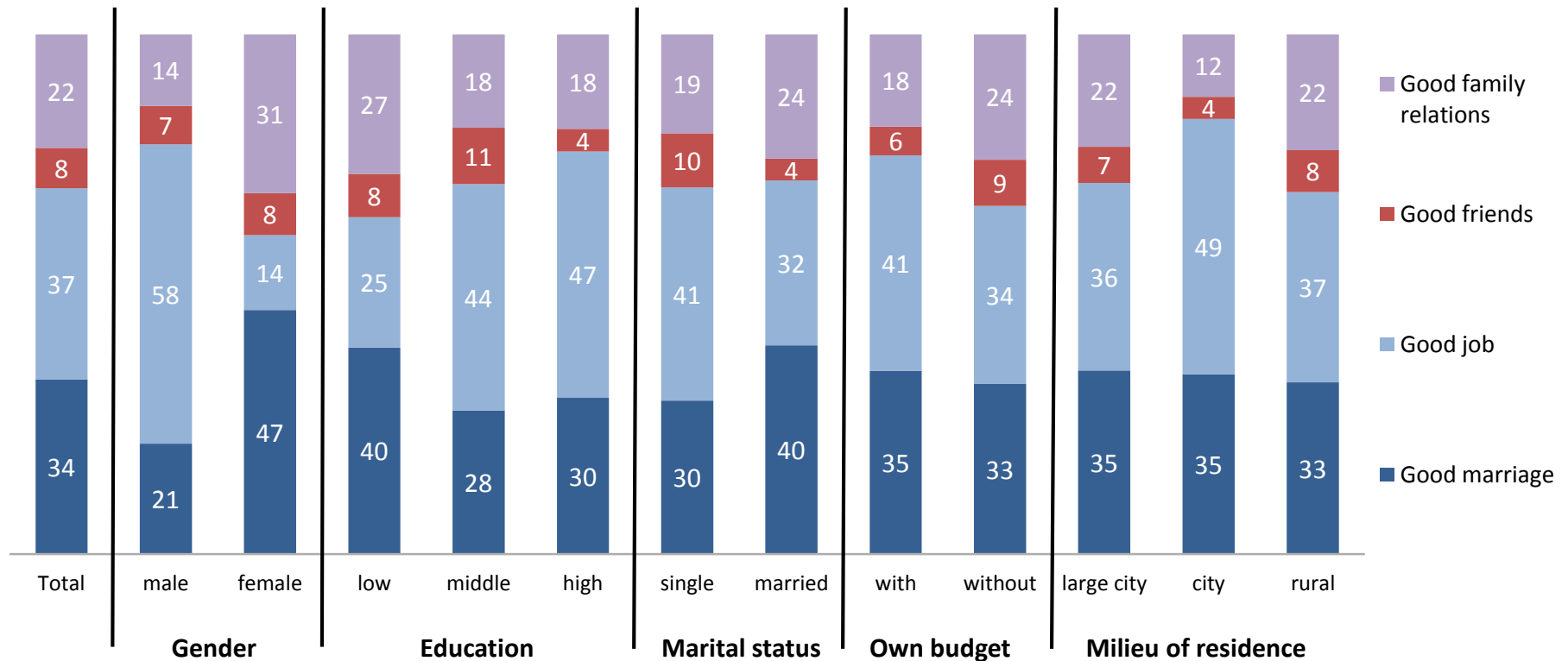

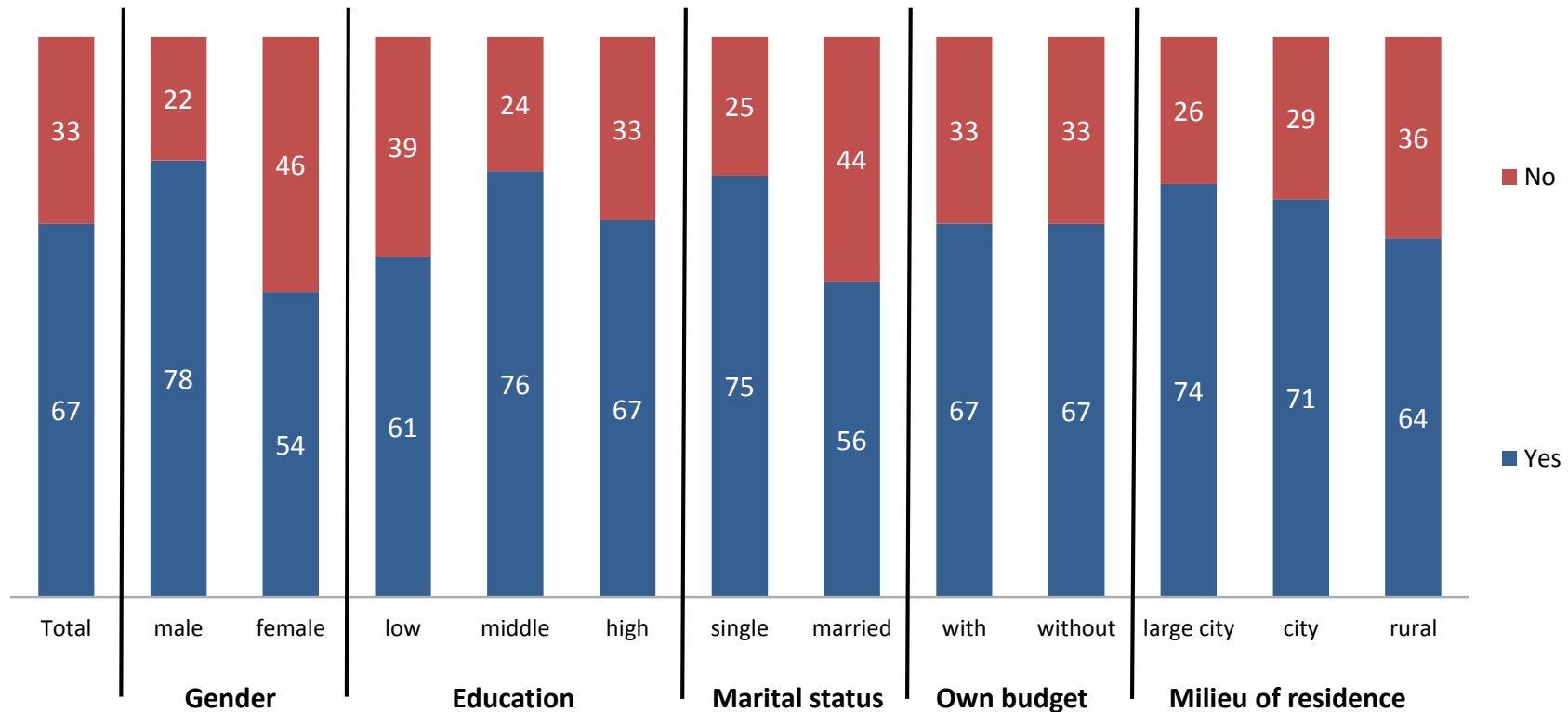

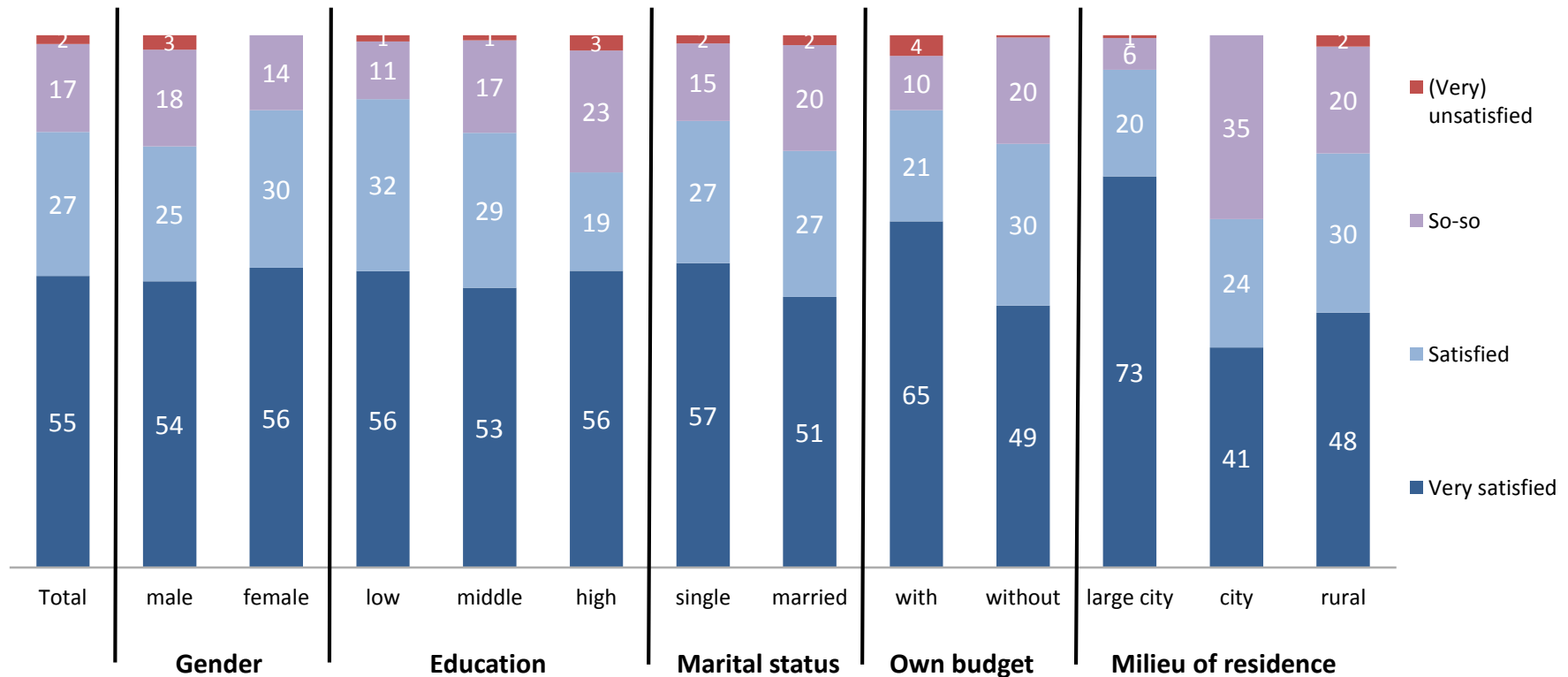
Yemen: Part of a clique

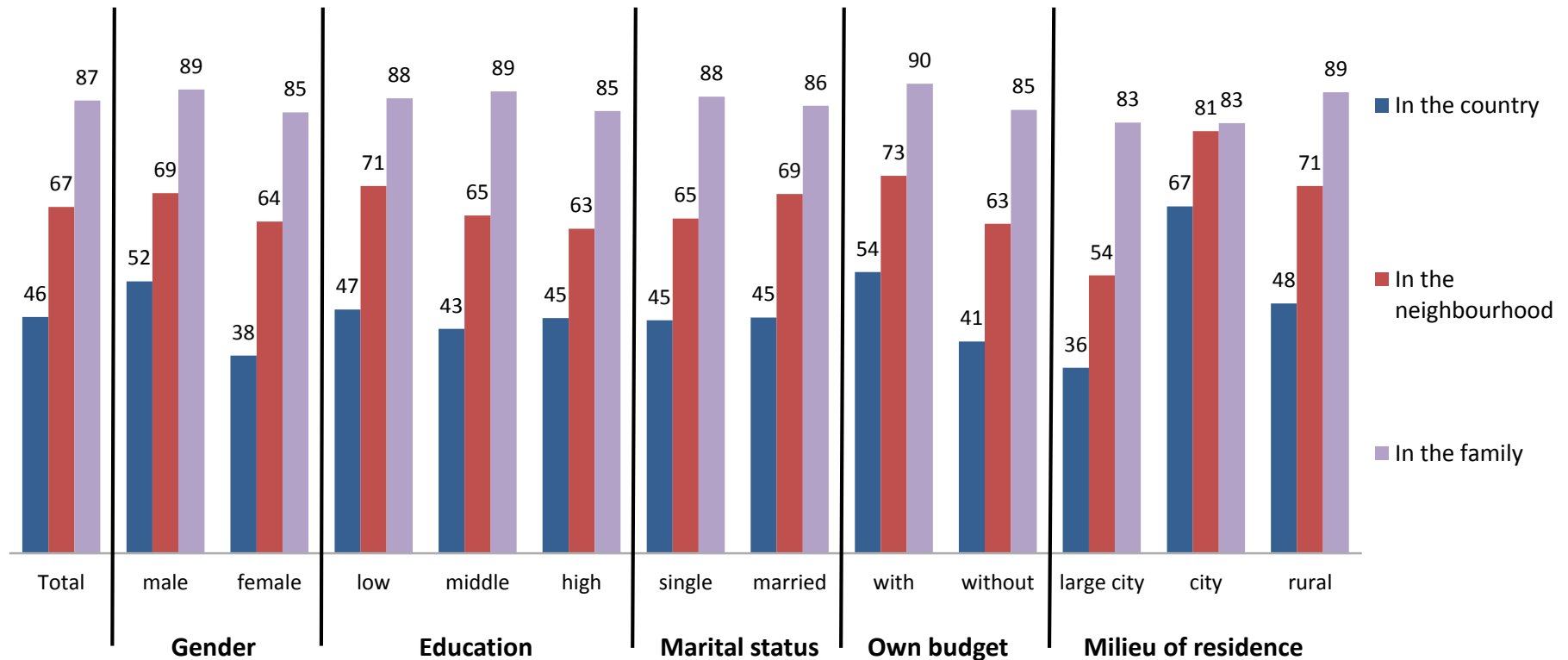

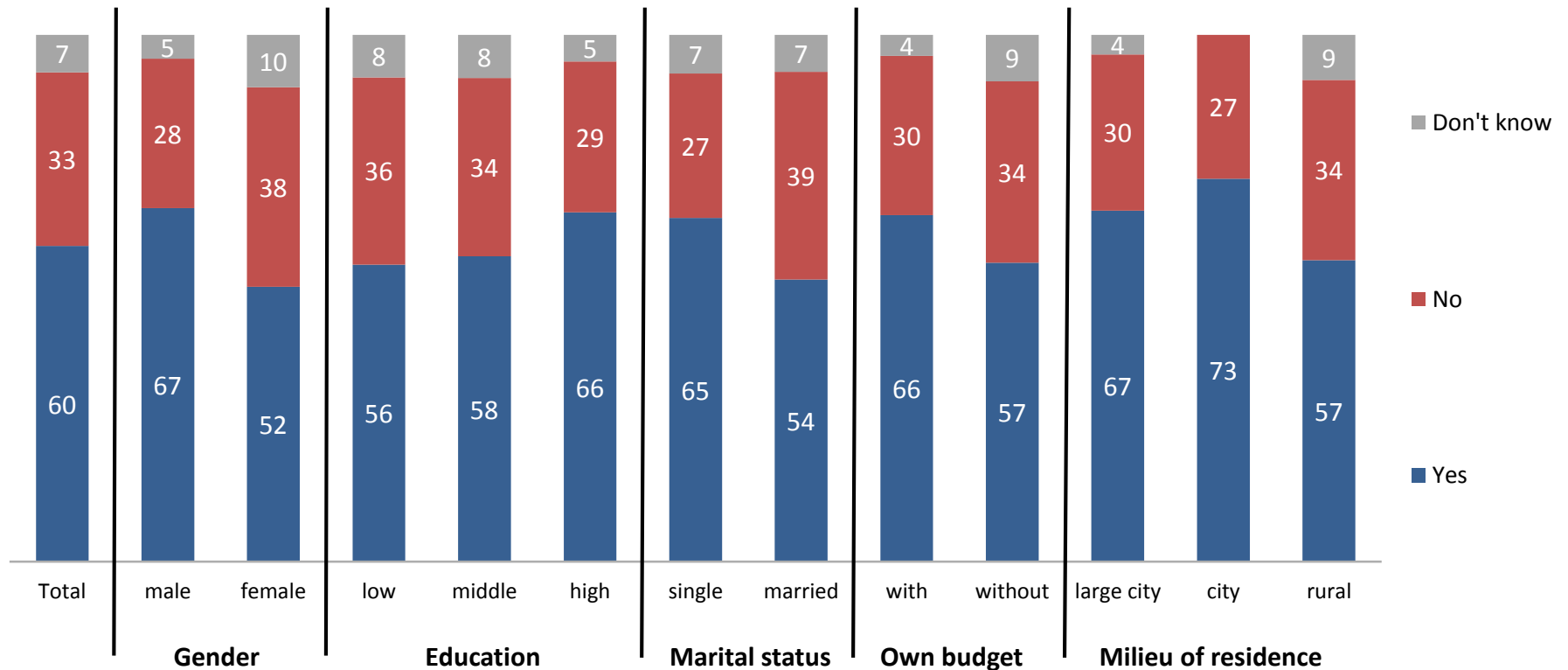
Yemen: Harmony between men and women

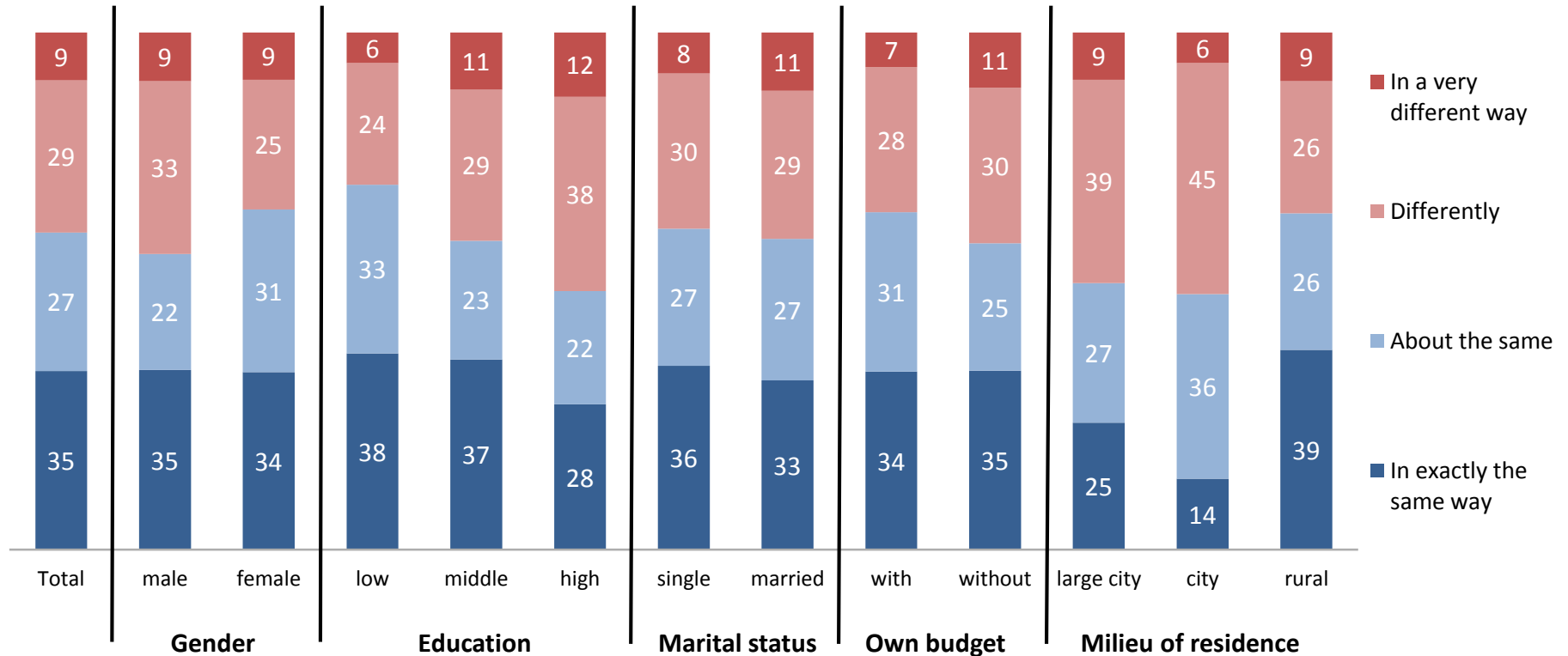

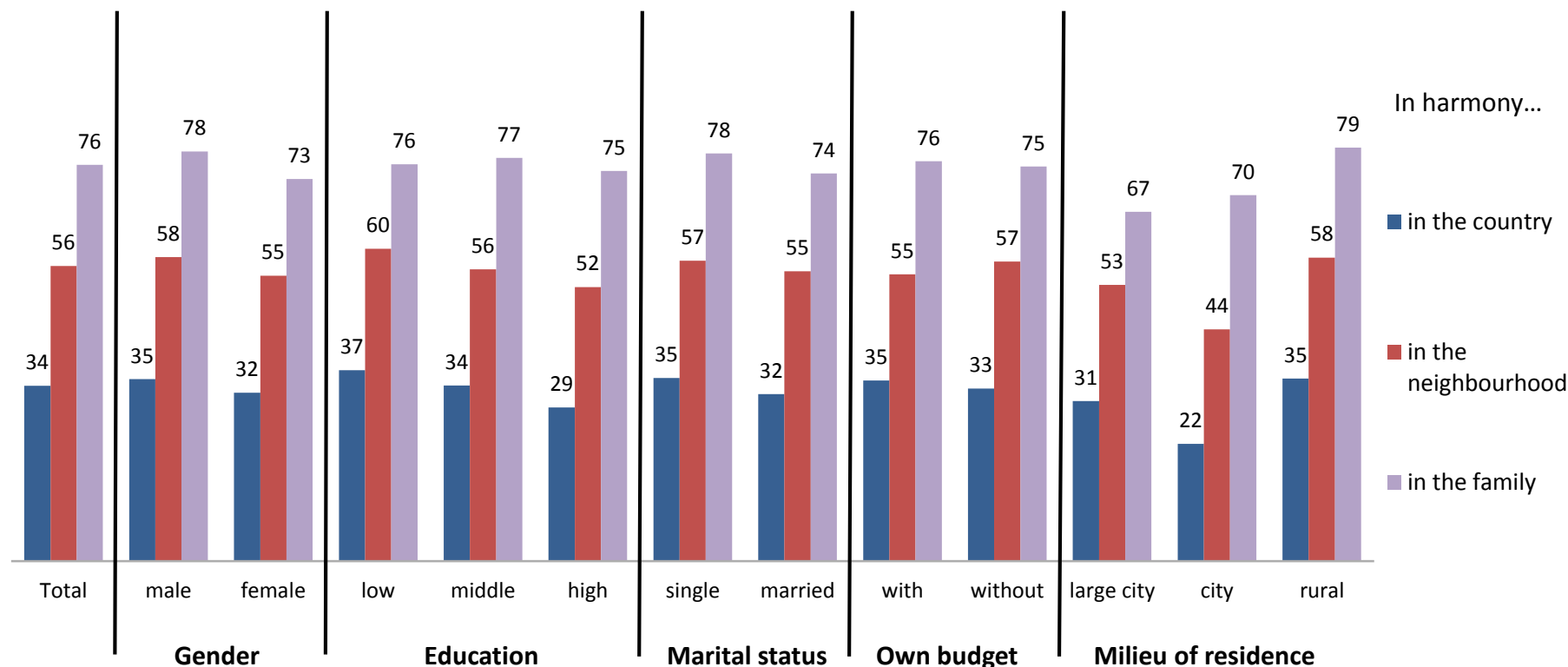

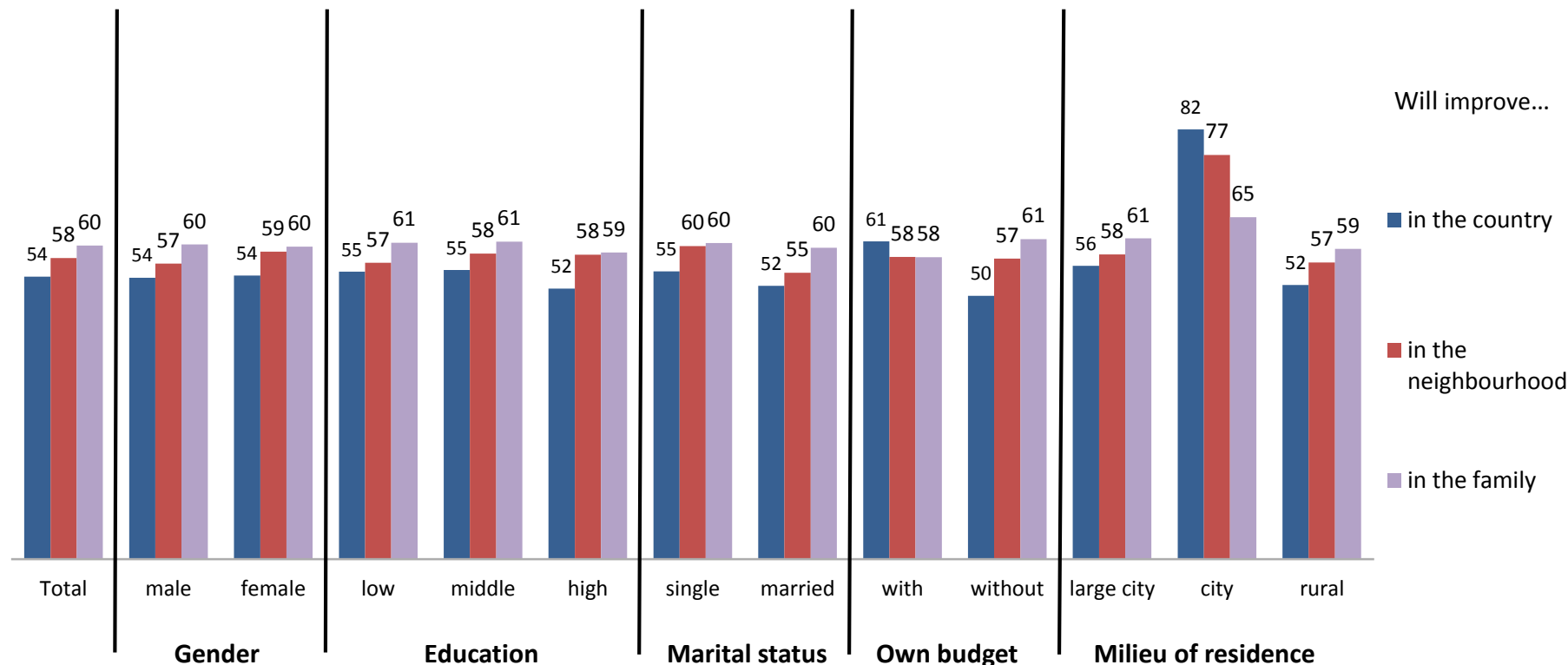
Yemen: Relationship between the generations

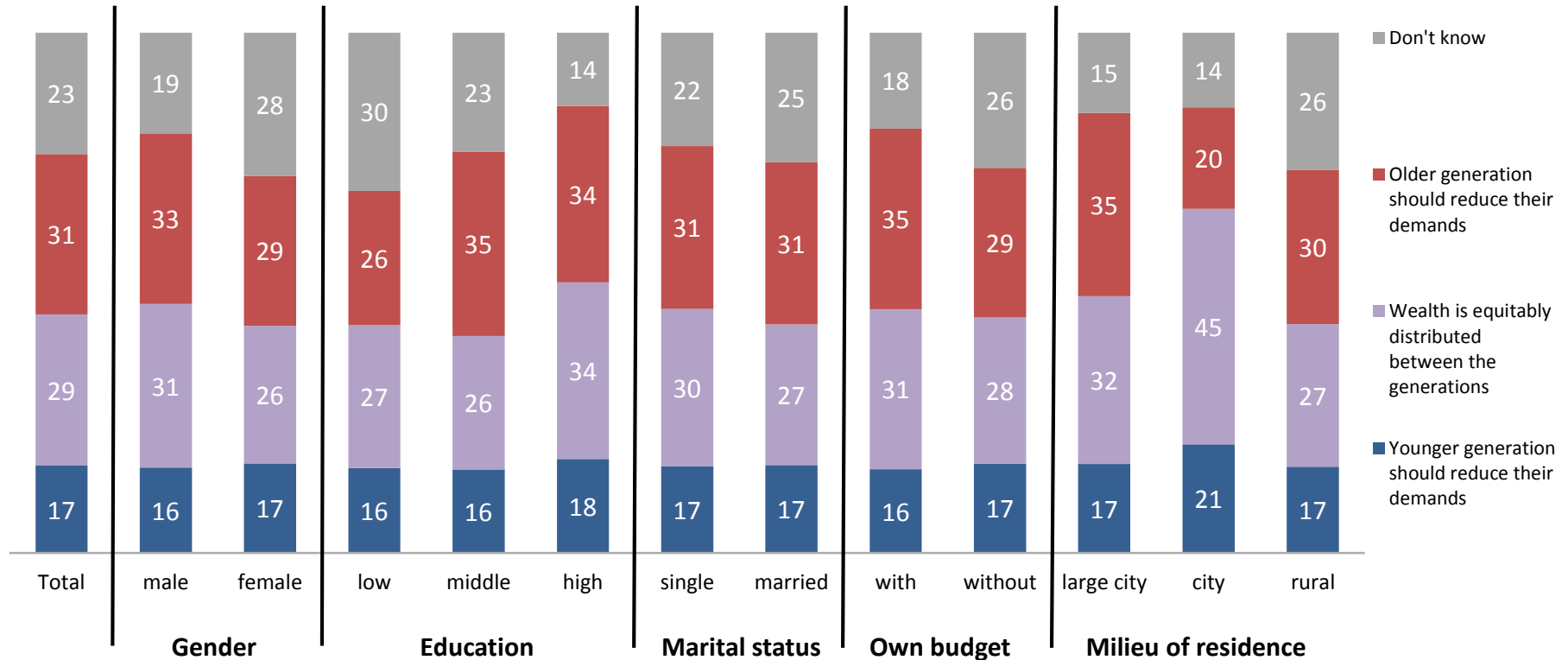
Yemen: Future relationship between the generations

Yemen: Distribution of wealth between generations

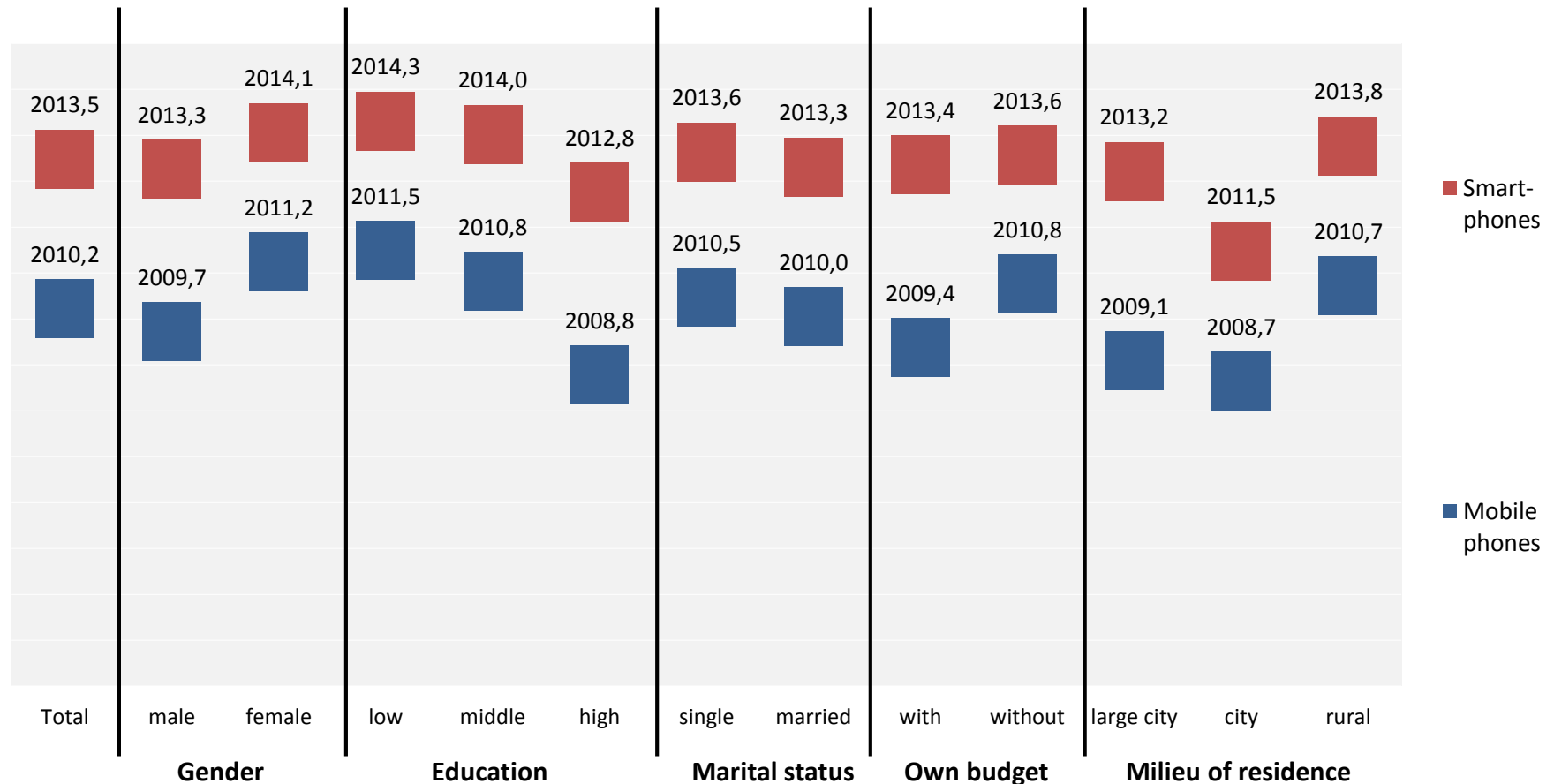

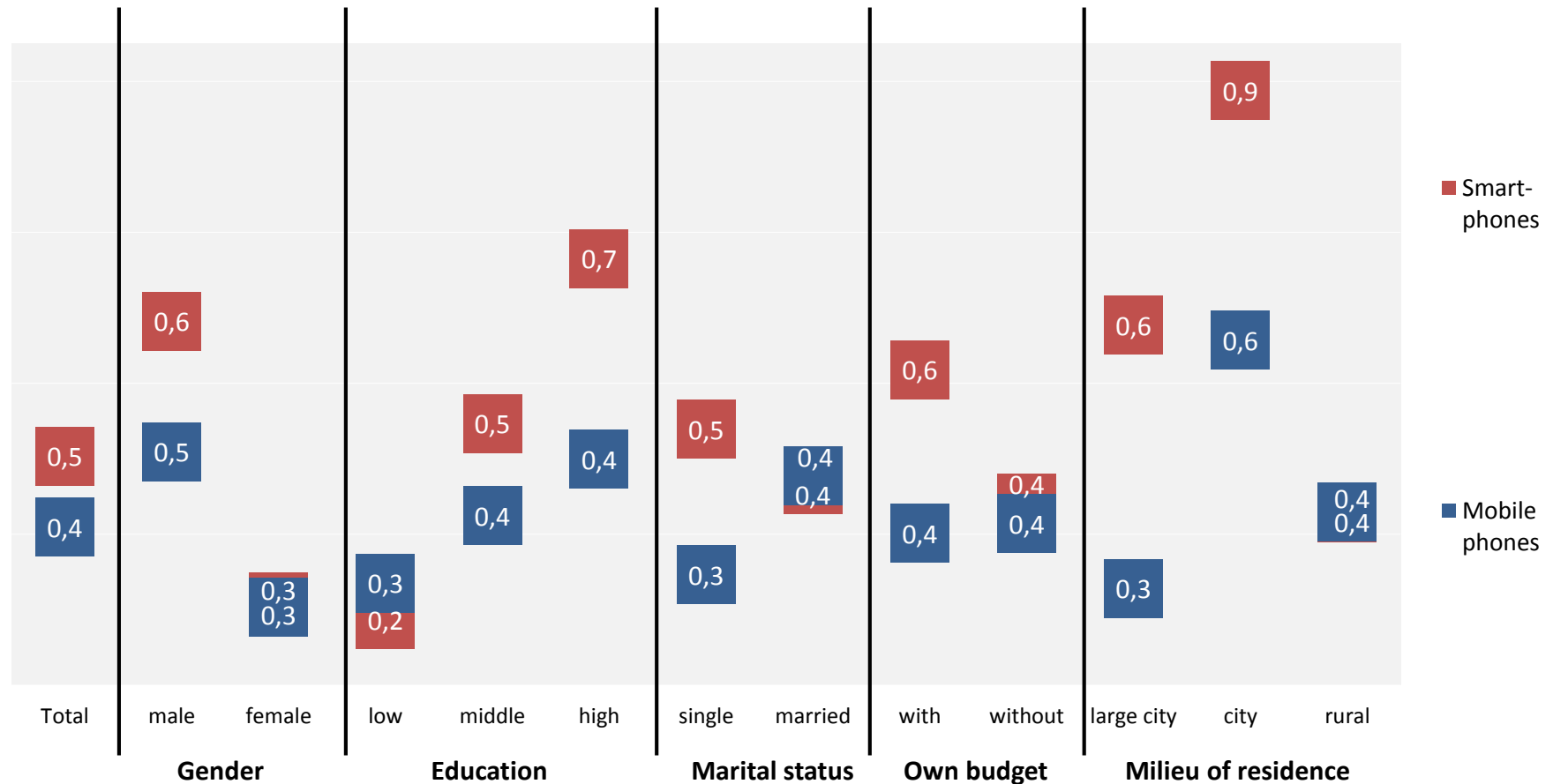
Yemen: Year of first mobile phone / smartphone

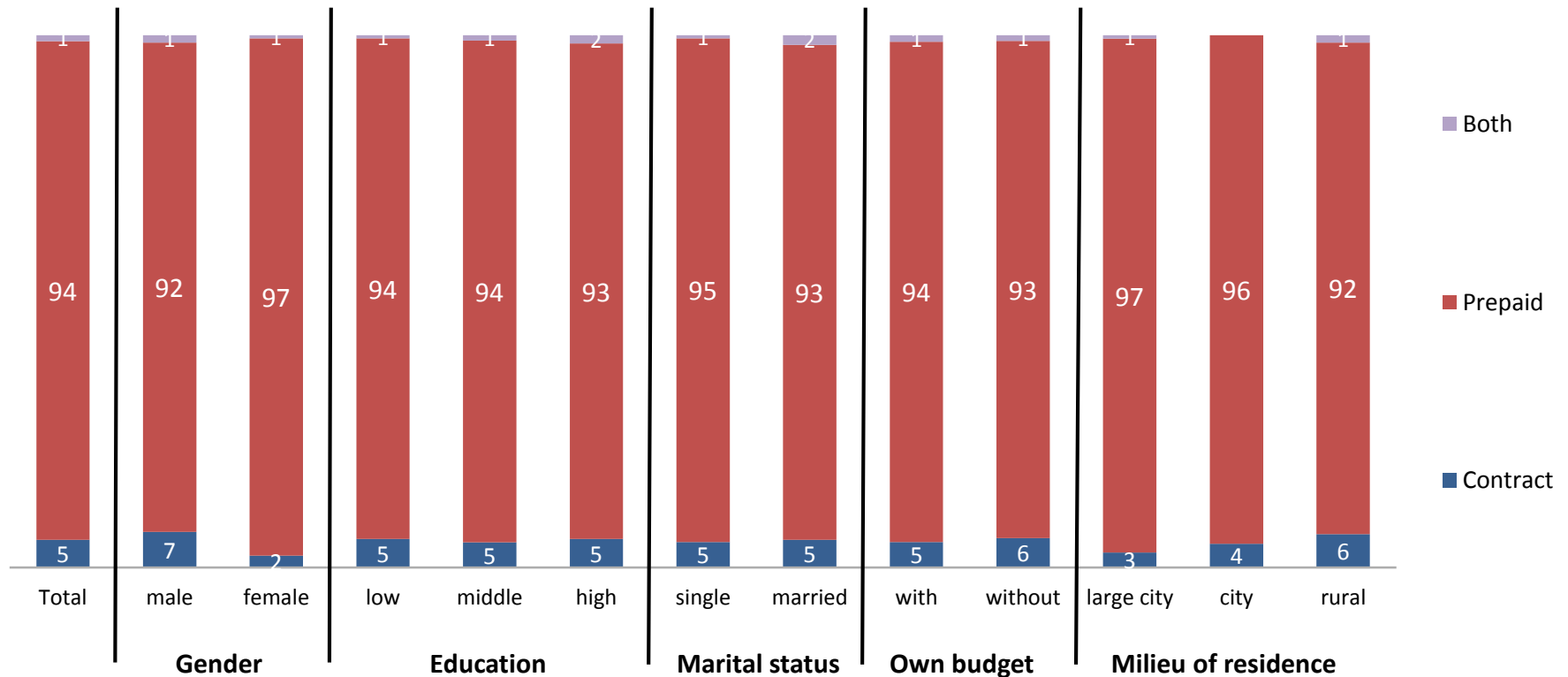
Yemen: Number of phones

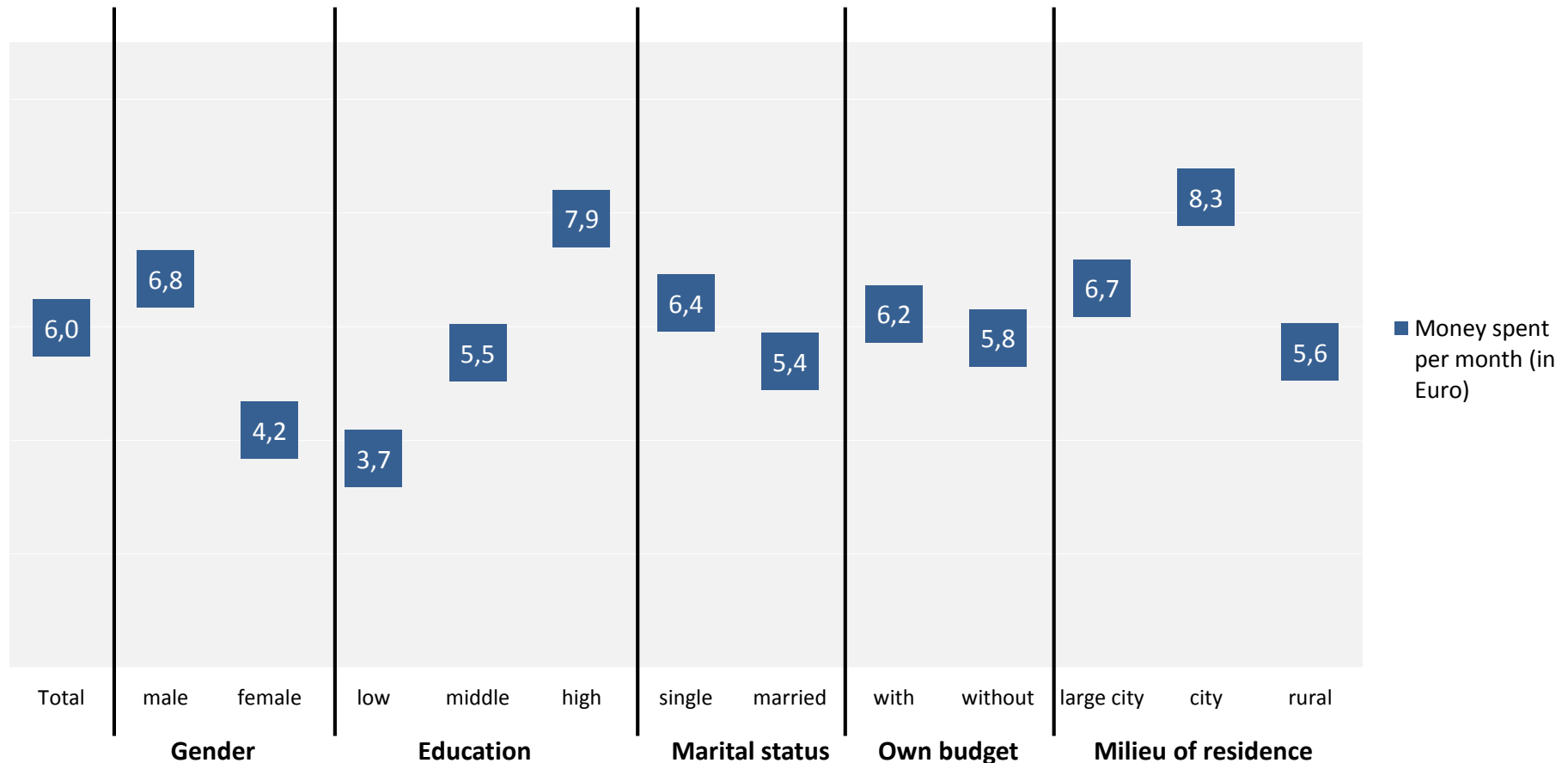
Yemen: Phone contract

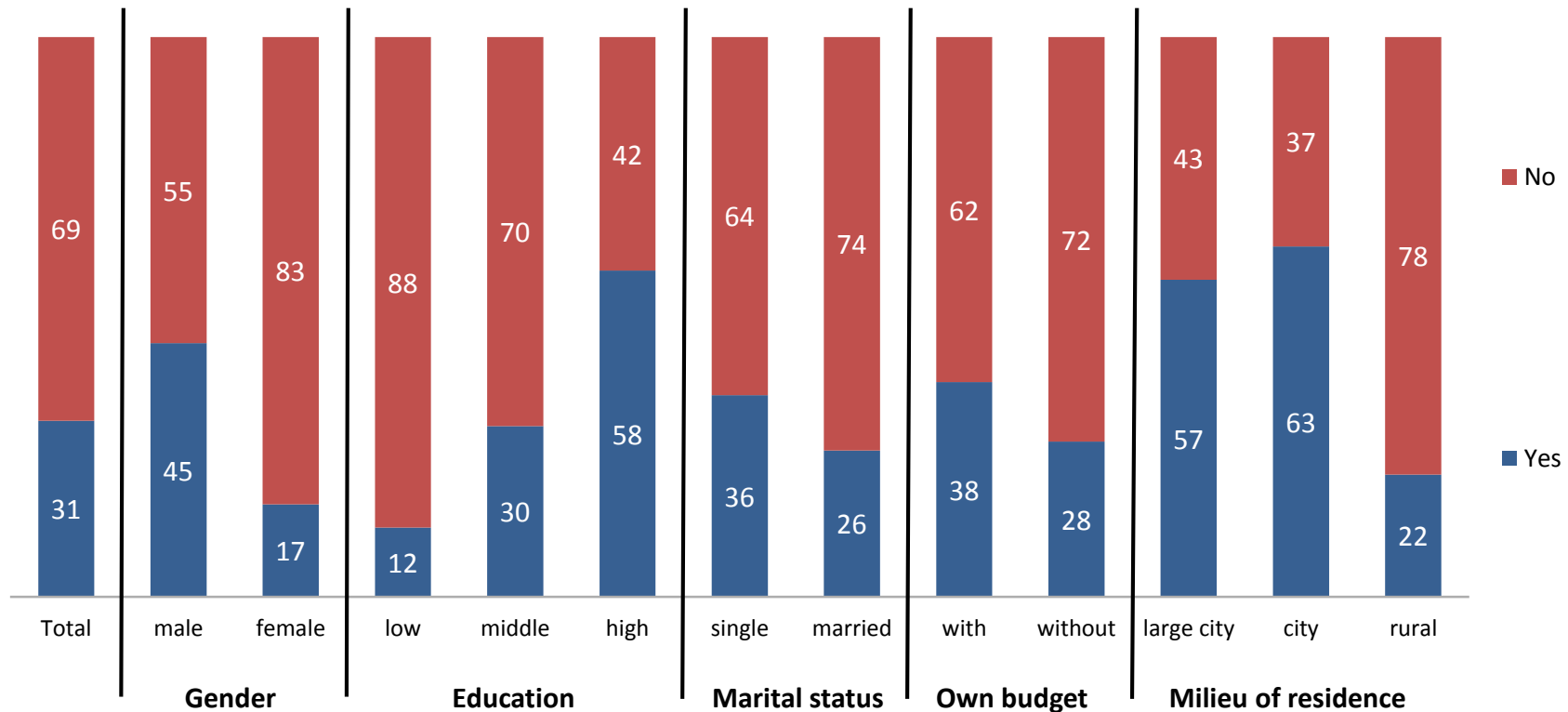

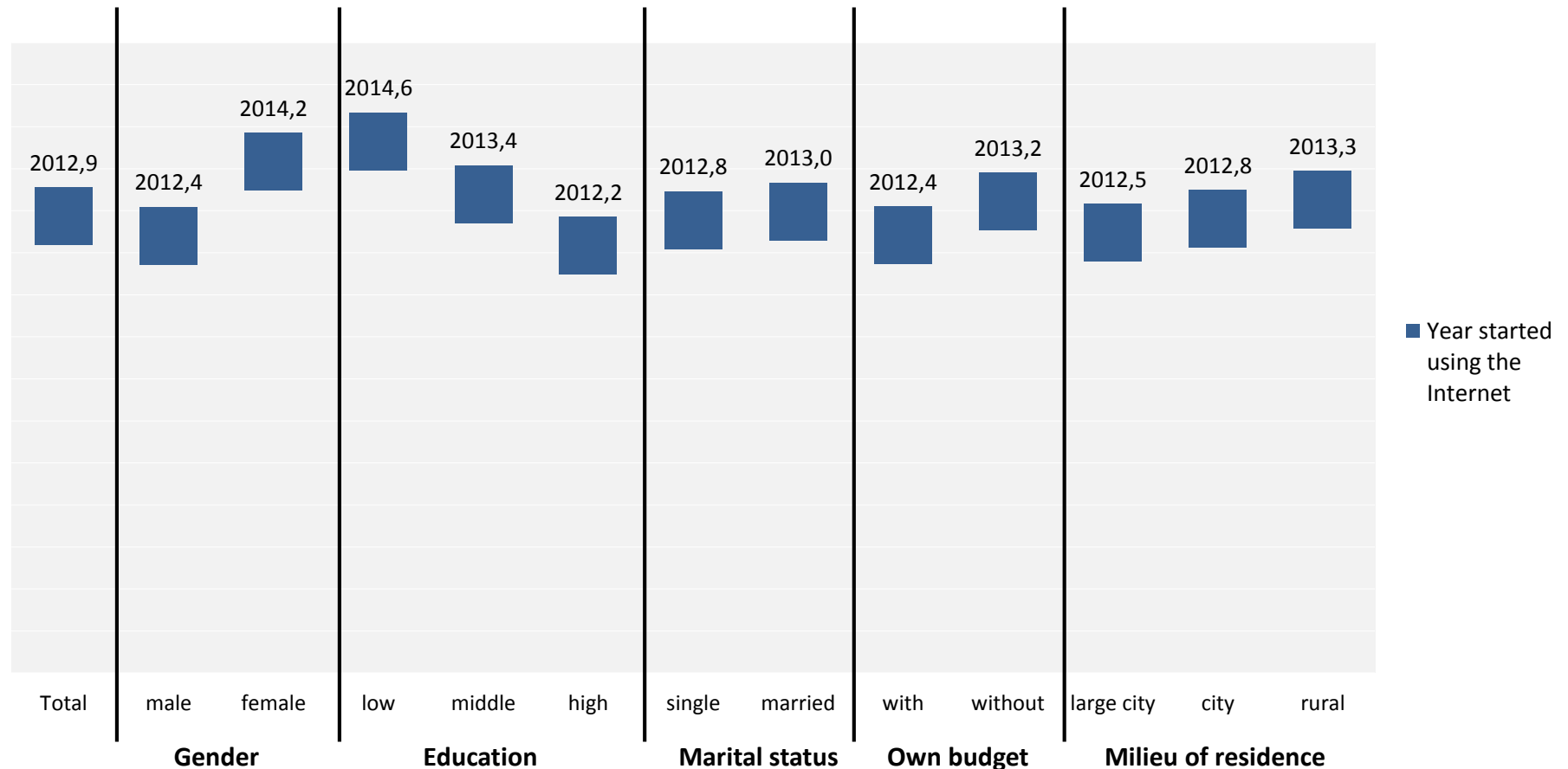

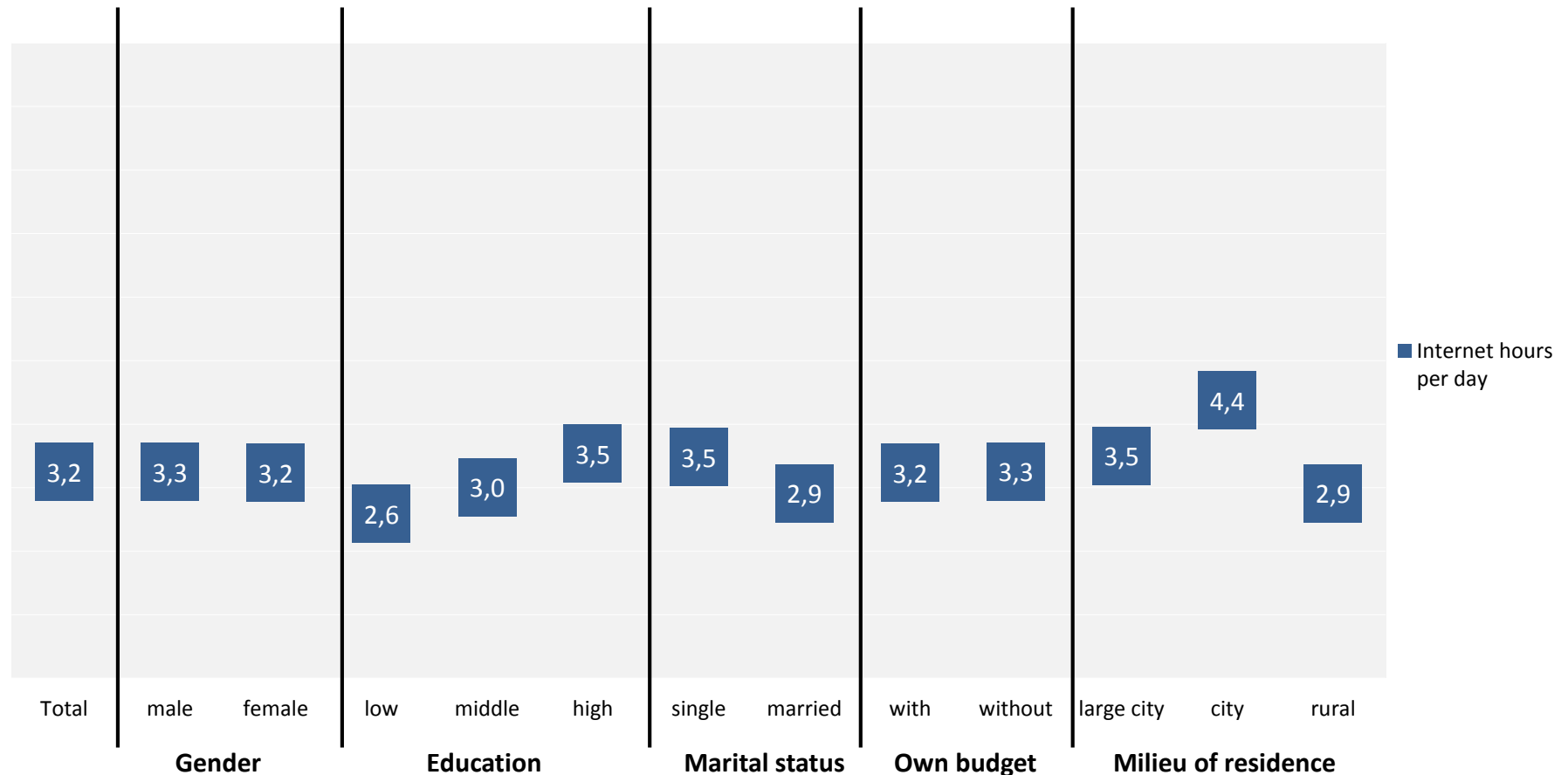

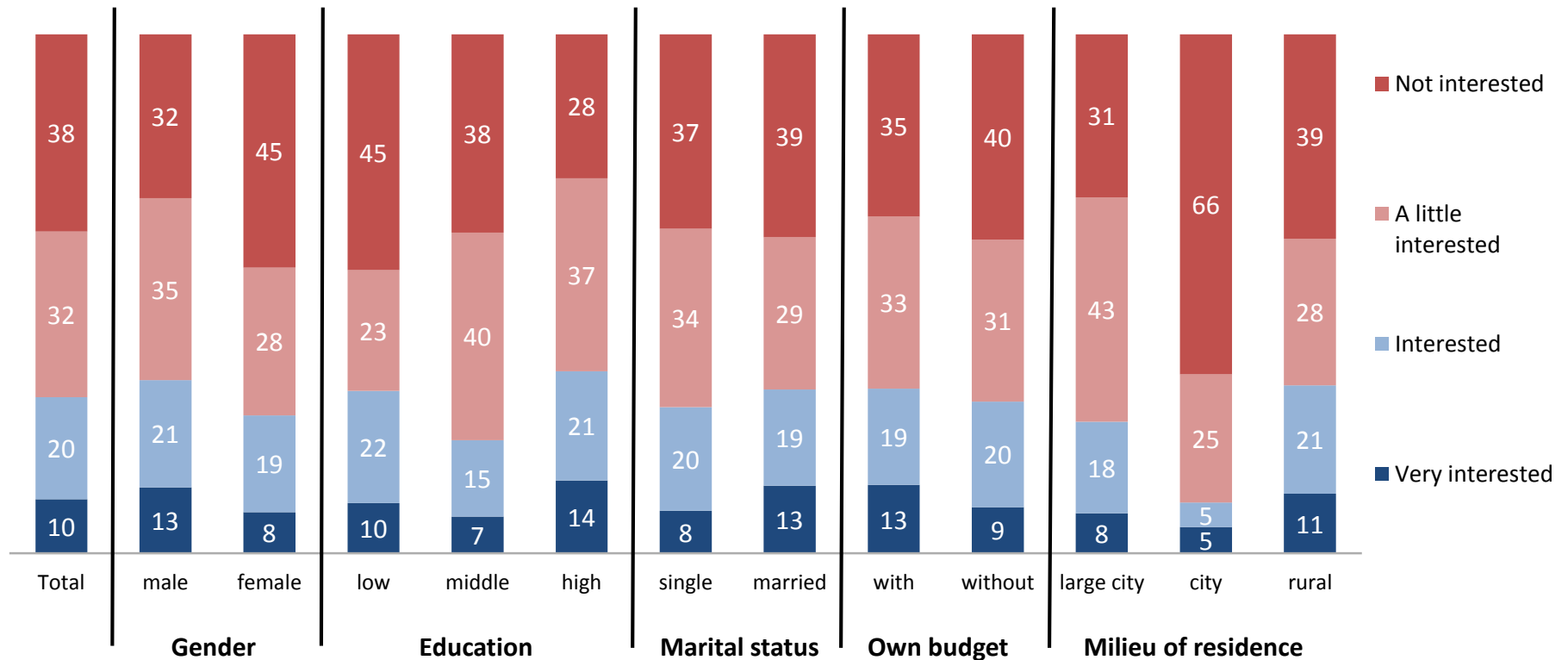

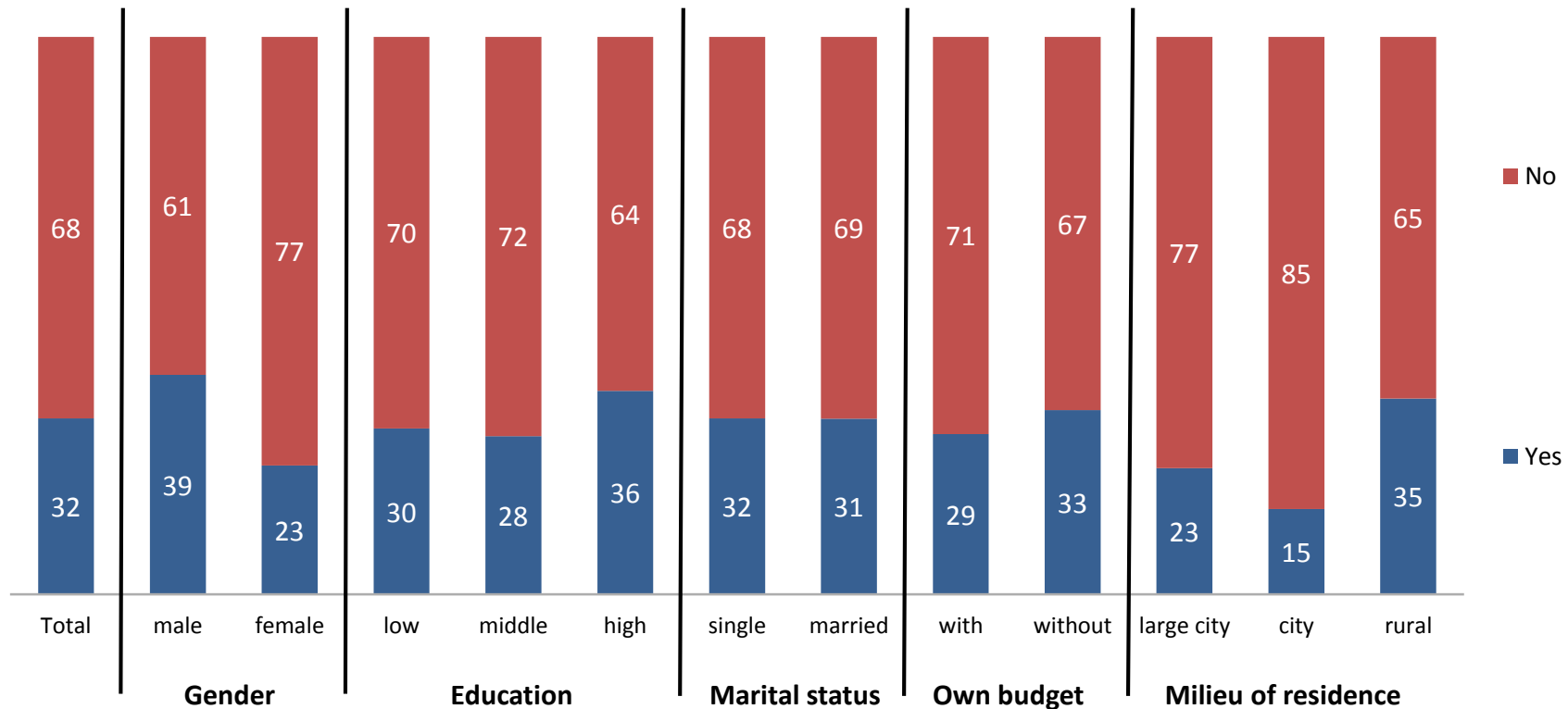

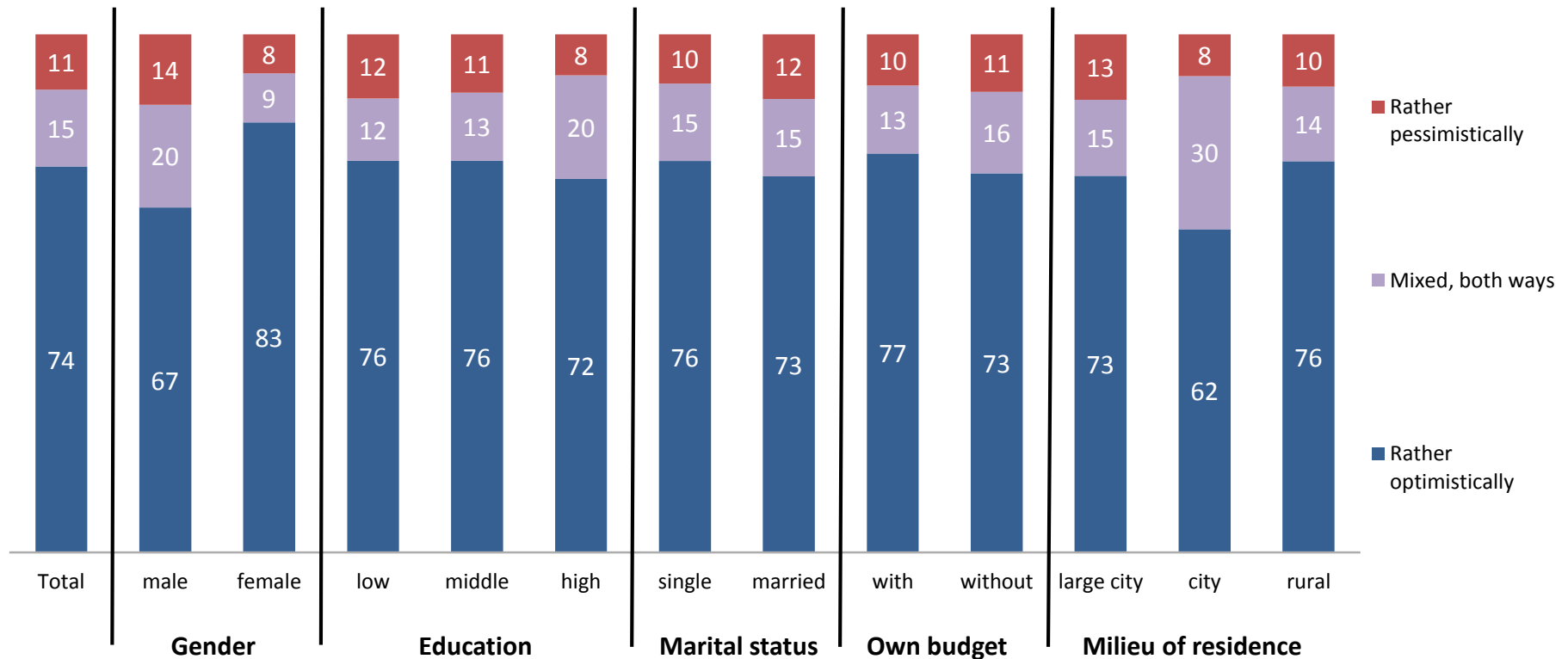

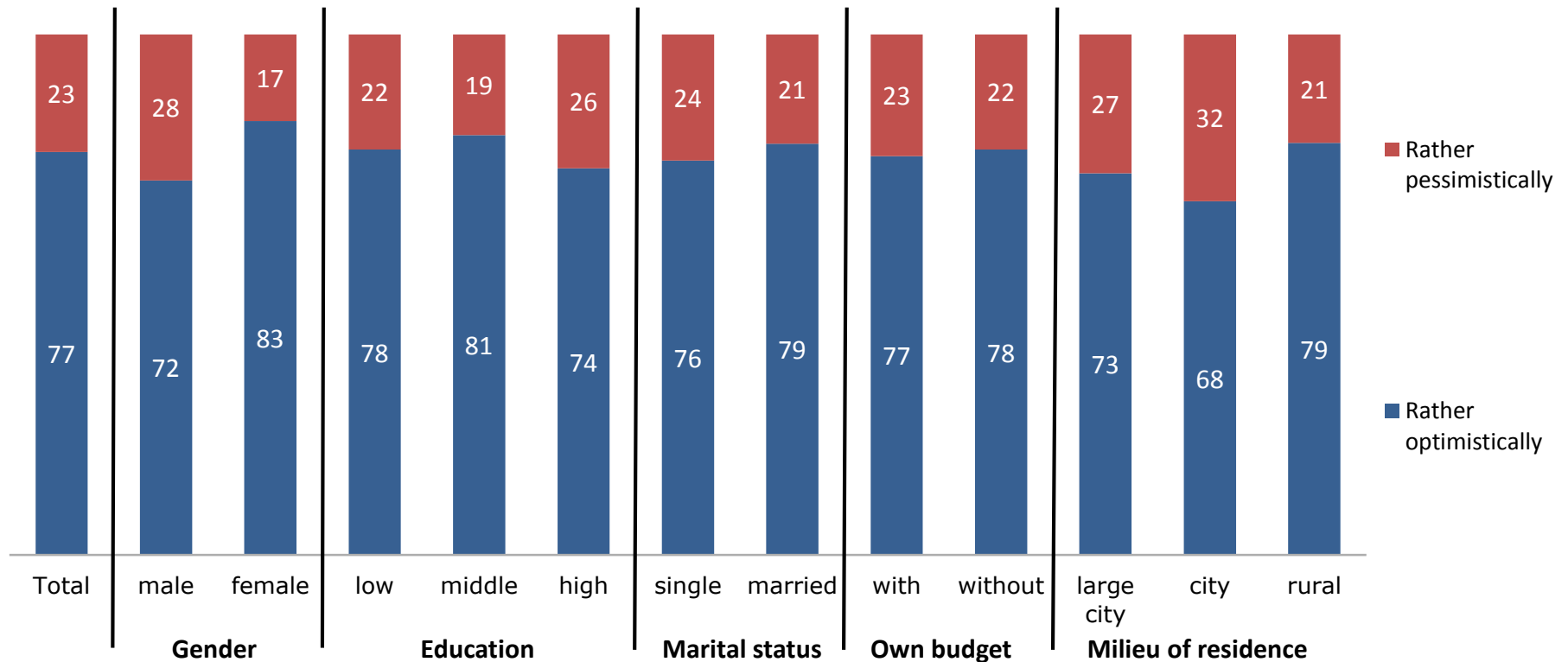

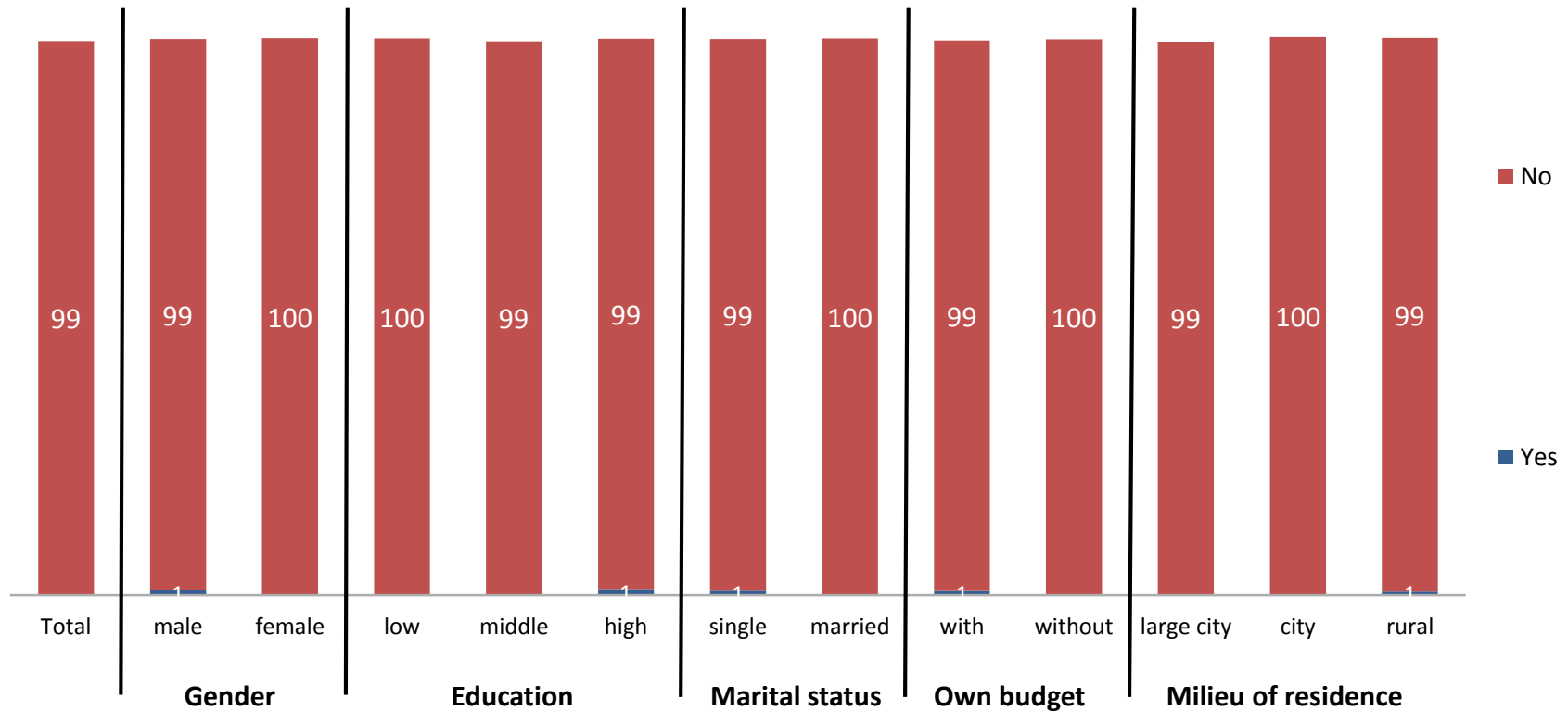

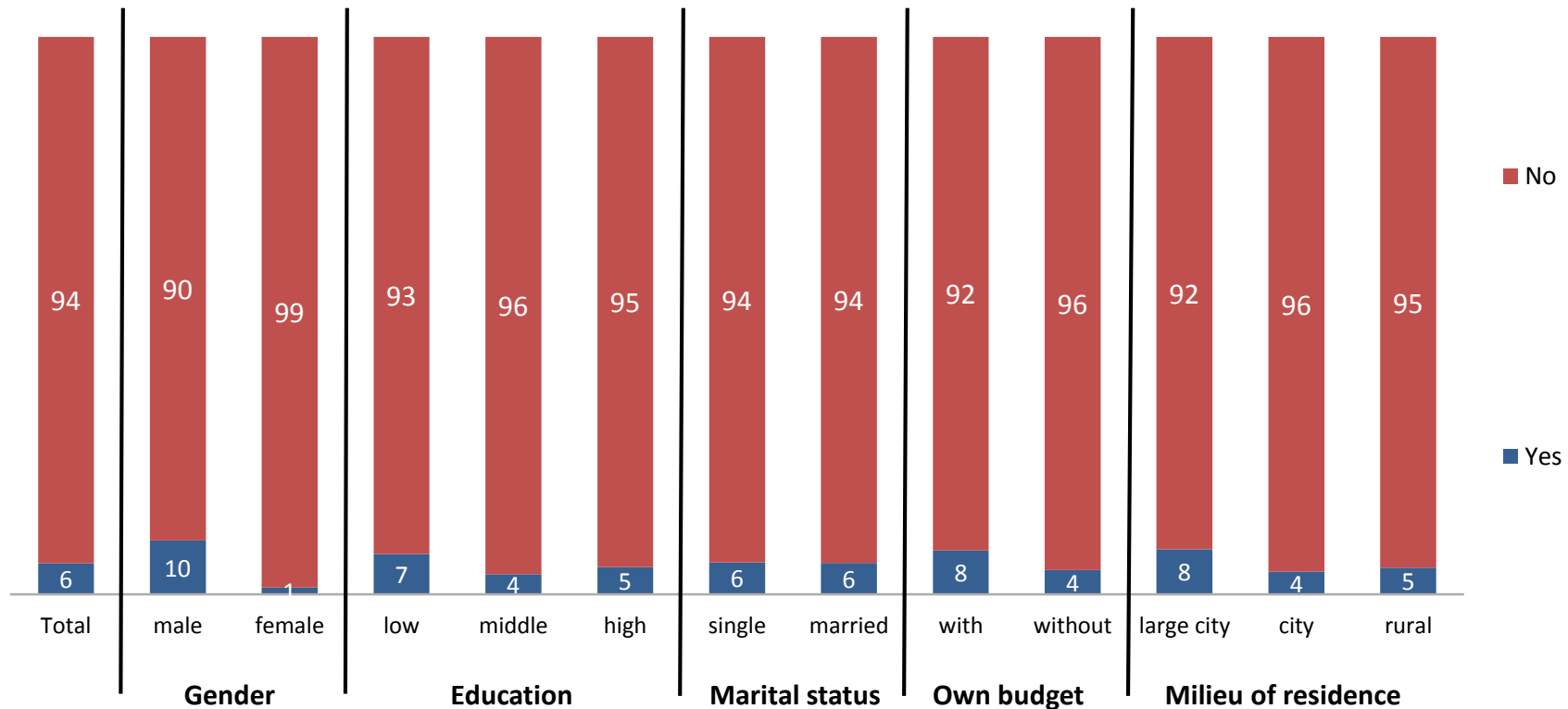

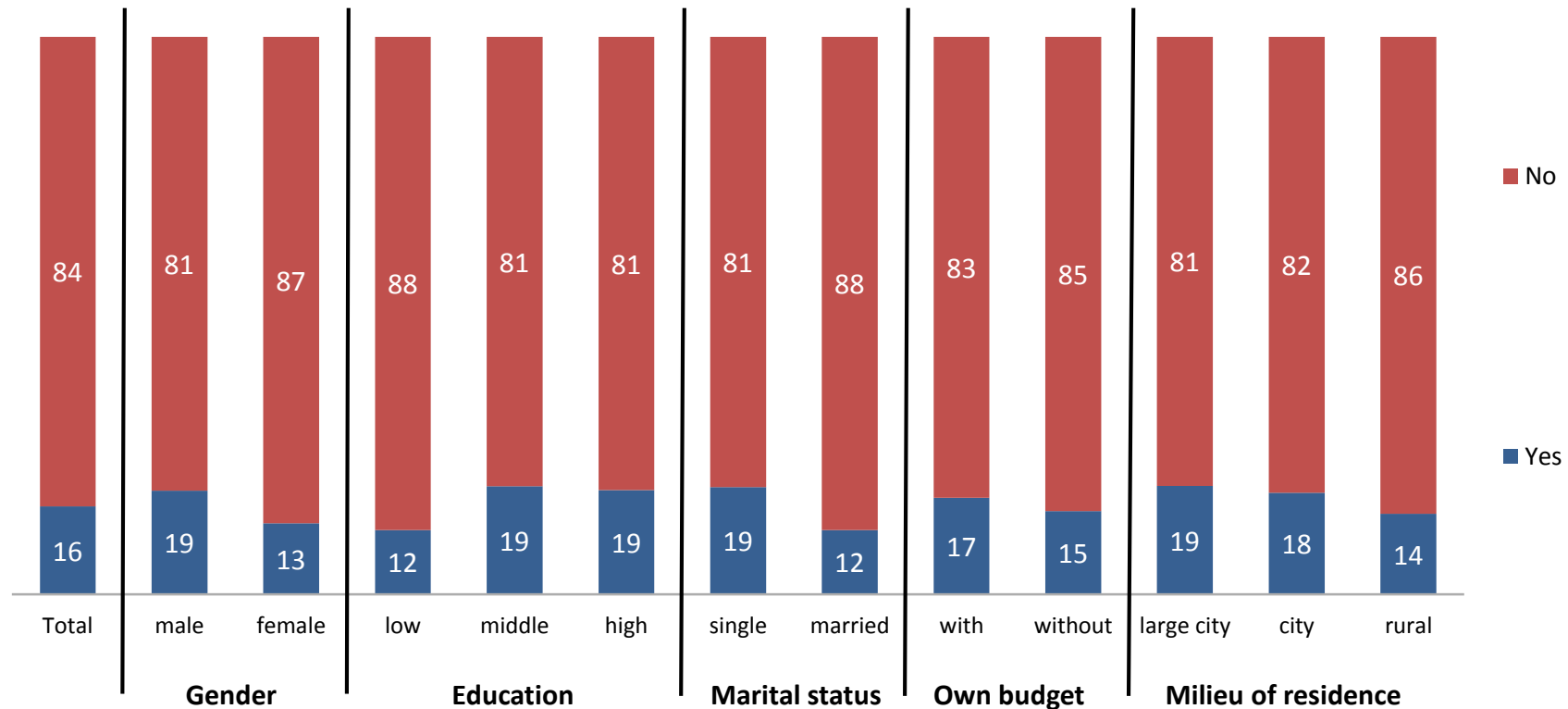

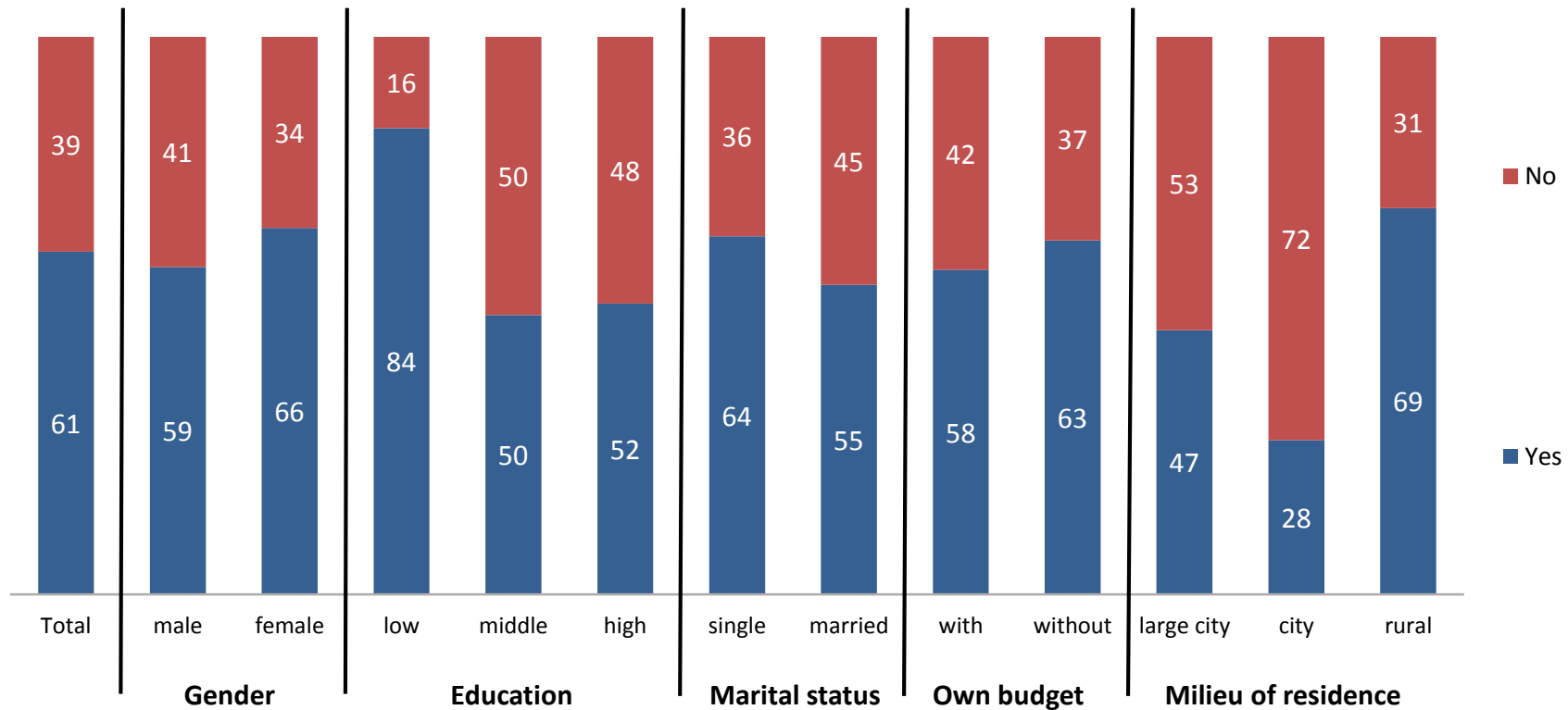

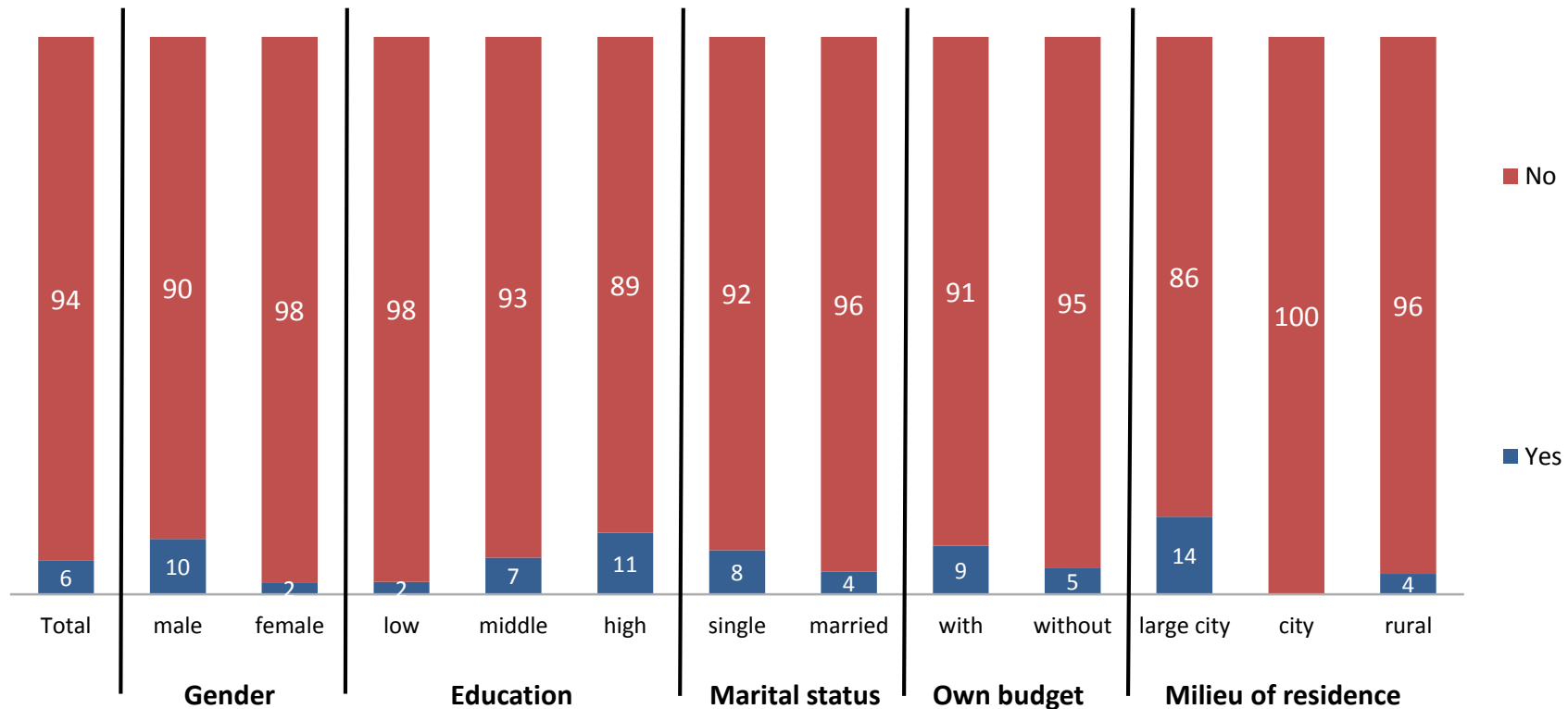

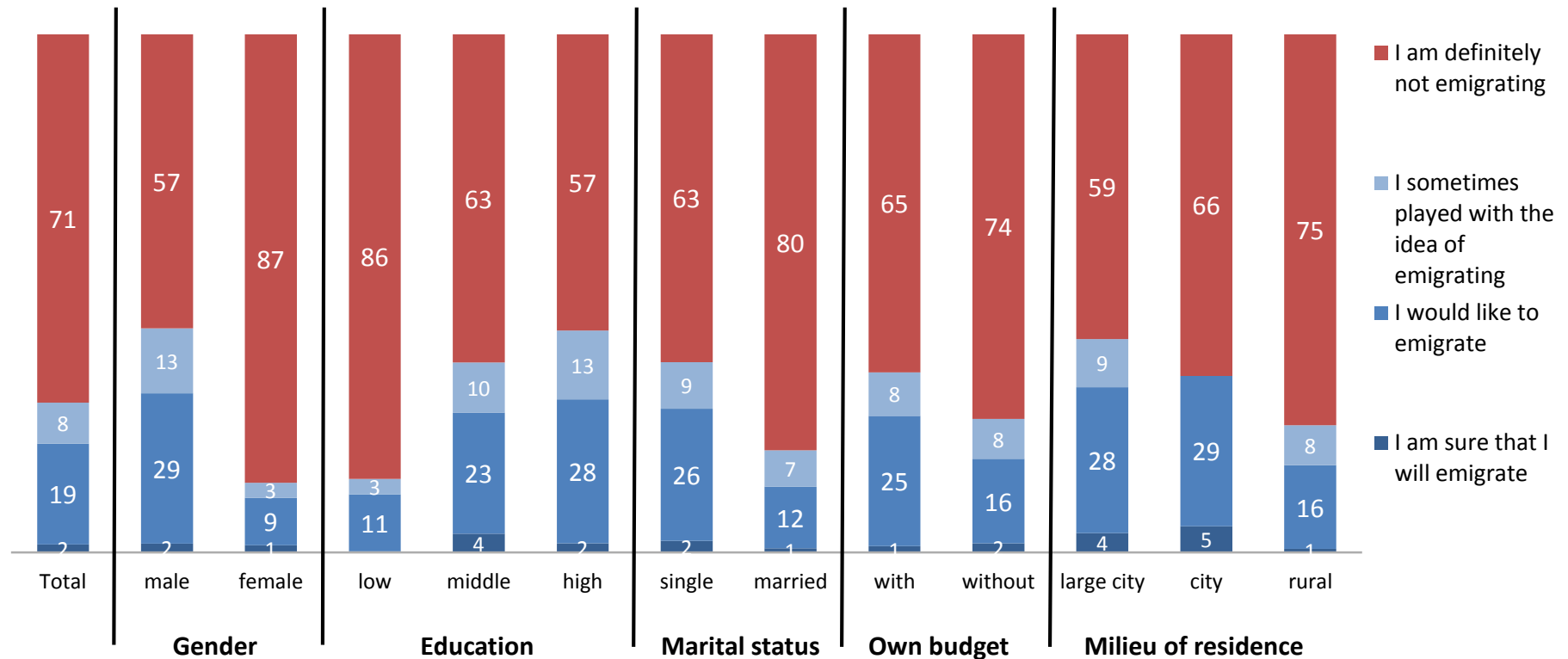
